





Checked Scarf and Hat

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

SIZE

Scarf: Adult

Hat: Adult Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf Width: 8½"

Scarf Length: 66" (without fringe) Hat Circumference: 19¾ (21¾, 23½)"

Hat Depth: 8 (8½, 9)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

• 323 Steel Grey (MC) – 2 skeins **Universal Yarn** *Uptown Worsted Mist* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

• 904 Lavender (CC) – 2 skeins **Needles:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight, 16" circular, set of dpns *or size needed* to obtain gauge

US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2½" pom-pom

maker, stitch markers

GAUGE

17 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Knotted Stitch patt using larger ndl Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

STITCH GUIDE

Knotted Stitch (worked in rows)

(even number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): With MC, knit. Row 2 (WS): With MC, purl.

Row 3: With CC, * k2tog; rep from * to end. **Row 4:** With CC, * k1, m1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

Knotted Stitch (worked in the rnd)

(even number of sts)

Rnds 1-2: With MC, knit.

Rnd 3: With CC, * k2tog; rep from * to end. Rnd 4: With CC, * m1p, p1; rep from * to end. Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

K2, P2 Ribbing

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Scarf is worked widthwise from one end to the other.

Hat is knit in the round from the bottom up. When there are too few stitches to fit on the needle during crown shaping, switch to dpns.

On Rnd/Row 3 of the Knotted Stitch patt, the total stitch count is cut in half due to k2togs. On the following Rnd/Row 4, the original stitch count is restored.

SCARF

With MC and straight ndls, cast on 36 sts. Knit 4 rows.

Establish Pattern

 ${f Row~1}$ (RS): With MC, k4, pm, work Row 1 of

Knotted Stitch to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

Row 2 (WS): With MC, knit to m, work Row 2 of

Knotted Stitch to m, knit to end.

Row 3: With CC, knit to m, work Row 3 of

Knotted Stitch to m, knit to end.

Row 4: With CC, knit to m, work Row 4 of

Knotted Stitch to m, knit to end.

Cont in patt as est'd until Scarf meas 65", ending with WS Row 2 of Knotted Stitch patt. Break CC. With MC, knit 4 rows. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

Fringe

Cut 66 13" pieces of MC. Holding 3 strands tog as one, attach 11 groups of fringe evenly to one end of Scarf. Rep for other end. Trim ends even.

HAT

With MC and smaller circ ndl, cast on 84 (92, 100) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Brim

Work in K2, P2 Ribbing patt until piece meas 2".

Hat Body

Switch to larger ndl. Beg with Rnd 3 of Knotted Stitch patt, work in patt until piece meas 7 (7, 7½)", ending with Rnd 3 of patt.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: With CC, purl – 42 (46, 50) sts.

Rnd 2: With CC, * m1p, p2; rep from * to end – 63 (69, 75) sts.

Break CC. Cont in MC only.

Rnds 3-4: Knit.

Rnd 5: * K3tog; rep from * to end – 21 (23, 25) sts rem.

Rnd 6: [K3tog] 7 (7, 8) times, k0 (2, 1) - 7 (9, 9) sts rem. Break yarn leaving 8" tail. Pass tail through rem live sts. Pull taut, fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. With MC and following manufacturer's directions, make a 2½" pom-pom. Sew to top of hat.

front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)

MC main color meas measures ndl needle patt pattern p purl

pm place marker

p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

rem remain(ing)
rep repeat
rnd round
RS right side
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
