### SKILL

Crochet

#### **DIFFICULTY**

Easy

#### **SIZES**

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 72" Length: 17"

#### **MATERIALS**

<u>Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop</u> (50% Bamboo, 50% Cotton; 100g/292 yds)

130 Sage - 4 balls

<u>Universal Yarn Cotton Gold</u> (65% Cotton, 8% Metallic, 27% Payette; 25g/200 yds)

> • 1103 Topiary with Silver Sequins - 6 balls

Hook: US Size G/6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

14½ sts x 10 rows = 4" in Rippling Pattern, after blocking, with both yarns held together.

Save time, check your gauge.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Undulating eyelets dance across the length of this wrap, creating a mesmerizing pattern. Bejeweled with sparkles and sequins, it entrances all who behold it. Dress up any look with this breathtaking accessory – it doesn't take a fortune teller to know that your future outfits will look great!

This wrap is worked flat from the bottom up along the widest edge. Both yarns are held together for the whole project.

#### STITCH GUIDE Rippling Pattern

turn

Ch a mult of 16 + 2.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk, sc in next ch, \* ch 1, sk next ch, hdc in next ch, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, [ch 1, sk next ch, tr in next ch] 2 times, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, sk next ch, hdc in next ch, [ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st] 2 times; rep from \* across until 2 sts rem, sc in last 2 sts,

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch-sp across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in 1st and each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, \* [sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp] 2 times, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, [tr in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp] 2 times, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp; rep from \* across until 10 sts/sps rem, [sc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st or sp, tr in next 2 sts, turn.

Row 5: Rep Row 4.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Row 7: Rep Row 3.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first and next st, \* ch 1, sk next st or sp, hdc in next ch, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next ch, [ch 1, sk next st or sp, tr in next ch] 2 times, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next st or sp, hdc in next ch, [ch 1, sk next st or sp, sc in next st] 2 times; rep from \* across until 15 sts/sps rem, ch 1, sk next st or sp, hdc in next ch, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next ch, [ch 1, sk next st or sp, tr in next ch] 2 times, ch 1, sk next st or sp, dc in next st or sp, hdc in next ch, ch 1, sc in last 2 sts, turn

Row 9: Rep Row 8. Rep Rows 2-9 for patt

#### **PATTERN BEGINS**

#### Wrap

With both yarns held together, ch 258.

Row 1: Work Row 1 of Rippling Pattern – 127 ch sp, 130, 257 total sts; patt will be repeated 16 times across row.

Rows 2-41: Rep Rows 2-9 of Rippling Pattern, 5 times.

Row 42: Rep Row 2 of Rippling Pattern, 1 more time. Do not Fasten off.

#### Border

Rnd 1: Ch 1, \* sc in each st or sp across the row until 1 st rem, 3 sc in rem st (corner made), sc in the side of each st *placing 1 sc per sc st and 3 sc per tr st* until 1 st rem, 3 sc in rem st (corner made); rep from \* 1 more time ending with 2 sc in same st as beginning sc, sl st to 1st sc. Fasten Off.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.


