Difficulty

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 49"

Depth at center: 20"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Be Wool* (60% acrylic, 40% wool; 200g/94 yds)

- 104 Jupiter (MC) – 2 balls
- 111 Pistachio (CC) – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 17 (12 mm) set of dpns, 32" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

7 sts x 14 rows = 4" in garter stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Simple stripes, a bit of texture, and soft, chunky Be Wool come together to create the perfect shawl. This is a great beginner project, but we think every knitter will enjoy it. It works up so quickly and is perfect as a gift to yourself or to a loved one.

This shawl is knit flat from the top down and begins with a garter tab cast-on. Four stitches are increased every right side row and two stitches are increased every wrong side row. When working in the Garter Stripes Section, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, carry the yarn up the side of the work and twist the strands of yarn around one another every color change, taking care not to twist too tightly.

STITCH GUIDE

Seed

(multiple of 2 sts, plus 1)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

SHAWL

Starting Tab

With CC, cast on 2 sts. Knit 7 rows in garter st.

Set-up Row (WS): K2, rotate work 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 sts from side of Tab, pick up and knit 2 sts from cast-on edge – 7 sts.

Garter Stripes Section

Row 1 (RS): With CC, k2, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, k1, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, k2 – 4 sts inc'd, 11 sts.

Row 2 (WS): With CC, k2, sl m, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, sl m, k2 – 2 sts inc'd, 13 sts.

Row 3: With MC, k2, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k2 – 4 sts inc'd, 17 sts.

Row 4: With MC, k2, sl m, yo, knit to last 2 sts, yo, sl m, k2 – 2 sts inc'd, 19 sts.

Row 5: With CC, rep Row 3 – 4 sts inc'd, 23 sts.

Row 6: With CC, rep Row 4 – 2 sts inc'd, 25 sts.

Rep Rows 3-6, 6 more times, then rep Rows 3-4, one more time – 78 sts inc'd, 103 sts. Break CC, cont with MC only.

Seed Section

Row 1 (RS): K2, sl m, yo, work Row 1 of Seed patt to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, work Row 1 of Seed patt to m, yo, sl m, k2 – 107 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K2, sl m, yo, work Row 2 of Seed patt to m, sl m, k1, sl m, work Row 2 of Seed patt to m, yo, sl m, k2 – 2 sts inc'd, 109 sts.

Rep Rows 1-2, 5 more times – 30 sts inc'd, 139 sts.

Next Row (RS): K2, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k2 – 4 sts inc'd, 143 sts. Bind off all sts kwise.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
