



## Pattern Collection: Accessories



### High Tide Shawlette

Designed by Amy Gunderson

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width across top: 44"

Depth in Center: 21"

### MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Cotton Supreme DK Seaspray* (100% cotton; 100g/230 yds)

- 1 ball

**Needles:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 32" circular

**Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm), for edging

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### GAUGE

16 sts x 22 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

This triangular shawl is worked from the top down, beginning with a garter stitch tab. On every right side row, an increased is worked in each side of the center “spine”, and on each edge. The lower edge is bound-off loosely, and then a simple crocheted edging is worked.

In the pattern sections, there are notes regarding number of Eyelet repeats. An easy way to keep track of this is by counting the double yarnovers in the center spine.

The sample pictured took just one hank of Cotton Supreme DK Seaspray, but there were just a few yards left over.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Eyelet Column

*(worked over 4 sts)*

**Row 1 (RS):** K2tog, [yo] 2 times, ssk.

**Row 2 (WS):** P1, [p1, p1 tbl] into double yo, p1.

**Row 3:** Yo, ssk, k2tog, yo.

**Row 4:** P4.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

## SHAWL

Cast on 3 sts.

### Starting Tab

Knit 10 rows.

**Next row (RS):** K3, pick up and knit 8 sts along side of Tab, pick up and knit 3 sts along cast-on edge – 14 sts.

**Next row (WS):** K3, pm, k2, pm, k4, pm, k2, pm, k3.

### Shawl Body

*(Eyelet Repeat 1)*

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, sl m, yo, p2, m1p, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, sl m, m1p, p2, yo, sl m, k3 – 18 sts.

**Row 2:** K3, sl m, knit to m, sl m, work Row 2 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, k3.

**Row 3:** K3, sl m, yo, purl to m, m1p, sl m, work Row 3 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, m1p, purl to m, yo, sl m, k3 – 22 sts.

**Row 4:** K3, sl m, knit to m, sl m, work Row 4 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, k3.

### Establish New Eyelet Columns

*(Eyelet Repeats 2-4)*

**Row 5:** K3, sl m, yo, p1, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column Patt over 4 sts, pm, p1, m1p, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, sl m, m1p, p1, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p1, yo, sl m, k3 – 26 sts.

**Rows 6-16:** Work in patt as established, working increases as established every RS row, and maintaining instances of Eyelet Column patt – 46 sts.

### Establish More Eyelet Columns

*(Eyelet Repeats 5-9)*

**Row 17:** K3, sl m, yo, [p1, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p2, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, p2, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p1], m1p, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, m1p, rep from [ to ] 1 more time, yo, sl m, k3 – 50 sts.

**Rows 18-36:** Work in patt as established, working increases as established every RS row, and maintaining instances of Eyelet Column patt – 86 sts.

### Establish Even More Eyelet Columns

*(Eyelet Repeats 10-12)*

**Row 37:** K3, sl m, yo, {p1, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p6, [work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, p2] 2 times, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, p6, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p1}, m1p, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, m1p, rep from { to } 1 more time, yo, sl m, k3 – 90 sts.

**Rows 38-48:** Work in patt as established, working increases as established every RS row, and maintaining instances of Eyelet Column patt – 110 sts.

### Last Eyelet Columns to be Added!

*(Eyelet Repeats 13-20)*

**Row 49:** K3, sl m, yo, {p1, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p2, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt to m, sl m, p6, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, p2] 2 times, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, p6, sl m, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, sl m, p2, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, pm, p1}, m1p, sl m,

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work Row 1 of Eyelet Column patt over 4 sts, sl m, m1p, rep from { to } 1 more time, yo, sl m, k3 – 114 sts.

**Rows 50-80:** Work in patt as established, working increases as established every RS row, and maintaining instances of Eyelet Column patt – 174 sts.

### Lower Edge

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, yo, knit to center 4 sts of row (removing other markers as you go), m1, sl m, k4, sl m, m1, knit to last 3 sts (removing markers as you go), yo, k3 – 178 sts.

