SKILL Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 71¼" Length: 71¼"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn <u>Deluxe Worsted</u> <u>Superwash</u> (100% superwash wool; 100g/218 yds)

- 734 Cream (MC) 14 balls
- 722 Classic Pink (CC1) 4 balls
- 706 Marigold (CC2) 4 balls

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) straight (or your preferred needle for working flat) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in garter stitch Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The Foursquare Afghan is a cozy blanket to snuggle up under while reading your favorite book at home. Its modern design was inspired by both quilts and a favorite childhood game. The warm tones of our soft, easy-care Deluxe Worsted Superwash make this afghan even more welcoming. Each square is knit individually, making it a perfect portable project!

This afghan is comprised of 100 mitered squares worked in garter stitch. Each square is arranged according to the illustration and sewn together. Each square is approximately 7¼" x 7¼".

PATTERN BEGINS BLANKET

MC: Make 64 squares. CC1: Make 18 squares. CC2: Make 18 squares.

Squares

Cast on 64 sts.

Set-up Row (WS): K32, pm, k32.

Row 1 (RS): Knit to 2 sts bef m, ssk, sl m, k2tog,

knit to end - 2 sts dec'd, 62 sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): Knit, slipping marker as you come to it.

Rep Rows 1-2, 29 more times – 58 sts dec'd, 4 sts rem

Next Row: Ssk, remove m, k2tog – 2 sts dec'd, 2 sts rem. Break yarn leaving approx. 8" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts and fasten off.

Assembly

Using a tapestry needle and MC, sew 10 strips of squares following the color arrangement shown on the illustration. Five of the strips will lean to the left, and five of the strips will lean to the right. Arrange these strips so that the left and right leaning stripes meet at the center of the blanket. Sew strips together to form the afghan.



Abbreviations

CC contrast color dec('d) decrease(d) garter st knit every row

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st

dec'd)

m marker
MC main color
pm place marker
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat
RS right side
sl slip

ssk slip next 2 sts individually


knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops

(1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side

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MC square
