FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 13"

Length: 79"

MATERIALS

[Fibra Natura Donnina](#) (100% superwash extra fine merino wool; 50g / 180 yds)

- 209 Pink Whisper (MC) - 4 balls
- 221 Seaport (CC1) - 1 ball
- 203 Amber (CC2) - 1 ball

Needles: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 12" circular
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

27 sts x 39 rnds = 4" in Stripe Sequence
Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Scarves are one of the many sweet treats of knitting. They work up quickly, make excellent gifts, and their size lends well to trying out lots of stitch patterns and techniques. Sweet and satisfying like your favorite cupcake, our Donnina yarn is plush, has beautiful stitch definition, and is soft on the skin. For the Buttercream Scarf, three shades work up beautifully in a striped and textured pattern. Knit as a tube, there's no right or wrong side, and the double thickness makes this sweet accessory even more delectable!

This scarf is knit in the round from the bottom up. Keep all three colors attached throughout the project. Carry unused colors up inside the work. When changing to a new color, bring it up and around previous colors to prevent any holes from forming at the join. The Stripe Sequence is both written and charted.

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Sequence

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: With CC1, knit.

Rnd 2: With CC1, purl.

Rnd 3: With MC, knit.

Rnd 4: With MC, purl.

Rnds 5-6: With CC2, * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: With MC, knit.

Rnd 8: With MC, purl.

Rnd 9: With CC1, knit.

Rnd 10: With CC1, purl.

Rnd 11: With MC, knit.

Rnds 12-13: With MC, * k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 14-15: With MC, * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 16-19: Rep Rnds 12-15.

Rnds 20-21: Rep Rnds 12-13.

Rnd 22: With MC, knit.

Rep Rnds 1-22 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

SCARF

Lower Edging

With CC2, cast on 88 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1-8: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Main Scarf

Note: Join CC1 and MC as indicated in Stripe Sequence.

Work Rnds 1-22 of Stripe Sequence, 34 total times, then rep Rnds 1-10, 1 more time. Break MC and CC1, cont with CC2 only.

Upper Edging

Rnds 1-8: With CC2, * p2, k2; rep from * to end. Bind off all sts in patt.

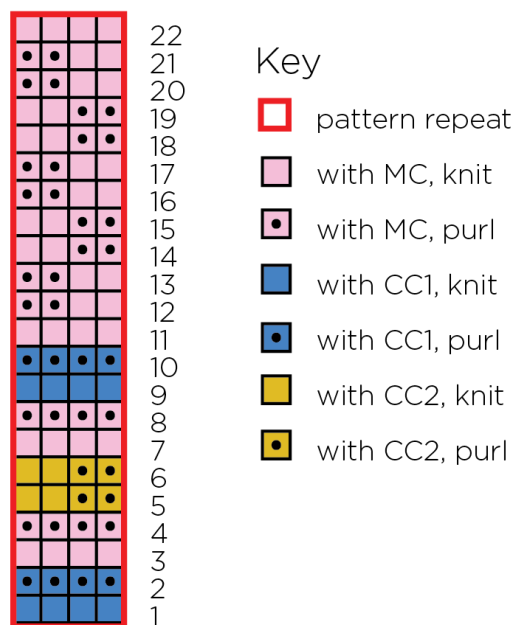
FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

CC	contrast color
cont	continue
k	knit
MC	main color
p	purl
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)
