## **SIZES**

Adult Small (Medium)

# FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Brim Circumference (unstretched): 17

(201/4)"

Stretches to approx. 20 (231/4)"

Length: 7½"

## **MATERIALS**

**Fibra Natura** *Ravello* (75% cotton, 16% extra fine merino, 9% recycled cashmere; 50g/207 yds)

• 101 Ocean Fog – 1 skein (all sizes)

Needle: US Size 3 (3.25 mm) 16" circular and set of dpns or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size 1 (2.25 mm) 16" circular

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers (we recommend using 1 unique marker to

denote bor)

#### **GAUGE**

31 sts x 38 rnds = 4" in Hat patt Save time, check your gauge.

# Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Gardenia is an ideal hat for early spring days when the air is crisp, and the first blooms begin to sprout. This hat features a beautiful cable and lace pattern throughout. Ravello, a blend of cotton, merino wool, and recycled cashmere, has a slight halo that beautifully complements the stitch pattern.

Gardenia is worked in the round from the bottom up. This pattern is both written and charted for your convenience. When working decreases, change to your preferred needles for knitting small circumferences when there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on circular needle.

#### **STITCH GUIDE**

**Left Twist (LT):** Knit the second st on the left ndl through the back loop, knit the first st through the front loop, slip both sts from ndl.

**Right Twist (RT):** K2tog but do not slip st from ndl, knit the first st again, slip both sts from ndl.

## 2x2 Left Cross (LC)

Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2 from LH ndl, k2 from cn.

### 2x2 Right Cross (RC)

Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2 from LH ndl, k2 from cn.

#### 2x2 Left Purl Cross (LPC)

Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in front, p2 from LH ndl, k2 from cn.

#### 2x2 Right Purl Cross (RPC)

Slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2 from LH ndl, p2 from cn.

#### HAT

#### **Brim**

Note 1: We recommend using a unique marker to denote the beginning of round.

Note 2: This section is also charted for your convenience.

With smaller 16" circ ndl, cast on 135 (162) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

**Rnd 1:** \* [K2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1, [k2, p2] 3 times, pm; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 until piece meas 1¼" from cast-on edge. Change to larger 16" circ.



#### **Main Hat**

Note 1: This section is also charted for your convenience.

Note 2: Slip markers as you come to them.

Note 3: Crown shaping begins on Rnd 46. When there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on 16" circular, change to your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences.

**Rnd 1:** \* [K2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1, [k2, p2] 3 times; rep from \* to end. Pattern will be repeated 5 (6) times across each rnd.

**Rnd 2:** \* Yo, ssk, p8, 2x2 RC, p1, 2x2 LC, p8; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \* K2, p8, k4, p1, k4, p8; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 4:** \* K2tog, yo, p6, 2x2 RC, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, 2x2 LC, p6; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** \* K2, p6, k6, p1, k6, p6; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 6:** \* Yo, ssk, p4, 2x2 RPC, k1, k2tog, yo, k1,

p1, k1, yo, ssk, k1, 2x2 LPC, p4; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \* K2, p4, k2, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2, p4; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 8:** \* K2tog, yo, p2, 2x2 RC, p2, ktog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, p2, 2x2 LC, p2; rep from \* to end. **Odd Rnds 9-29:** \* K2, [p2, k4] 2 times, p1, [k4, p2] 2 times; rep from \* to end.

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**Rnd 10:** \* Yo, ssk, p2, RT, LT, p2, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, p2, RT, LT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 12:** \* K2tog, yo, p2, LT, RT, p2, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, p2, LT, RT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 14:** \* Yo, ssk, p2, RT, LT, p2, k2, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, k2, p2, RT, LT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 16:** \* K2tog, yo, p2, LT, RT, p2, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, ssk, k1, p2, LT, RT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 18:** \* Yo, ssk, p2, RT, LT, p2, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, p2, RT, LT, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 20: Rep Rnd 12.

Rnd 22: Rep Rnd 10.

Rnd 24: \* K2tog, yo, p2, LT, RT, p2, k2, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, k2, p2, LT, RT, p2; rep from \* to end. Rnd 26: \* Yo, ssk, p2, RT, LT, p2, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, ssk, k1, p2, RT, LT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 28:** \* K2tog, yo, p2, LT, RT, p2, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, p2, LT, RT, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 30:** \* Yo, ssk, p2, 2x2 LPC, p2, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, p2, 2x2 RPC, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 31:** \* K2, p4, k2, p2, k4, p1, k4, p2, k2, p4; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 32:** \* K2tog, yo, p4, 2x2 LPC, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1, 2x2 RPC, p4; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 33:** Rep Rnd 5.

**Rnd 34:** \* Yo, ssk, p6, 2x2 LPC, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, 2x2 RPC, p6; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 35:** Rep Rnd 3.

**Rnd 36:** \* K2tog, yo, p8, 2x2 LPC, p1, 2x2 RPC, p8; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 37:** \* K2, p10, k2, p1, k2, p10; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 38:** \* Yo, ssk, p10, LT, p1, RT, p10; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 39: Rep Rnd 37.

**Rnd 40:** \* K2tog, yo, p10, LT, p1, RT, p10; rep

from \* to end.

**Rnds 41-44:** Rep Rnds 37-40.

Rnd 45: Rep Rnd 37.

**Rnd 46:** \* Yo, ssk, p8, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p8; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 125 (150) sts rem.

**Rnd 47:** \* K2, p9, k2, p1, k2, p9; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 48:** \* K2tog, yo, p7, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p7; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 115 (138) sts rem.

**Rnd 49:** \* K2, p8, k2, p1, k2, p8; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 50:** \* Yo, ssk, p6, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p6; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 105 (126) sts rem.

**Rnd 51:** \* K2, p7, k2, p1, k2, p7; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 52:** \* K2tog, yo, p5, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p5; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 95 (114) sts rem.

**Rnd 53:** \* K2, p4, ssp, k2, p1, k2, p2tog, p4; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 85 (102) sts rem.

**Rnd 54:** \* Yo, ssk, p3, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p3; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 75 (90) sts rem.

Rnd 55: \* K2, p2, ssp, k2, p1, k2, p2tog, p2; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 65 (78) sts rem. Rnd 56: \* K2tog vo. p1, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p1;

**Rnd 56:** \* K2tog, yo, p1, ssp, LT, p1, RT, p2tog, p1; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 55 (66) sts rem.

Rnd 57: \* K2, ssp, k2, p1, k2, p2tog; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 45 (54) sts rem.

**Rnd 58:** \* Yo, ssk, p1, ssk, p1, k2tog, p1; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 35 (42) sts rem.

**Rnd 59:** \* K2, ssp, p1, p2tog; rep from \* to end – 10 (12) sts dec'd, 25 (30) sts rem.

**Rnd 60:** \* K2tog, p3tog; rep from \* to end – 15 (18) sts dec'd, 10 (12) sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving approx. 8" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts. Pull taut to close.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.


