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Hanukkah Throw Designed by Amy Gunderson

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FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Width: 42" Length: 48"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Adore* (55% superwash merino, 45% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/273 yds)

- 104 Powder (MC) 6 balls
- 123 Cobalt (CC) 2 balls

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

1 motif = 6" wide Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Adorned with Star of David motifs, this throw is intended to celebrate Hanukkah, the Jewish Festival of Lights. This lovely throw is a festive addition to your holiday décor and would make a wonderful gift.

Motifs are crocheted separately and sewn together. Up for a speed challenge? Make at least six to seven motifs a day during the holiday and you'll have a nearly complete throw by the end!

THROW

MOTIF (make 52)

With MC, begin with adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc in ring, join with sl st to beg dc - 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same dc, 2 dc in each dc around, join with sl st to beg dc - 24 dc. **Rnd 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in next dc, [dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc] around, join with sl st to beg dc - 36 dc.

Rnd 4: [Sc in next dc, ch 6, working in bottom bumps of ch, sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next ch, sk next 4 dc from Rnd 3, sc in next dc] 6 times, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 star points.

Rnd 5: Ch 7 (counts as dc + ch 4), sc in unworked ch of ch 6, ch 4, dc in next sc, ch 1, [dc in next sc, ch 4, sc in unworked ch of ch 6, ch 4, dc in next sc, ch 1,] 5 times, ending last rep with sc join to third ch of beg ch 7.

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts dc), {5 dc in ch-4 sp, ch 2, 5 dc in ch-4 sp, [dc, ch 1, dc] in ch-1 sp} 5 times, 5 dc in ch-4 sp, ch 2, 5 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in same sp as beg ch-3, ch 1, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 – 72 dc, 6 ch-1 sps, 6 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 7: Sc in next 6 dc, {[sc, ch 1, sc] in ch-2 sp, sc in next 6 dc, sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next 6 dc} 5 times, [sc, ch 1, sc] in ch-2 sp, sc in next 6 dc, sc in ch-1 sp, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Overlay

Rnd 1: With CC, beg with the second dc of Rnd 3 of Motif, fpsc in each dc around, join with sl st to beg fpsc.

Rnd 2: [Fpsc in base of dtr from Rnd 4 of Motif, fpsc in base of tr, fpsc in base of dc, fpsc in base

Sew together using mattress stitch, using assembly diagram as a guide. Edging

st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Work 1 rnd of sc using MC, working sc2tog at inner points and 3 sc in each ch-1 corner sp. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

hdc, fpsc in dc, fpsc in tr, fpsc in dtr, ch 1, sl st bet

next 2 fpsc from Rnd 1] 6 times, ch 1, join with sl




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
