The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, times or rows are  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right)$ worked for this size.

After casting off one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

**IMPORTANT** To ensure accuracy only RICO YARNS are suitable. No responsibility will be taken for the result of using any other yarns.

# Creative Melange chunky















#### **SWEATER**

#### **TENSION**

16 sts and 24 rows to 10 cm, (4 in), over pattern on 6 mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tansion

#### **BACK**

Using 5 mm needles and thumb method cast on 50[54:58] sts.

**1st Row (RS).** K1, \*k1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1. Last row sets rib.

Cont in rib until work measures 10 cm, (4 in), ending with a rs row.

**Next Row.** Patt1, (m1, patt1) 14[12:10] times, (m1, patt2) 10[14:18] times, (m1, patt1) 14[12:10] times, m1, patt1. 89[93:97] sts.

Change to 6 mm needles and proceed as follows: **Next Row.** K1, \*k1, yfrt, s1p, ybk, rep from \* to last 2 ste k2

**Next Row.** K1, \*yfrt, s1p, ybk, knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), rep from \* to last 2 sts, yfrt, s1p, ybk, k1.

**Next Row.** K1, \*knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), yfrt, s1p, ybk, rep from \* to last 2 sts, knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), k1.

Last 2 rows set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt correct (throughout) cont until work measures 25[26:27] cm, (9%[10%:10%] in), ending with a ws row.

#### Shape armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 81[85:89] sts.\*\*
Cont without shaping until armhole measures
26[27:28] cm, (101/4[103/:11] in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape shoulders

Cast off 8 sts at beg of next 6 rows. 33[37:41] sts. Cast off.

#### FRONT

Work exactly as given for Back to \*\*. Cont without shaping until armhole measures 22[23:24] cm, (8¾[9:9½] in), ending with a ws row.

#### Shape neck

**Next Row.** Patt35[36:37] sts, turn and leave rem 46[49:52] sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 35[36:37] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Cast off 4 sts, patt to end. 31[32:33] sts. Work 1 row.

**Next Row.** Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 28[29:30] sts. Work 2[5:6] rows dec 1 st at neck edge on every row. 26[24:24] sts.

### For 1st size only

Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge on next and foll alt row. 24 sts.

# For all 3 sizes

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 26[27:28] cm, (10¼[10¾:11] in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 46[49:52] sts left

on a stitch holder, cast off 11[13:15] sts, patt to end. 35[36:37] sts.

Work 1 row.

Next Row. Cast off 4 sts, patt to end. 31[32:33] sts.

**Next Row.** Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 28[29:30] sts. Work 2[5:6] rows dec 1 st at neck edge on every row. 26[24:24] sts.

#### For 1st size only

Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge on next and foll alt row. 24 sts.

#### For all 3 sizes

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 26[27:28] cm, (10¼[10¾:11] in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

#### SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 5 mm needles and thumb method cast on 48[52:56] sts.

Work in rib as set for Back until work measures 8 cm, (3 in), ending with a rs row.

**Next Row.** Patt1, (m1, patt1) 12[8:6] times, (m1, patt2) 11[17:21] times, (m1, patt1) 12[8:6] times, m1, patt1. 84[86:90] sts.

Change to 6 mm needles and proceed as follows: **Next Row.** K1, \*k1, yfrt, s1p, ybk, rep from \* to last

**Next Row.** K1, knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row) \*yfrt, s1p, ybk, knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), rep from \* to last 2 sts, yfrt, s1p, ybk, k1.

**Next Row.** K1, \*knit tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), yfrt, s1p, ybk, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Last 2 rows set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt correct (throughout) cont until work measures 43[44:45] cm, (17[171/:173/] in), ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

Using 5 mm needles pick up and knit 12 sts evenly down left side of neck, 11[13:15] sts evenly across cast off sts at front neck, 12 sts evenly up right side of neck and 33[37:41] sts evenly across back neck. 68[74:80] sts. Starting with a ws row, work 7 rows in rib as set for Back

Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position. Join side seams. Join sleeve seams. Block out garment to the measurements given and place under damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and care instructions.

# SCARF

#### TENSION

22 sts and 44 rows to 10 cm, (4 in), over pattern on 4 mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

### INSTRUCTION

Using 4 mm needles and thumb method cast on 77 sts. **1st Row (WS).** \*K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Next Row (RS).** K1, \*yfrt, s1p, ybk, p1, rep from \* to last 2 sts, yfrt, s1p, ybk, k1.

**Next Row.** K1, \*purl tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), k1, rep from \* to last 3 sts, purl tog next st and loop across st (yfrt and s1p of previous row), k1.

Last 2 rows set patt.


Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) cont until work measures 200 cm, (78¾ in), ending with a ws row.

Cast off in patt.

#### TO MAKE UP

Block out garment to the measurements given and place under damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and care instructions.





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
