# Cabled Cushion Cover

# SKILL

Crochet

#### **DIFFICULTY**

Intermediate

# SIZES

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 18½" Width: 18½"

## **MATERIALS**

Universal Yarn Bella Chenille (100% polyester; 100g/131 yds)

• 125 Oatmeal - 4 balls

Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) or size

needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable

stitch markers, 18" pillow form

#### GAUGE

11 sts  $\times$  7% rows = 4" in hdc Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Adorn your home with this soft, fluffy cushion cover complete with a dazzling splash of cables. The interlocking twists and turns create just enough intrigue to elevate any space.

This cushion cover is crocheted in three pieces, then seamed. The front piece is square-shaped. The two back pieces are rectangular and are wide enough to slightly overlap, creating the insert for a cushion.

#### STITCH GUIDE

#### Front Post Treble Crochet (FPtr)

Yo twice, insert hk from front to back to front around the post of the indicated st, yo, pull up lp (4 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (3 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo and draw through rem 2 lps on hk.

### Front Post Double Treble Crochet (FPdtr)

Yo 3 times, insert hk from front to back around the post of the indicated st, yo, pull up Ip (5 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (4 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (3 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 rem lps on hk.

#### Cable Panel

Panel is worked across 15 hdc in the center of the Front Piece.

Note: Should you wish to practice, work 2 rows of 19 hdc sts, then work 2 hdc at the beginning and end of each row.

Row 1 (RS): FPtr in each of the next 2 sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, FPtr in each of the next 2 sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, FPtr in each of the next 2 sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, FPtr in each of the next 2 sts 2 rows below.

WS Rows 2-12: Hdc in each st across.

Row 3: Hdc in next 2 sts, reaching hk backwards FPdtr in each of the first 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, sk next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st working behind last 2 FP sts made, reach hk backwards and FPdtr in each of the 2 FP sts sk'd, hdc in next st, reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the last 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts.

Row 5: Hdc in next 2 sts, \*sk next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the next 2 sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, working over last 2 FP sts made, reach hk backwards and FPdtr in each of the 2 FP sts sk'd \*\*, hdc in next st; rep from \* to \*\*, hdc in next 2 sts.

Row 7: Hdc in next 2 sts, FPtr in each of the 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, sk next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st working behind last 2 FP sts made, reach hk backwards and FPdtr in each of the 2 FP sts sk'd, hdc in next st, FPtr in each of the 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Row 11: Reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, sk next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching hk forward FPdtr in each of the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st working behind last 2 FP sts made, reach hk backwards and FPdtr in each of the 2 FP sts sk'd, hdc in next 3 sts, reaching hk backwards FPdtr in each of the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below. Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

#### PATTERN BEGINS

#### **FRONT**

Ch 52.

Foundation Row 1 (RS): Hdc into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hk (chs count as st here and throughout) and each ch across, turn – 51 hdc.

Foundation Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, hdc in next 17 sts, work Row 1 of Cable Panel, hdc in next 18 sts, turn.

WS Rows 2-34: Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

RS Rows 3-23: Keeping sts each side in hdc and center 15 sts in Cable Panel, work RS Rows 3-11 of Cable Panel, then rep RS Rows 1-11, 1 more time.

RS Rows 25-29: Keeping sts each side in hdc and center 15 sts in Cable Panel, work RS Rows 1-5 of Cable Panel.

RS Row 31: Keeping sts each side in hdc and center 15 sts in Cable Panel, work Row 11 of Cable Panel.

RS Row 33: Keeping sts each side in hdc and center 15 sts in Cable Panel, work Row 1 of Cable Panel.

Fasten off after Row 34.

#### **BACK**

Make 2 alike.

Ch 34.

Row 1: Hdc in  $3^{rd}$  ch from hk and each ch across, turn - 33 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 3-36: Rep Row 2. Fasten Off.

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#### **ASSEMBLY**

Lay the Front Piece WS down in front of you. Lay a Back Piece with WS up on top of the Front Piece. RS of pieces will be facing each other. Whipstitch through both Pieces along the top, side edge, and bottom of where they align.

Align the second Back Piece on top of the Front Piece next to the first, and along the other side. The Back Pieces will overlap in the center. Whipstitch through both pieces, including any overlap, along the top, side edge, and bottom of where they align.

#### **FINISHING**

Flip the Cushion Cover RS out. Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends. Place pillow form inside.


