DIFFICULTY

Basic

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 23¼"

Height: 12½"

MATERIALS

Rozette Yarns Nymph (84% cotton, 16% polyamide; 50g/125 yds)

• 110 Lichen - 4 balls

Hook: US Size G/6 (4 mm) or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

19 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Cobbled Stitch

PATTERN NOTES

Looking to make the basics a bit more interesting? Look no further than the richly textured Cobbled Cowl! Crocheted with delightfully soft Nymph, the structure of the stitches is balanced out beautifully by the fluffy halo this yarn boasts. The result is a quick and joyful project you'll turn to again and again.

This cowl is worked flat from the bottom up, then seamed to create a loop.

STITCH GUIDE

Double Triple Crochet (dtr)

[Yo] 3 times, insert hk into indicated st, yo, pull up lp (5 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 (4 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (3 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo draw through rem 2 lps on hk.

Cobbled Stitch

Ch an even number of sts.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2^{nd} ch from hk and each ch across, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 1, sc in same st, * dtr in next st, sc in next st; rep from * across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in same and each st across, turn. Rep Rows 2-3 for patt, ending on an odd row.

PATTERN BEGINS

COWL

Ch 112.

Row 1: Work Row 1 of Cobbled Stitch patt - 111 sc. Rows 2-57: Rep Rows 2-3 of Cobbled Stitch patt. Do not fasten off.

Seam Cowl

Turn work sideways and fold in half so right sides face each other. SI st evenly across both edges to join and form a loop. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.



Abbreviations

ch chain dtr double triple crochet hk hook lp(s) loop(s) patt pattern rem remain(ing) repeat rep right side RS single crochet SC sl slip stitch(es) st(s) WS wrong side

ws wrong sid yo yarn over
