SKILL

Knitting

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck Circumference: 24"

Height: 18"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Deluxe Bulky Superwash](#)
(100% superwash wool; 100g/106 yds)

- 954 Phantom Heather (A) – 3 balls

[Universal Yarn Bella Pom Pom](#) (78%
polyamide, 22% polyester; 50g/334 yds)

- 101 Neon Fun (B) – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 24-32" circular
(to accommodate large number of sts) *or*
size needed to obtain gauge

US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

12 sts x 16 rows in Stockinette stitch (St st)
with larger ndls

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

A whimsical accessory that takes your outfit to the next level, the Heidi Hood utilizes a dark shade of our lofty Deluxe Bulky Superwash yarn as the perfect backdrop for the pops of neon scattered throughout Bella Pom Pom.

This hood is knit from the bottom up. The neck section is first worked in the round in Fisherman's Rib. Then, stitches are separated at the center front and the hood is worked flat with a built-in I-Cord edge. The top of the hood is formed by grafting each half of the stitches together. In this pattern, work all slipped stitches purlwise.

The neck is worked with yarn A. Yarns A and B are held together as one for the main part of the hood, with the built-in I-cord worked with just yarn A.

STITCH GUIDE

Knit 1 below (k1b): Insert the right needle into the space right below the next stitch as if to knit. Knit as you normally would, allowing the stitch to fall off the left needle.

Purl 1 below (p1b): Insert the right needle into the space right below the next stitch as if to purl. Purl as you normally would, allowing the stitch to fall off the left needle.

Fisherman's Rib

(even number of sts, worked in the rnd)

Rnd 1: * K1b, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * K1, p1b; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

HOOD

Neck

With smaller ndl and yarn A, cast on 72 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Set-up Rnd: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Work in Fisherman's Rib until piece meas approx. 3¼" from cast-on edge. Remove marker and turn work. Change to larger needles. Join yarn B.

Increase Section

Note: You will now be working flat in rows.

Set-up Row (WS): With yarn A, p36, pm, purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

Row 1 (RS): With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, knit to 1 st bef m, kfb, sl m, kfb, knit to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif - 2 sts inc'd, 74 sts.

Row 2: With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.



Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times - 8 sts inc'd, 82 sts.

Even Section

Row 1 (RS): With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, knit to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

Row 2 (WS): With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas approx. 15½" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

Decrease Section

Row 1 (RS): With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, knit to 2 sts before m, ssk, sl m, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif - 2 sts dec'd, 80 sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): With yarn A, k3, with yarns A and B held together as one, purl to last 3 sts, sl 3 wyif.

Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times - 8 sts dec'd, 72 sts rem.

FINISHING

Note: If you're having difficulty grafting while holding yarns A and B together as one, you may choose to graft with just yarn A instead.

Place first 36 sts on one side of circ ndl, and last 36 sts on opposite side, with WS facing together. Holding ndls parallel, graft the two sets of sts together. Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
kfb	knit into front and back of next st (1 st inc'd)
m	marker
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd(s)	round(s)
RS	right side
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
wyif	with yarn held in front

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
