DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Scarf: One Size

Hat: Adult Small/Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf Length: 68"

Width: 8"

Hat

Brim Circumference: 16½" Stretches to approx 18½"

Length (excluding pom pom and with

brim folded): 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn <u>Colorburst</u> (65% superwash fine merino, 35% acrylic 200g/660 yds)

• 118 Baltic - 1 ball

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight or your preferred ndl for knitting flat and 16" circular (for Hat) and set of dpns (or your preferred ndl for knitting small circumferences) or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, cable needle (cn), 3" pom pom maker

GAUGE

26 sts x 28 row/rnds = 4" in Cable and Rib patt with larger ndl Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

Gusty winds are frequent in early spring, making it essential to keep your favorite lightweight knit accessories handy. Knit in warm yet seemingly weightless, self-shading Colorburst, the Café Cable Set will keep you cozy and comfortable throughout early spring! Wrap the scarf around your neck and pop the hat on top as you stroll to your favorite café for a cup of coffee, and knitting of course!

The Café Cable scarf is knit flat from the bottom up. The Café Cable hat is knit in the round from the bottom up. A pom pom is added as the finishing step. Please note that this pattern is written to make the most of one skein of Colorburst, and you can adjust the length of the scarf as desired.

STITCH GUIDE

3x3 Right Cross (RC)

Slip 3 sts from LH ndl to cn and hold in back, k3 from LH ndl, k3 from cn.

3x2 Right Cross (RC)

Slip 2 sts from LH ndl to cn and hold in back, k3 from LH ndl, k2 from cn.

K2, P2 Rib

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Cable and Rib Pattern

(multiple of 12 sts, knit in the rnd)

Rnd 1: * P2, k6, p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 2-4: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 5: * P2, 3x3 RC, p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 6-8: Rep Rnd 1. Rnd 9: Rep Rnd 5.

Rnd 10: Rep Rnd 1.

Rep Rnds 1-10 for patt.

Cable and Rib Pattern

(multiple of 12 sts, plus 2, knit flat)

Row 1 (RS): * K2, p2, k6, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts. k2.

Row 2 (WS): P2, * k2, p6, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rows 3-4: Rep Rows 1-2.

Row 5: * K2, p2, 3x3 RC, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rows 7-8: Rep Rows 1-2.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Row 10: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

HAT

Brim

With smaller circ ndl, cast on 108 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work in K2, P2 Rib until piece meas approx 4" from cast-on edge. Change to larger circ ndl.

Main Hat

Note: We recommend placing markers between pattern repeats to help you stay on track.

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Cable and Rib Patt to end. Patt will be repeated 9 times across each rnd.

Rnd 2: Work Rnd 2 of Cable and Rib Patt to end.

Cont as est'd through Rnd 10 of Cable and Rib Patt, then rep Rnds 1-10, 3 more times, then rep Rnds 1-4, one more time.

Crown Shaping

Note 1: This section is also charted for your convenience.

Note 2: Change to DPNs or your preferred needles for knitting small circumferences when you no longer have enough sts to fit comfortably on 16" circ ndl.

Rnd 1: * P2, 3x3 RC, p2, k2tog; rep from * to end - 9 sts dec'd, 99 sts rem.

Rnd 2: * P2, k6, p2, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * Ssp, k6, p1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 18 sts dec'd, 81 sts rem.

Rnd 4: * P1, k6, p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: * P1, 3x2 RC, k3tog; rep from * to end - 18 sts dec'd, 63 sts rem.

Rnd 6: * P1, k6; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: * Ssk, k3, k2tog; rep from * to end - 18 sts dec'd, 45 sts rem.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: * Ssk, k1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 18 sts dec'd, 27 sts rem.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11: * K2tog, k1; rep from * to end - 9 sts dec'd, 18 sts rem.

Rnd 12: Knit.

Rnd 13: * K2tog, rep from * to end - 9 sts dec'd, 9 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving approx 8" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends. With pom pom maker, make a 3" pom pom and attach to top of hat.

SCARE

Cast on 58 sts,

Row 1 (RS): K4, pm, work Row 1 of Cable and Rib Patt over 50 sts, pm, k4. Patt will be repeated 4 times across each row.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to m, sl m, work Row 2 of Cable and Rib Patt to m, sl m, knit to end.

Cont as est'd through Row 10 of Cable and Rib patt, then rep Rows 1-10 until piece meas approx 68" from cast-on edge, or until desired measurement has been reached. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
