



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Clematis Cowl

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Depth: 11¼"

Circumference: 48"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Classic Shades Sequins Lite* (74% acrylic, 22% wool, 4% payette; 100g/263 yds)

- 405 Primrose – 2 skeins

Needle: US Size 6 (4 mm) 40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in Twisting Eyelets patt with larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This unique, yet easy to memorize lace pattern utilizes twisted knit stitches for an extra bit of pop. The sequins in Classic Shades Sequins Lite scatter across the fabric while you knit like clematis climbing along a garden trellis.

This cowl is long enough to wrap twice around the neck. The three-stitch Twisting Eyelets pattern is easy enough to adjust if you prefer a shorter or longer cowl. Just be sure to cast on a multiple of three stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Twisted Stockinette

(any number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Twisting Eyelets

(repeat of 3 sts)

Rnd 1: * Yo, sl 1 pwise wyib, [k1 tbl] 2 times, pssso the 2 twisted sts; rep from * to end.

Rnds 2-4: * K1 tbl; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

COWL

Bottom Edge

With smaller ndl, cast on 216 sts. PM and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 3 more times.

Establish Pattern

Change to larger ndl.

Work in Twisted Stockinette for 5 rnds.

Work Rnds 1-4 of Twisting Eyelets patt 12 times, then work Rnd 1 of Twisting Eyelets patt 1 more time. Patt will be repeated 72 times across each rnd.

Work in Twisted Stockinette for 5 rnds.

Top Edge

Change to smaller ndl.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 3 more times. Loosely bind off all sts pwise.


FINISHING

Weave in ends but do not trim. Gently wet or steam block, stretching to enhance eyelets. Once piece is fully dry, trim ends close to work.

Abbreviations

k	knit
ndl	needle
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
pssso	pass slipped stitch(es) over
pwise	purlwise
rep	repeat
rnd	round
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
wyib	with yarn held in back
yo	yarn over
