#### Cobblesocks

#### DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

#### SIZES

Adult Large

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Foot Circumference: 9"

Foot Length: Adjustable

#### MATERIALS

[Fibra Natura Cobblestone](#) (100% superwash merino wool; 200g/612 yds)

- 105 Mallard - 1 ball

**Needles:** US Size 4 (3.5 mm) set of DPNs or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

#### GAUGE

23 sts x 32 rnds = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st)

Save time check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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## PATTERN NOTES

Chilly weather always makes us dream of warm and woolly socks. The Cobblesocks, worked in gorgeous, variegated Cobblestone, are the perfect pair to add to your sock drawer this season! The best part? One ball will easily make two pairs of socks – make a pair for yourself and a pair to give away!

These socks are knit in the round from the toe-up. In this pattern, slip all stitches purlwise.

### Judy's Magic Cast On (JMCO)

Hold two needles in your right hand, they will be referred to as the front and back needle. Place the yarn over the back needle with the working end hanging between the two needles and the tail hanging in the back – 1 st CO.

1. Hold the 2 ends in your left hand with the tail around your index finger and the working yarn around your thumb.
2. Bring the tail forward and wrap around the front needle from front to back, and down between the needles – 1 st CO front needle.
3. Bring the working yarn up between the 2 needles, the over the back needle from front to back – 1 st CO back needle.

Rep steps 3-4 until the correct number of stitches have been CO, ending with step 3.

## STITCH GUIDE

### K3, P1 Rib

(multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \* K3, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

## SOCKS

*Make two.*

### Toe

Using JMCO, cast on 24 sts. Evenly distribute sts between dpns. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

**Set-up Rnd 1:** K12, pm, k12.

**Inc Rnd:** \* K1, m1R, knit to 1 st bef m, m1L, k1; rep from \* one more time – 4 sts inc'd, 28 sts.

**Even Rnd:** Knit.

Rep Inc Rnd and Even Rnd, 6 more times – 24 sts inc'd, 52 sts.

### Foot

Work even in St st until foot meas 8", or 2" less than your desired foot length, measuring from cast-on.

### Gusset

**Rnd 1:** Knit to m, sl m, k1, m1L, knit to 1 st bef end, m1R, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 54 sts.

**Rnd 2:** Knit to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2, 7 more times – 14 sts inc'd; 26 Instep sts, 42 Gusset sts; 68 sts total. *Note: You will now begin working across the Gusset sts while the Instep sts are on hold.*

### Heel Extension

**Set-up Row (RS):** K13, pm, ssk, k14, pm, turn – 1 st dec'd, 15 sts bet markers.

**Row 1 (WS):** P2tog, p13, turn – 1 st dec'd, 14 sts bet markers.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ssk, knit to m, turn – 1 st dec'd, 13 sts bet markers.

Rep Rows 1-2, 3 more times, then rep Row 1, one more time, turn – 7 sts dec'd, 6 sts bet markers.

### Heel Flap

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1, k5, remove m, pick up and knit 9 sts along the decrease edge of Heel Extension, turn.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** PM, sl 1, p14, pick up and knit 9 stitches along decrease edge of Heel Extension, turn – 24 sts bet markers.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1, [k1, sl 1] to 1 st bef m, ssk (next st with 1<sup>st</sup> st after the m), turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl 1, purl to 1 st bef m, p2tog (next st with 1<sup>st</sup> st after the m), turn.

Rep Rows 1-2, 10 more times – 20 sts dec'd. 54 total sts rem.

### Leg

**Set-up Rnd:** [Sl 1, k1] 11 times, sl 1, ssk (next st with 1<sup>st</sup> st after the m, removing m as you come to it), k26 Instep sts, k2tog (next st with 1<sup>st</sup> st after the m, removing m as you come to it), PM to denote new bor – 2 sts dec'd, 52 sts rem.

Work in K3, P1 Rib until Leg meas approx. 6", or desired length. Bind off all sts loosely in patt.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

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## Abbreviations

bor	beginning of round
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1P	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
m1R	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd	round
RS	right side
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side



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
