Fern Wrap

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 16"

Length: 60"

MATERIALS

Nazli Gelin Garden 10 (100% mercerized Egyptian Giza cotton); 50 g/306 yds)

- 700-35 (MC) – 4 balls
- 700-16 (CC) – 2 balls

Hook: US 8 steel (1.25mm) crochet hook
or size needed to obtain gauge.

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

3 pattern repeats = 3¼"; 12 rows = 2½"
in Flower Pattern.

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Originally part of the print-only *Garden Book 4: Garden Romance*, the Fern Wrap is being set free. This beautiful wrap is a special, heirloom piece perfect to create and wear on warm summer days. The Fern Wrap is worked flat in one piece and features a flower motif broken up by contrast-color stripes. It is finished with a tidy single crochet edging. This shawl is written with a right side and wrong side to help you stay on track but is completely reversible when worn.

WRAP

With MC, ch 197.

Flower Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 8th ch from hk (counts as ch 2, dc, ch 2), * ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across, turn – 64 ch-2 sps.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 throughout), dc in next dc, * ch 6, sk next dc, (sc, ch 3, 2 tr) in next dc, sk next dc, (2 tr, ch 3, sc) in next dc; rep from * across to last 3 dc, ch 6, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 5, dc in next dc, * ch 4, sc in ch-6 sp, ch 4, sk next tr, (2 tr, ch 3, sc, ch 3, 2 tr) in next tr; rep from * across, end with ch 4, sc in last ch-6 sp, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in last dc, turn – 15 Flowers.

Row 4: With CC, ch 5, dc in next dc, * ch 5, sc in next tr, ch 5, sk next tr, sc in next tr; rep from * across, end with ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as sc, ch 2), sc in next dc, * 5 sc in next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * across, end with ch 5, sc in next dc, ch 2, sc in last dc, turn.

Row 6: With MC, ch 5, dc in next sc, * ch 6, sk 5 sc, (sc, ch 3, 2 tr) in next sc, sk next 5 sc, (2 tr, ch 3, sc) in next sc; rep from * across, end with ch 6, sk next 5 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in last sc, turn. Rep Rows 3-6 until piece meas approx. 60", ending with Row 3.

Next Row: With MC, rep Row 4.

Final Row: Ch 5, dc in next dc, * ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, dc in next sc; rep from * across, ending with ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in last dc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends but do not trim. Block to finished measurements, stretching to enhance lace. Once piece is fully dry, trim ends close to work.

Edging

Beg at any corner, join CC. Sc evenly around, sl st in first sc to join. Fasten off. Weave in rem ends.
