#### SKILL

Crochet

#### DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

#### SIZES

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 62½"

Length: 13½"

#### MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Sock Solids](#)

(55% Bamboo, 37% Cotton, 8% PBT;  
100g/1492 yds)

- 614 Celestial (A) - 1 ball

[Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Sock](#)

(55% Bamboo, 37% Cotton, 8% PBT;  
100g/1492 yds)

- 801 Tundra (B) - 2 balls

**Hook:** US Size G/6 (4 mm) *or size  
needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

#### GAUGE

19½ sts x 19½ rows = 4" in Oval Tiles patt,  
after blocking.

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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## PATTERN NOTES

Cool shades ripple through the oval tiles of this wrap like mythical dragon scales. Switch up the colors for more earthy, floral or fire like hues to capture the energy that suits your style. The supple, springy blend of bamboo, cotton and PBT in Bamboo Pop Sock make this wrap a wonderful layering piece for any season or setting.

This shawl is worked flat along the widest edge, from the bottom up.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Changing Colors

Work until 2 lps remain on hk, yo with new color and pull through the last 2 lps to complete the stitch.

### Oval Tiles patt

*With Color A Ch a multiple of 14 + 13.*

**Set-up Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hk and each ch across, turn.

**Set-up Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> and each st across *changing to Color B on the last st*, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, \* hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, tr in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st \*\*, ch 2, sk 2 sts or chs, sc in next st; rep from \* across, ending at \*\* on last st, turn.

**Row 2:** Rep Row 1 *changing to Color A on the last st*.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> and next 11 sts, \* *working over the ch sps* dc in next 2 sts 3 rows below, sc in next 12 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> and each st across *changing to Color B on the last st*, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, \* sc in next st, ch 2, sk 2 sts or chs, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts \*\*, tr in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts; rep from \* across, ending at \*\* on last st, turn.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 5 *changing to Color A on the last st*.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> and next 4 sts, \* *working over the ch sps* dc in next 2 sts 3 rows below, sc in next 12 sts; rep from \* across until 5 sts rem, sc in last 5 sts, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in 1<sup>st</sup> and each st across *changing to Color B on the last st*, turn.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

## PATTERN BEGINS

Ch 307.

Work Set-up Rows 1-2 of Oval Tiles patt - 306 sts.

**Rows 1-64:** Work Rows 1-8 of Oval Tiles patt, 8 times. Patt will be repeated 21 times across each row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

ch	chain
dc	double crochet
hk	hook
lp(s)	loop(s)
sc	single crochet
sk	skip
sp	space(s)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tr	treble crochet
yo	yarn over

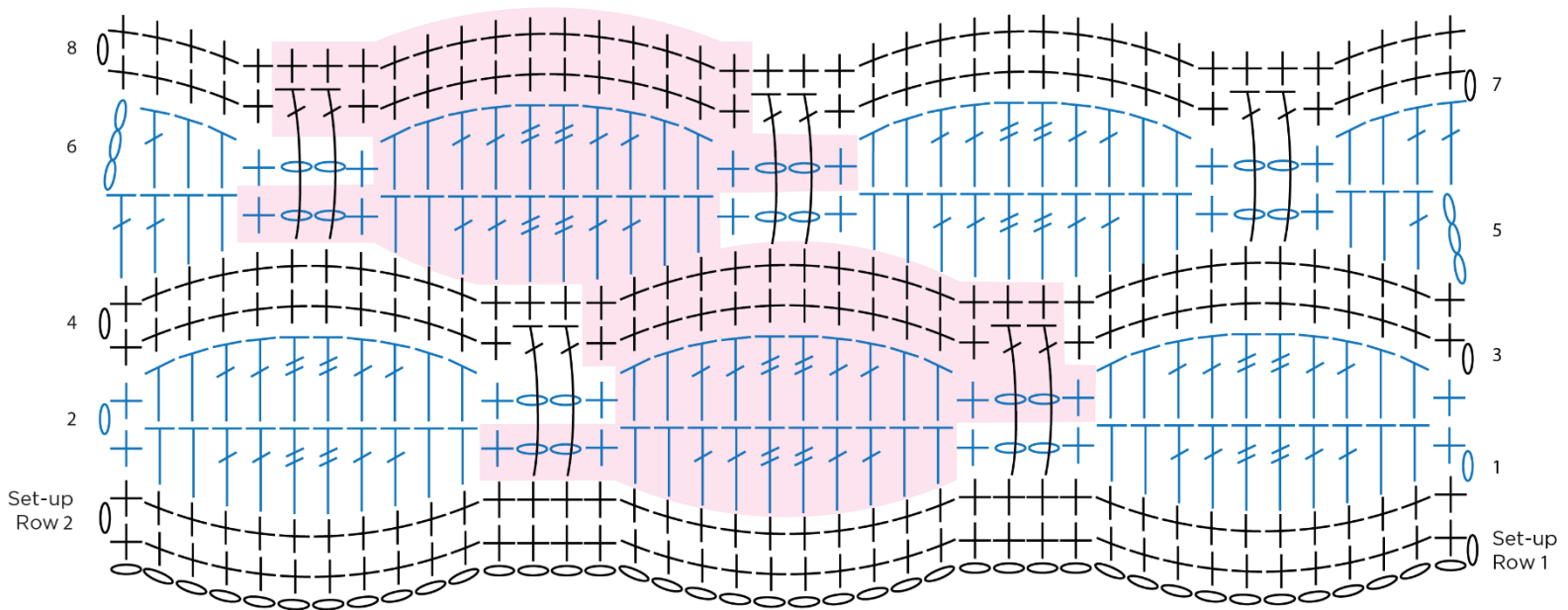
