





# **Ebony Pullover**

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Shown in Medium size with approx. 12½" of positive ease.

# **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Bust: 40½ (44¼, 48½, 52¼, 56½, 60¼,

64½, 68¼, 72½)"

Length: 18¼ (18¾, 19¼, 20¼, 20¾, 21¼,

22¼, 22¾, 23¼)"

# **MATERIALS**

Universal Yarn Bella Cash (60% fine merino superwash, 30% nylon, 10% cashmere; 50g/230 yds)

- 108 Ebony (MC) 6 (7, 8, 8, 9, 10, 11, 11, 12) balls
- 109 Snow (CC) 1 ball (all sizes)

Needles: US Size 3 (3.25 mm) straight (or your preferred needle for knitting flat) or size needed to obtain gauge US Size 2 (2.75 mm) 16" circular **Notions:** Tapestry needle, removable

stitch markers, stitch marker, stitch holders or waste yarn

# **GAUGE**

26 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st) with larger ndl Save time, check your gauge.

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Much like the famed little black dress, every wardrobe needs a neutral sweater that goes with everything. Perfect for the capsule wardrobe, the Ebony sweater is knit in luxurious Bella Cash — a blend of superwash merino, cashmere, and nylon. This piece features a ribbed hem in classic black and white. Drop sleeves, a generous amount of positive ease, and a turtleneck create the ultimate cozy pullover.

This sweater is intended to be worn with a generous amount of positive ease around the bust. Working a size with less positive ease may result in sleeves that are too snug, so we recommend choosing the size with the upper arm circumference closest to your own upper arm measurement.

This pullover is knit flat in pieces from the bottom up and seamed. After seaming, the neck band is picked up and worked in the round.

#### STITCH GUIDE

**Two Color Rib** 

(multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1 (RS): \* MC p1, CC k1; rep from \* to end. Row 2 (WS): \* CC p1, MC k1; rep from \* to end. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

#### **K1, P1 Rib**

(multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end. Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

# **BACK**

### Hem

With MC and larger ndl, cast on 134 (146, 160, 172, 186, 198, 212, 224, 238) sts.

Set-up Row 1 (RS): \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end. Set-up Row 2 (WS): \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end. Join CC, do not break MC.

Work in Two Color Rib until piece meas 1½" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. Break CC, cont with MC only.

# Body

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

# Row 2 (RS): Purl.

Cont in St st until piece meas 12% (12%, 12%, 12%, 12%, 13%, 13%, 13%, 13%)" from cast-on edge. Place a removable marker on each side to indicate armholes. Cont as est'd until piece meas 4% (5%, 5%, 6%, 6%, 7%, 7%, 8%, 8%)" from armhole markers.

#### **Shape Back Neck**

**Next Row (RS):** K46 (52, 59, 64, 71, 77, 83, 89, 96) Right Back sts, bind off center 42 (42, 42, 44, 44, 46, 46, 46) Back Neck sts, k46 (52, 59, 64, 71, 77, 83, 89, 96) Left Back sts. Place Right Back sts on holder.

#### **Left Back**

WS Rows 1-5: Purl.

**Row 2 (RS):** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 44 (50, 57, 62, 69, 75, 81, 87, 94) sts rem.

**Row 4:** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 42 (48, 55, 60, 67, 73, 79, 85, 92) sts rem.

**Row 6:** Bind off 1, cont as est'd to end – 41 (47, 54, 59, 66, 72, 78, 84, 91) sts rem.

Cont even in St st until piece 6 (6½, 7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9, 9½, 10)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder or waste yarn. Return Right Back sts to needle.

# **Right Back**

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 44 (50, 57, 62, 69, 75, 81, 87, 94) sts rem.

RS Rows 2-4: Knit.

**Row 3:** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 42 (48, 55, 60, 67, 73, 79, 85, 92) sts rem.

**Row 5:** Bind off 1, cont as est'd to end – 41 (47, 54, 59, 66, 72, 78, 84, 91) sts rem. Cont even in St st until piece 6 (6½, 7, 7½, 8, 8½,

9, 9½, 10)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder or waste yarn.

