DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width along Longest Edge: 53½"

Depth in Center: 22"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Sock](#) (55% bamboo, 37% cotton, 8% PBT; 100g/492 yds)

- 506 Rip Tide (A) - 1 ball
- 503 Jetties (B) - 1 ball

[Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Sock Solids](#) (55% bamboo, 37% cotton, 8% PBT; 100g/492 yds)

- 620 Moondust (C) - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 24" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn

GAUGE

22 sts x 44 rows = 4" in garter stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Perfect for a confident beginner, Exhilarate Revisited reintroduces one of our beloved shawl patterns and marries it with fan-favorite Bamboo Pop Sock! We've paired solids and self-shading colors in this glorious garter stitch accessory. Looking to build your skills? We've implemented a touch of intarsia and striping for a colorful effect sure to turn heads. This accessory is so lightweight and drapery – it's perfect for summer!

This shawl is worked modularly in 4 sections. This pattern includes a diagram to help you visualize the construction. Sections 1 and 2 are worked using the intarsia method. When switching to a new color in the same row, bring the new color up and around the previous color to prevent holes from forming in the work. Wind off a ball of yarn for each different color segment. Stitches are picked up along the side of Section 1, and Section 2 is worked in a different direction.

I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. * K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from * until all sts have been bound off.

PATTEN BEGINS

SHAWL

Section 1

With color A, cast on 20 sts, pm, with color B, cast on 30 sts – 50 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With B, knit to m, with A, knit to end.

Row 2 (WS): With A, knit to m, with B, knit to end.

Rows 3-230: Cont in patt as est'd to end.

Row 231: Ssk, work to end – 49 sts rem.

Row 232: Cont in patt as est'd to end.

Rows 233-330: Rep Rows 231-232. After all the color A sts have been dec'd, cont using color B only. Fasten off last st.

Section 2

C Stripe

Pick up (*do not pick up and knit, just pick up*) 115 sts along the short/B side of Section 1 by sliding ndl through the very outer edge of each garter st ridge.

Row 1 (RS): With color C, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog – 1 st dec'd, 114 sts rem.

Row 2: Knit.

Rows 3-12: Rep Rows 1-2, 5 times – 5 sts dec'd, 109 sts rem.

Intarsia Section

Note: Use a separate length of yarn for each section.

Row 1: With color A k34, pm, with color C k4, pm, with color B k14, pm, with color A k10, pm, with color B k20, pm, with color A knit to last 2 sts, k2tog – 108 sts rem.

Row 2: [With color A knit to m, with color B knit to m] 2 times, with color C knit to m, with color A knit to end.

Rows 3-218: Rep Rows 1-2. As a color section is ended when there are no more sts in that color rem, break yarn of that color. Fasten off last st.

Section 3

Pick up (*do not pick up and knit, just pick up*) 165 sts along combined Section 1 & Section 2, using diagram as a guide.

Row 1 (RS): With color C, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 1 st inc'd, 166 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Rows 3-22: Rep Rows 1-2 – 10 sts inc'd, 176 sts. Place sts on holder or waste yarn.

Section 4

Pick up (*do not pick up and knit, just pick up*) 176 sts along long/A side of Section 1 and edge of Section 3.

Row 1 (RS): With color C, k1, m1, knit to end – 1 st inc'd, 177 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Rows 3-22: Rep Rows 1-2 – 10 sts inc'd, 187 sts.

Bind off all sts using I-Cord Bind-off, work 2 rows of I-Cord without joining (corner turned), work applied I-Cord along end of Section 4, bind off held sts from Section 3 using I-Cord Bind-off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Run blocking wires along all sides of shawl. Pin to blocking mats. Steam or wet block to finished measurements.

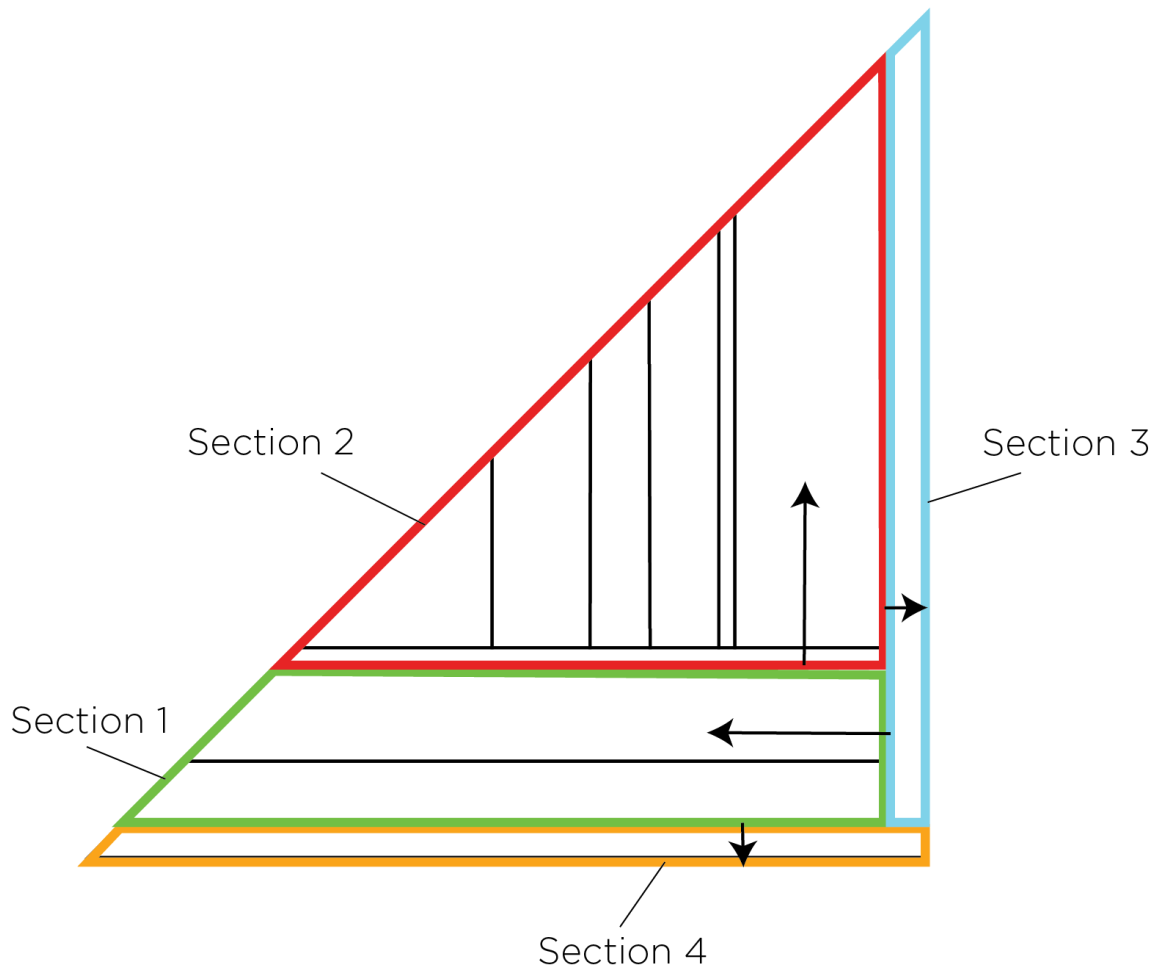

 garter st knit every row
 inc('d) increase(d)
 k knit
 k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

 m marker
 m1 insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

 ndl

 ssk
