Confetti Scrunchie

SKILL

Crochet

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximate Diameter: 4"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Bella Chenille (100% polyester; 100g/131 yds)

- 101 Snowy - 1 ball

Universal Yarn Bella Pom Pom (78% polyamide, 22% polyester; 50g/334 yds)

- 101 Neon Fun - 1 ball

Hook: US Size J/10 (6 mm) round or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, standard hair tie elastic

GAUGE

11 sts x 7 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Whether adorning your wrist or atop your head, this cute scrunchie will be your favorite small accessory for any outfit. The vibrant confetti-like pom poms sprinkle in a dash of fun, perfecting the trendy look!

This pattern is crocheted in continuous rounds and is easily adjustable to add or remove length. If you prefer a smoother looking Scrunchie, work less than the indicated rounds. If you prefer a more scrunched-looking Scrunchie, work more than the indicated rounds.

Place a removable stitch marker in the first stitch made, then move it up each round to denote the beginning of the round.

The gauge listed for this pattern is suggested based on the sample, though gauge is not critical to the success of this pattern.

PATTERN BEGINS

SCRUNCHIE

Note: You will be working around the hair tie elastic and may need to untwist your work as you progress.

Ch 10, thread ch through the hair tie elastic, sl st to 1st ch to make a circle.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc, pm, hdc in next and each ch around, do not turn - 10 sts.

Rnd 2: Hdc in marked sc, move m up, hdc in next and each st around, do not turn.

Rnd 3-15: Hdc in marked st, move m up, hdc in next and each st around, do not turn.

Rnd 16: Hdc in marked st, move m up, hdc in next 8 sts, sc in last st before m, sl st in marked st. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming.

Seaming

Before seaming, you may wish to purposely add some twists to the Scrunchie to create additional texture. Align the stitches from the base of the first row to the top of the last row. Using a tapestry needle, whip stitch through both sets of stitches to close the Scrunchie. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