#### **FRONT**

Work as for Back until piece meas 4 ( $4\frac{1}{2}$ , 5,  $5\frac{1}{2}$ , 6,  $6\frac{1}{2}$ , 7,  $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 8)" from armhole markers.

# **Shape Front Neck**

**Next Row (RS):** K56 (62, 69, 74, 81, 87, 93, 99, 106) Left Front sts, bind off center 22 (22, 22, 24, 24, 24, 26, 26, 26) Front Neck sts, k56 (62, 69, 74, 81, 87, 93, 99, 106) Right Front sts. Place Left Front sts on holder.

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# **Right Front**

WS Rows 1-9 (WS): Purl.

**Row 2 (RS):** Bind off 5, cont as est'd to end – 51 (57, 64, 69, 76, 82, 88, 94, 101) sts rem.

**Row 4:** Bind off 4, cont as est'd to end – 47 (53, 60, 65, 72, 78, 84, 90, 97) sts rem.

**Row 6:** Bind off 3, cont as est'd to end – 44 (50,

57, 62, 69, 75, 81, 87, 94) sts rem.

**Row 8:** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 42 (48,

55, 60, 67, 73, 79, 85, 92) sts rem. **Row 10:** Bind off 1, cont as est'd to end – 41 (47, 54, 59, 66, 72, 78, 84, 91) sts rem.

Cont even in St st until piece 6 (6½, 7,  $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 8,  $8\frac{1}{2}$ , 9,  $9\frac{1}{2}$ , 10)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder or waste yarn.

Return Left Front sts to needle.

# **Left Front**

**Row 1 (WS):** Bind off 5, cont as est'd to end – 51 (57, 64, 69, 76, 82, 88, 94, 101) sts rem.

RS Rows 2-10: Knit.

**Row 3:** Bind off 4, cont as est'd to end – 47 (53, 60, 65, 72, 78, 84, 90, 97) sts rem.

**Row 5:** Bind off 3, cont as est'd to end – 44 (50, 57, 62, 69, 75, 81, 87, 94) sts rem.

**Row 7:** Bind off 2, cont as est'd to end – 42 (48, 55, 60, 67, 73, 79, 85, 92) sts rem.

**Row 9:** Bind off 1, cont as est'd to end – 41 (47, 54, 59, 66, 72, 78, 84, 91) sts rem.

Cont even in St st until piece 6 (6½, 7,  $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 8,  $8\frac{1}{2}$ , 9,  $9\frac{1}{2}$ , 10)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder or waste yarn.

# **SLEEVES**

#### Cuff

With MC and larger ndl, cast on 54 (54, 54, 56, 56, 56, 58, 58, 58) sts.

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end. **Set-up Row 2 (WS):** \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end. Join CC, do not break MC.

Work in Two Color Rib until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. Break CC, cont with MC only.

**Main Sleeve** 

Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 (RS): Purl.

**Inc Row:** K1, m1R, knit to last st, m1L, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 56 (56, 56, 58, 58, 58, 60, 60, 60) sts.



Rep Inc Row every 8 (6, 4, 4, 4, 0, 2, 2, 2) rows, 6 (6, 3, 9, 18, 0, 6, 12, 18) more times, then rep Inc Row every 10 (8, 6, 6, 6, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows, 5 (8, 15, 11, 5, 26, 23, 20, 17) times – 22 (28, 36, 40, 46, 52, 58, 64, 70) sts inc'd, 78 (84, 92, 98, 104, 110, 118, 124, 130) sts.

Work even in St st until piece meas 14%" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block pieces to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

With RS facing together, join Left Front and Left Back sts using the three-needle bind-off. Rep for Right Front and Right Back shoulders. Sew Sleeves to body, using armhole markers as a guide. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

#### **Neck Edging**

With smaller ndl and MC, beg at right shoulder, pick up and knit 130 (130, 130, 134, 134, 134, 138, 138, 138) sts evenly around neck edge. PM and join in the rnd. Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 6½" from picked-up edge. Bind off all sts in patt.

Weave in rem ends.


