SIZES

Small/Medium (Large/1X, 2X, 3X)
Shown in Small/Medium size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 38"

Length: 19 (20, 21)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Deluxe Worsted Tweed Superwash* (90% superwash wool, 7% acrylic, 3% viscose; 100g/218 yds)

- 913 Smoke 6 (7, 8) balls

Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm) 36" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 36" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder

GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This poncho is knit in 2 pieces. The difference between sizes is the length of the finished poncho.

The Cowl Neck is knit sideways and seamed to the neck opening.

STITCH GUIDE

1x1 Ribbing

(odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

Flame

(multiple of 8 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): K1, * p7, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): * P1, k7; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 3: K2, * p5, k3; rep from * to last 7 sts, p5, k2.

Row 4: P2, k5, * p3, k5; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 5: K3, * p3, k5; rep from * to last 6 sts, p3, k3.

Row 6: P3, k3, * p5, k3; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 7: K4, * p1, k7; rep from * to last 5 sts, p1, k4.

Row 8: P4, k1, * p7, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.

Row 9: P1, * k7, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 10: * K1, p7; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 11: P2, * k5, p3; rep from * to last 7 sts, k5, p2.

Row 12: K2, p5, * k3, p5; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 13: P3, * k3, p5; rep from * to last 6 sts, k3, p3.

Row 14: K3, p3, * k5, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 15: P4, * k1, p7; rep from * to last 5 sts, k1, p4.

Row 16: K4, p1, * k7, p1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

Chevrons

(multiple of 8 sts + 1)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): P1, k4, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.

Row 3: K3, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 6 sts, p4, k2.

Row 4: P3, k4, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 5: K1, * p4, k4; rep from * to end.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: * P4, k4; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 9: K2, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 7 sts, p4, k3.

Row 10: P2, k4, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 11: K4, * p4, k4; rep from * to last 5 sts, p4, k1.

Row 12: Purl.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

Columns

(multiple of 9 sts + 6)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): P2, k2, * p7, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 3: K2, * k4, k3tog but do not sl sts from ndl, yo, knit same 3 sts tog, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

FRONT

With smaller ndl, cast on 161 sts. Work in K1, P1 Ribbing for 12 rows. Knit 2 rows. Switch to larger ndl.

Work Rows 1-16 of Flame patt, 1 time. Purl 2 rows.

Rep Rows 1-12 of Chevrons patt, 3 times. Knit 2 rows.

Work Rows 1-16 of Flame patt, 1 time. Purl 2 rows, inc'ing 7 sts evenly on last row – 168 sts.

Rep Rows 1-4 of Columns patt until piece meas 18 (19, 20)" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): Work in patt over 71 sts, attach new ball of yarn bind off center 26 sts, work in patt over rem 71 sts. Working both sides at once, dec 1 st at neck edge on each side, 4 times – 67 sts rem. Work even in patt until piece meas 19 (20, 21)" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row. Place both sets of sts on holder.

BACK

Work as for Front.

COWL NECK

With larger ndl, cast on 42 sts. Work in Columns patt until piece meas 22", ending with WS row. Bind off all sts.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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FINISHING


Block pieces. Join shoulder seams using 3-ndl bind-off. Sew cast-on and bind-off edges of Cowl Neck together. Sew side of Cowl Neck to Neck opening of Poncho such that when folded over, the RS of the Cowl Neck will show.

Sew side seams of Poncho, leaving 3" unsewn at lower edge and 7 (8, 9)" unsewn at upper edge for Armholes. Weave in ends.


Abbreviations

cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
ndl	needle
patt	pattern
p	purl
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side


Flame

Key

- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS
-  k3tog, yo, k3tog
- pattern repeat

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
