

# Pattern Collection: Home



Fresh Air Cloths Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

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DIFFICULTY Easy

**SIZE** One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width: 8½" Length: 7¾"

### MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Clean Cotton (85% recycled cotton, 15% recycled polyester; 75g/131 yds)

- 117 Morning Glory (A) 2 skeins
- 110 Poppy (B) 1 skein

**Needles:** US size 8 (5 mm) straight and set of dpns (for I-Cord) *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 34 rows = 4" in Fresh Air patt **Save time, check your gauge.** 

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Handmade things for the home are a simple pleasure. Even better when they are made with clean yarns. The Fresh Air Washcloths will add a pop of color to your kitchen or bathroom, and knit up using Clean Cotton, you can feel good about their footprint too. Whether you make this set of washcloths for a gift, or for yourself, they are sure to put a smile on your face.

These washcloths are knit flat from the bottom up. An I-Cord border and hanger is worked after blocking for ease of hanging and a tidy finish.

# STITCH GUIDE

#### I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. \* K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \* until all sts have been bound off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

#### Fresh Air

(multiple of 6 sts, plus 3) **Row 1 (RS):** \* K3, p1, k1, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3. **Row 2 (NS):** K2, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to opd

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, \* p3, k3; rep from \* to end. Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

#### WASHCLOTH

#### (make three)

With color A, cast on 39 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work Row 1 of Fresh Air patt to end. **Row 2 (WS):** Work Row 2 of Fresh Air patt to end. Cont as est'd until piece meas approx. 7¾" from cast on edge, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts in patt.

#### FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.


I-Cord Edging and Hanging Loop

Beg at top right corner, with B, pick up (do not pick up and knit, just pick up) 1 st for each st along the bound-off edge. Work I-Cord Bind Off over these sts, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining (corner turned). Pick up 1 st for each st garter bump down the left side of the cloth. Work I-Cord Bind-Off over these sts, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining (corner turned). Pick up 1 st for each st along the cast-on edge. Work I-Cord Bind-Off over these sts, work 1 row of I-Cord without joining (corner turned). Pick up and knit 1 st for each garter bump along right side of cloth. Work I-Cord Bind-Off over these sts. Work 14 rows of I-Cord without joining for Hanging Loop. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts. Sew end of Hanging Loop to meeting corner.
