

# Pattern Collection: Home



**Corner to Corner Throw** Designed by Alice Gossette and Kat Koeller

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS** 48" wide x 50" tall

## MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn** *Classic Shades* (70% acrylic, 30% wool; 100g/197 yds)

• 731 Natural Glow (MC) – 9 balls Universal Yarn Uptown Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

 328 Dijon (CC) – 1 ball
Hook: US Size J-10 (6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

4 Blocks x 9 rows = 4" Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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## **PATTERN NOTES**

This throw is worked from one corner to the other. For best results, match the beginning and end of each yarn ball to another ball with a similar color start to determine order of use. Label each ball band with the order it will be used (example: ball 1, 2, 3, etc). This throw uses about 80g to complete with the remainder used to match yarn colorway repeats.

#### THROW

With MC, ch 6.

#### **Increase Section**

**Row 1:** Dc in fourth ch from hk and next 2 ch, turn – 1 Block.

**Row 2:** Ch 6, dc in fourth ch from hk and next 2 ch (Beg Block made), sk next 3 dc, sl st in top of ch-3 sp, 3 dc in side of same dc (Block made), turn - 2 Blocks.

**Row 3:** Ch 6, dc in fourth ch from hk and next 2 ch (Beg Block made), [sk next 3 dc, sl st in top of ch-3 sp, 3 dc in side of same dc (Block made)] 2 times, turn – 3 Blocks.

Rep Row 3 until approximately 4 skeins of MC have been used, then work 3 more rows.

#### **Decrease Section**

**Row 1:** SI st in next 3 dc, [sk next 3 dc, sI st in top of ch-3 sp, 3 dc in side of same dc (Block made)] to last ch-3 sp, sI st in last ch-3 sp, turn – 1 Block dec'd.

Rep Row 1 until 1 Block rem. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING


Weave in ends.

### Fringe

Cut 300, 16" pieces of CC. Holding 3 strands tog as one, attach groups to two opposide sides of throw approx. every inch. Trim ends even. Block lightly.
