# **Cozy Snood**

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 19" (unstretched)

**Depth:** 13"

## **MATERIALS**

Fibra Natura *Dona* (100% extra fine merino

superwash; 50g/126 yds)

• 113 Orchid Organza – 3 balls

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

## **GAUGE**

21 sts x 26 rows = 4" in Brioche Rib pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This cowl/snood is worked flat and seamed. Wear it folded over as shown for a warm cowl that fits nicely in the neckline of a winter coat. Unfold it and bring it over your ears on cold days.

## **STITCH GUIDE**

#### **Brioche Rib**

(even number of sts)

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Knit 1, \* knit 1, knit 1 by insterting needle into center of next stitch of row bwlow, then drop unworked stitch above off left needle without working it; repeat from \* to last stitch, knit 1. Repeat Row 2 for pattern.

#### **SNOOD**

Cast on 100 stitches loosely.

Work Row 1 of Brioche Rib pattern, then repeat
Row 2 of pattern until piece measures 13" from
cast on edge. Bind off all stitches loosely.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Block piece. Sew sides together.
