SIZE

Adult Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 20¼" (stretches to 24")

Height: 9½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Deluxe DK Tweed Superwash* (90% superwash wool, 7% acrylic, 3% viscose; 100g/284 yds)

• 403 Hazelnut – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 16"' circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker,

2 cable needles

GAUGE

22 sts x 29 rows = 4" in Slip Stitch patt Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

The Cosign Cap is the perfect project to kick off the autumn season. Rich in color, this hat combines a gorgeous slip-stitch texture with an all-time favorite yarn: Deluxe DK Tweed. The tweedy nubs perfectly compliment slipped-stitch patterning. Simple to knit and to wear; you'll want to get this quick project on your needles as soon as possible!

This hat is knit in the round from the brim upward to the crown. It features cables with slipped stitches that appear as columns of diamonds across the fabric. This makes a good first cable project for those new to crossed stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

1x2 Right Slipped Cross (RSC): Slip next 2 sts to cn and hold in back, slip next st to right ndl, k2 from back cn.

1x2 Left Slipped Cross (LSC): Slip next st to cn and hold in front, k2 from left ndl, sI the st from the cn to the right ndl without knitting.

Slip Stitch (multiple of 8 sts)

Rnd 1: * K4, [sl 1 pwise wyib] 2 times, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8: Knit.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 5: * K2, 1x2 RSC, 1x2 LSC; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: * K2, sl 1 pwise wyib, k4, sl 1 pwise wyib;

rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: * K2, 1x2 LSC, 1x2 RSC; rep from * to end.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-10 for patt.

HAT

Brim

With smaller ndl, cast on 112 sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 until Brim meas 2".

Hat Body

Switch to larger ndl. Rep Rnds 1-10 of Slip Stitch patt, 5 times. Patt will be repeated 14 times each rnd. Hat meas approx 7½" from cast-on edge.

Shape Crown

Note: For your convenience, crown shaping is both written and charted. When there are too many sts to fit comfortably on circ ndl, switch to

Rnd 1: * K2tog, k2, [sl 1 pwise wyib] 2 times, k2; rep from * to end – 98 sts rem.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: * K2tog, k1, [sl 1 pwise wyib] 2 times, k2; rep from * to end – 84 sts rem.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: * K2tog, [sl 1 pwise wyib] 2 times, k2; rep from * to end – 70 sts rem.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: * K2tog, k3; rep from * to end – 56 sts

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: * K2tog, k2; rep from * to end – 42 sts

Rnd 10: * K2tog, k1; rep from * to end – 28 sts rem.

Rnd 11: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 14 sts rem. Break yarn leaving 8" tail. Pass tail through rem live sts, pull taut, fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!




