#### **SIZES**

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width (at widest point): 50%"

Length: 92¾"

### **MATERIALS**

**Fibra Natura** *Ravello* (75% cotton, 16% extra fine merino, 9% recycled cashmere; 50g/207 yds)

- 108 Tuscan Pepper (MC) 5 balls
- 104 Soft Clay (CC) − 2 balls

**Needle:** US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 24" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) or size needed to obtain gauge **Hook:** US F/5 (3.75 mm) (for Picot Trim) **Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

## **GAUGE**

19 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Lace patt 19 sts x 38 rows = 4" in garter st Save time, check your gauge.

## Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

There is so much to love about the Ciri shawl. Stripes and a delicate lace pattern play beautifully together, and the picot trim adds just a touch of romance. Knit in Ravello – a dreamy blend of cotton, merino, and recycled cashmere – this piece is appropriate for every season. The fabric drapes beautifully thanks to the loose gauge. You won't be able to resist wrapping this generously-sized shawl around your neck and shoulders.

This boomerang-shaped shawl is worked on the bias, beginning with the smallest point. It features alternating sections of stripes and lace. It is finished with a crochet picot trim along the bind-off edge.

When working in Stripes sections, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, twist the strands of yarn around one another every RS row, taking care not to twist too tightly.

The Lace sections are charted for your convenience. You may wish to place markers between each pattern repeat to help you stay on track.

#### **STITCH GUIDE**

## Lace

(multiple of 9 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** \* K2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to end.

WS Rows 2-6: Purl.

**Row 3:** \* K1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 5:** \* K2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rows 1-6 for patt.

### **SHAWL**

Tip

With CC, cast on 2 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb – 3 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit. Join MC, do not break CC.

**Row 3:** With MC, k2, kfb – 4 sts.

Row 4: With MC, knit.

**Row 5:** With CC, k2, yo, k2 – 5 sts.

Row 6: With CC, knit.

**Row 7:** With MC, k2, yo, knit to end – 6 sts.

Row 8: With MC, knit.

**Section 1 - Stripes** 

Row 1 (RS): With CC, k2, yo, knit to end -1 st inc'd, 7 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** With MC, k2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd, 8 sts.

**Row 4:** With MC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Rows 5-70:** Rep Rows 1-4, 16 more times, then rep Rows 1-2, 1 more time – 33 sts inc'd, 41 sts. Break CC. Cont with MC only.

#### Section 2 - Lace

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 12 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 42 sts.

**WS Rows 2-18:** K2, k2tog, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, yo, k2, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3 – 1 st inc'd, 43 sts.

**Row 5:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 44 sts. **Row 7:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 9 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 45 sts.

**Row 9:** \* K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 46 sts.

**Row 11:** K2, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 47 sts.

**Row 13:** K2, yo, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k6 – 1 st inc'd, 48 sts.

**Row 15:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 49 sts.

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**Row 17:** K2, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 50 sts.

Rep Rows 1-18, 1 more time – 9 sts inc'd, 59 sts.

## Section 3 – Stripes

Row 1 (RS): With CC, k2, yo, knit to end -1 st inc'd, 60 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** With MC, k2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd, 61 sts.

**Row 4:** With MC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Rows 5-90: Rep Rows 1-4, 21 more times, then rep Rows 1-2, 1 more time – 43 sts inc'd, 104 sts. Break CC. Cont with MC only.

#### Section 4 – Lace

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 12 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 105 sts.

**WS Rows 2-18:** K2, k2tog, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2

**Row 3:** K2, yo, k2, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3 – 1 st inc'd, 106 sts.

**Row 5:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 107 sts

**Row 7:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 9 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 108 sts.

**Row 9:** \* K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 109 sts.

**Row 11:** K2, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 110 sts.

**Row 13:** K2, yo, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k6 – 1 st inc'd, 111 sts.



**Row 15:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 112 sts.

**Row 17:** K2, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 113 sts.

Rep Rows 1-18, 3 more times – 27 sts inc'd, 140 sts.

## Section 5 – Stripes

Row 1 (RS): With CC, k2, yo, knit to end -1 st inc'd, 141 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** With MC, k2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd, 142 sts.

**Row 4:** With MC, k2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

Rows 5-90: Rep Rows 1-4, 21 more times, then rep Rows 1-2, 1 more time – 43 sts inc'd, 185 sts. Break CC. Cont with MC only.

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#### Section 6 - Lace

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 12 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 186 sts.

**WS Rows 2-18:** K2, k2tog, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** K2, yo, k2, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k3 – 1 st inc'd, 187 sts.

**Row 5:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 188 sts.

**Row 7:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 9 sts, k2, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 189 sts.

**Row 9:** \* K2, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k1, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 190 sts.

**Row 11:** K2, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2tog, yo, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 191 sts.

**Row 13:** K2, yo, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2, \* k2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k6 – 1 st inc'd, 192 sts.

**Row 15:** K2, yo, k2, yo, ssk, k2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, \* k1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k5 – 1 st inc'd, 193 sts.

**Row 17:** K2, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, \* k2tog, yo, k1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1, yo, ssk; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4 – 1 st inc'd, 194 sts.

Rep Rows 1-18, 5 more times – 45 sts inc'd, 239 sts.

## Section 7 - Border

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, knit to end – 1 st inc'd, 240 sts.

**Row 2 (WS):** K2, k2tog, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2.

**Row 3:** Rep Row 1 – 1 st inc'd, 241 sts.

Loosely bind off all sts kwise.

#### **Picot Trim**

With RS facing and hk, attach CC with sl st to right corner of bind-off edge.

**Row 1:** With CC, working through both loops of bound-off sts, \* [sl st, ch 3, sl st] in next st (picot made), sl st in next st; rep from \* to last st, [sl st, ch 3, sl st] in last st. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends but do not trim. Wet or steam block, stretching to enhance lace. Once piece is fully dry, trim ends close to work.

ssk slip next 2 sts individually

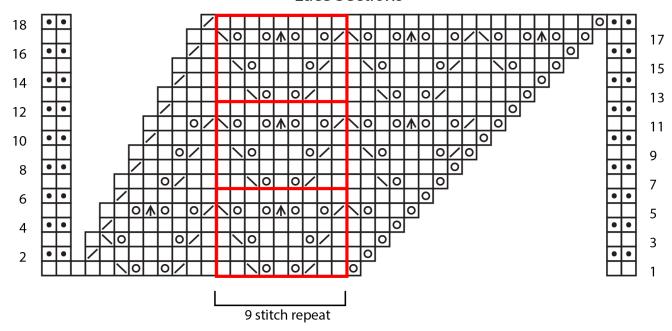

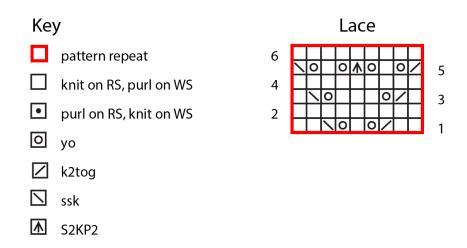
