

Pattern Collection: Accessories



Florin Scarf

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 4" Length: 42"

MATERIALS

Rozetti Yarns *Cotton Gold* (65% cotton, 27% payette, 8% metallic; 25g/200 yds)

• 1091 – 1 ball

Hook: US Size B-1 (2.25 mm) or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

2 reps of Chain Mesh patt = 1" wide Save time, check your gauge

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The body of this scarf is worked in two directions. First, the main scarf body is worked to one end, and the End Section is crocheted. Then the other End Section is crocheted into the beginning chain of the other side of the scarf body. Finally, a border is worked around the entire outer edge of the scarf.

STITCH GUIDE

Chain Mesh

(begins with mult of 4 chs + 1)

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hk, * ch 4, sk next 3 chs, sc in next ch; rep from * to last 3 chs, ch 2, dc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in dc, * ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * across, ending ch 2, dc in last sc, turn. Rep Row 2 for patt.

DC-Picot: Dc in sp indicated, ch 3, sl st in top of dc just made.

SCARF BODY

Ch 29. Work in Chain Mesh patt until piece meas 31".

First End Section

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same dc, skip ch-2 sp, * ch 3, sc in next sc, ch 3, sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * to last sc, ch 4, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc + ch 2), sc in next sp, * 9 dc in next sp, sc in next sp, ch 4, sc in next sp; rep from * 2 more times, 9 dc in next sp, sc in last sp, ch 2, dc in sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in same dc, ch 3, * sc in third dc of 9-dc group, ch 3, sc in seventh dc of same 9-dc group, ch 3, sc in ch-4 sp, ch 3; rep from * 2 more times, sc in third dc of 9-dc group, ch 3, sc in seventh dc of same 9-dc group, ch 3, sc in last dc, turn.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2-3, 2 more times.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in same st, * ch 7, sc in center of next 9-dc group, ch 7, sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 7, sc in center of next 9-dc group, ch 7, sc in last dc, turn.

Row 10: Ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3), * sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 7; rep from * to last ch-7 sp, sc in last ch-7 sp, ch 3, dc in last sc, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in same st, * ch 7, sc in next ch-7 sp; rep from *, ending sc in last dc, turn.

Rows 12-13: Rep Rows 10-11. Fasten off.

Second End Section

Attach yarn to one end of beg-ch with sl st.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same ch, ch 3, sk 2 chs, * sc in next ch, ch 3, sk 1 ch; rep from * to last 4 chs, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 2 ch, sc in last ch, turn – 13 sc, 12 ch-3 sps.

Rows 2-13: Work as for First End Section. Turn at the end of the last row but do not fasten off.

Border

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same sc, * ch 3, {sc in next sp, ch 15, sl st in 5th ch from hk to form ring, [sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc, sc] in ring 3 times, join with sl st to first sc, ch 10} 7 times, sc in last sp along last row of End Section, ch 3, sc in last sc, working along side of Scarf Body, [ch 3, sc in side of next row, ch 3, 3 DC-Picot in side of next row] to last row along side of Scarf Body, ch 3, ** sc in first sc from other End Section, rep from * to ** 1 more time, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.