**Row 2 (WS):** Knit.

**Row 3:** K3, yo, knit to m, m1, sl m, k4, sl m, m1, knit to last 3 sts, yo, k3 – 182 sts.

**Row 4:** Knit.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 3 – 186 sts.

Bind off all sts very loosely over the next WS row, do not break yarn.

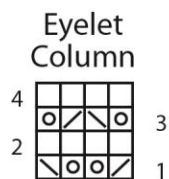
### Edging

Place crochet hook in last rem live loop.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, [ch 5, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st] to last 3 sts, ch 5, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in last st. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wet block firmly, pinning out ch-5 sps from Edging.



### Key

- knit on RS, purl on WS
- k2tog
- ssk
- yo

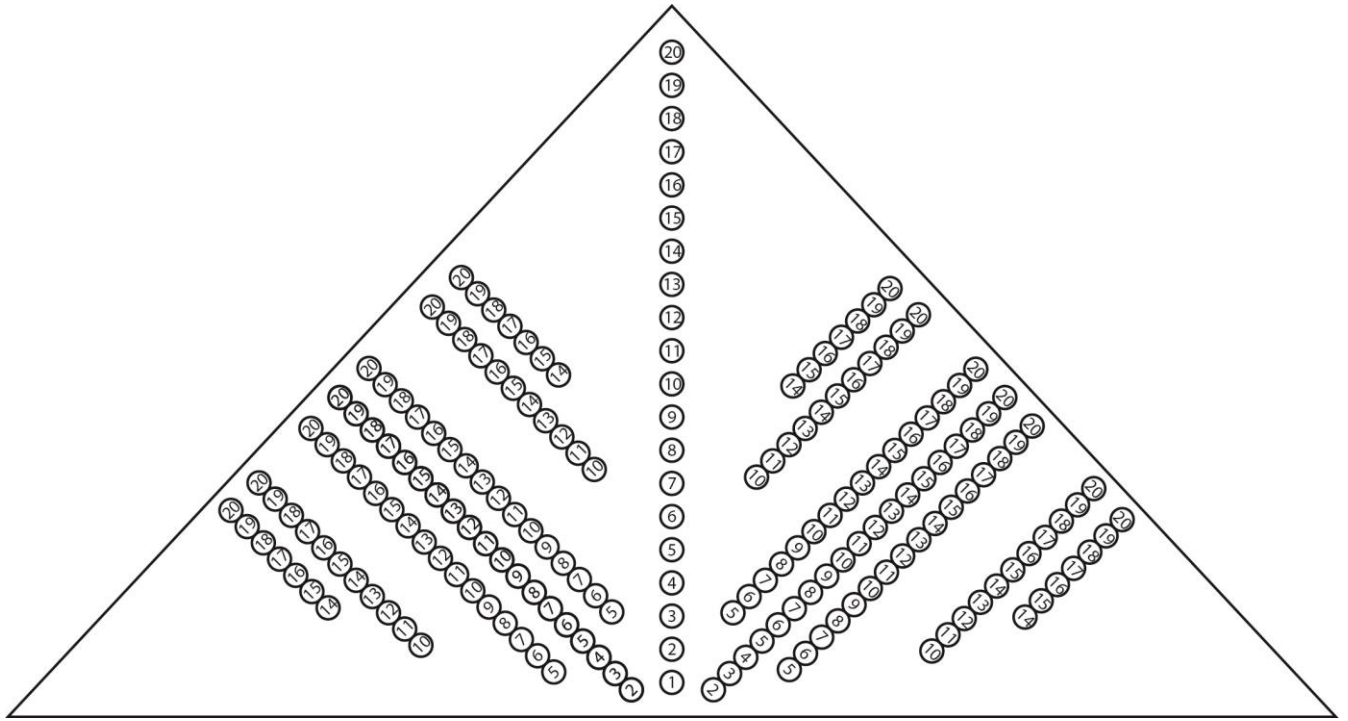
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
