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Hexagon Throw

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Triangles: 15" wide x 15¾ " tall

Throw: 31½ " across

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Worsted Spirit Stripes* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)/

• 507 Slam Dunk (MC) – 4 skeins **Universal Yarn** *Uptown Worsted* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

324 Black (CC) – 2 skeins
 Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm) straigh

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Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Garter st Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Patt

2 rows CC

2 rows MC

2 rows CC

12 rows MC

Rep these 18 rows for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This pattern is worked in triangular pieces which are then seamed together to create a hexagon shaped throw.

TRIANGLES

(Make 6)

With CC, cast on 69 sts. Work even in garter st and Stripe Patt for 2 rows.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd, 67 sts rem.

Rep Dec Row every other RS row 29 more times and then every RS row 3 times – 3 sts rem. After 7 reps of Stripe Patt are complete, bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Wash and block triangles to finished meas and then seam sides and points together. Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations

CC contrast color dec('d) decrease(d) garter st knit every row

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

MC main color
meas measures
patt pattern
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat
RS right side

ssk slip next 2 sts individually

knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops

(1 st dec'd)

St st stockinette stitch

st(s) stitch(es) WS wrong side
