INTRODUCTION

Who doesn't love pom-poms? In this fun, hip collection, you'll find 9 great ways to take your knitted hat from plain ol' hat to Hot Hat. Luxury Fur Pom-Poms from Universal Yarn are soft, sassy, colorful, and all-around fabulous. Each Pom-Pom comes with strings attached in the same color as the pom-pom, so all you have to do is tie them to your project. Think about tying a bright Pom-Pom to a zipper pull on a vest or bag for an extra touch of fur. Or consider tying one Pom-Pom to each end of a scarf, and one to the top of a hat for maximum Pom-Poms!

THROUGH THE MARSH HAT



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 20"

Height: 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Deluxe Worsted*

(100% wool; 100g/220 yds)

• 3649 Forest - 1 skein

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom tapestry needle, stitch marker, cable needle

GAUGE

20 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Sand Cables patt

Save time, check your gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

10 Stitch Right Cross (10-st RC):

Sl 5 sts to cn and hold in back, k5, k5 from cn.

10 Stitch Left Cross (10-st LC):

Sl 5 sts to cn and hold in front, k5, k5 from cn.

6 Stitch Right Cross (6-st RC): Sl 3 sts to cn and hold in back, k3, k3 from cn.

6 Stitch Left Cross (6-st LC): Sl 3 sts to cn and hold in front, k3, k3 from cn.

3x2 Left Cross (2x2 LC): Sl next 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k3, k2 from cn.

2x2 Right Cross (2x2 RC): Sl next 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2, k2 from cn.

STITCH GUIDE

Plaited Cable (worked over 15 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

WS Rows 2-16: Purl.

Row 3: 10-st RC, k5.

Rows 5, 7, 9: Knit.

Row 11: K5, 10-st LC.

Rows 13, 15: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

Sand Cables (multiples of 12 sts)

Rnds 1-4: Knit.

Rnd 5: * 6-st RC, k6; rep from * to end.

Rnds 6-9: Knit.

Rnd 10: * K6, 6-st LC; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-10 for patt.

BRIM

Cast on 18 sts.

Set-up row (WS): K1, p15, k2.

Row 1: P2, work Row 1 of Plaited Cable over 15 sts, p1.

Row 2: K1, work Row 2 of Plaited Cable over 15 sts, k2.

Cont in patt, working reps of Rows 1-16 of patt until Brim meas 20", ending with Row 12 of patt. Bind off all sts. Sew bind-off edge to cast-on edge.

HAT


Beg at seam, pick up and knit 108 sts evenly along the edge of brim with 1 rev St st. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Sand Cables to end. Cont in Sand Cables patt until Hat meas 6½" from bottom of Brim, ending with Rnd 3 of patt.










Work Rnds 1-16 of Crown Shaping chart - 9 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

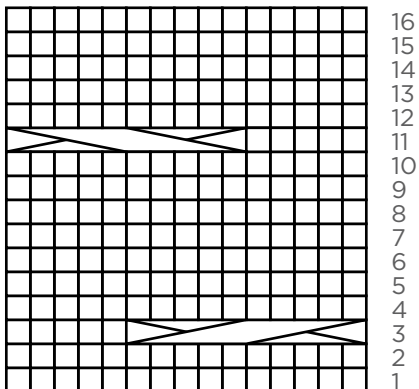
Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom securely to top of hat.

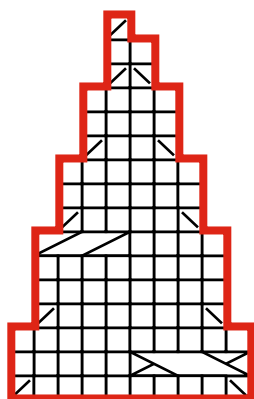

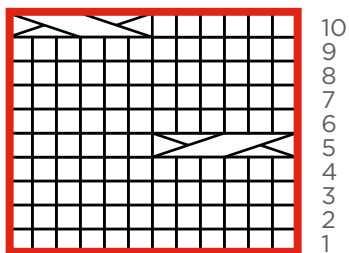
Plaited Cable

LOVEY DOVEY EAR FLAP



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 22"

Height: 7½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Chunky (100% wool; 100g/120 yds)

- 50002 Millet (MC) – 1 skein
- 91906 Azure Heather (CC1) – 1 skein
- 91904 Pomegranate Heather (CC2) – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker, US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook

GAUGE

14 sts x 18 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Seed Stitch (worked flat, odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

Seed Stitch (worked in the rnd, even number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * P1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

HAT

Earflap 1

With MC, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): P1, k1, p1.

Row 2: [K1, m1] twice, k1 – 5 sts.

Row 3: P1, m1, p1, k1, p1, m1, p1 – 7 sts.

Row 4: K1, m1, [k1, p1] twice, k1, m1, k1 – 9 sts.

Row 5: P1, m1, work in Seed st to last st, m1, p1 – 11 sts.

Row 6: K1, work in Seed st to last st, k1.

Row 7: Rep Row 5 – 13 sts.

Rows 8, 9 & 10: Work even in patt.

Row 11: Rep Row 5 – 15 sts.

Rows 12-17: Work even in patt. Break yarn. Place sts on dpn.

Earflap 2

Work as for Earflap 1. Do not break yarn.

Begin Main Hat

Next rnd: Work in Seed st across Earflap 2, cast on 23 sts for Back of Hat, work in Seed st across Earflap 1, cast on 27 sts for Front of Hat – 80 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd. Work in Seed st for 5 rnds. Knit 1 rnd. Work rows 1-18 of Lovey Dovey chart, changing colors as indicated. Break CCs. With MC, knit 2 rnds.

Next rnd: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Work 2 more rnds in Seed st.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: * Work in Seed st for 6 sts, p2tog, k2tog; rep from * to end – 64 sts rem.

Rnd 2: Work even in Seed st.

Rnd 3: * Work in Seed st for 4 sts, p2tog, k2tog; rep from * to end – 48 sts.

Rnd 4: Work even in Seed st.

Rnd 5: * Work in Seed st for 2 sts, p2tog, k2tog; rep from * to end – 32 sts rem.

Rnd 6: Work even in Seed st.

Rnd 7: * P2tog, k2tog; rep from * to end – 16 sts rem.

Lovey Dovey Ear Flap Continued

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 7 - 8 sts rem.
Break yarn, thread through tapestry
ndl and pass through rem live sts.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.
Tie Pom-Pom securely to
top of hat.

Attach MC to center back of hat.
Work sc evenly along back edge
of hat, around Earflap, along Front
edge, around other Earflap, and to
beg, join with sl st to beg sc.

Ties

Cut 6 strands of MC, 24" long.
Fold strands in half. Insert crochet
hook through bottom center of
Earflap from front to back, grab
strands at fold point and bring
partway through Earflap forming
loop, grab ends of strands and pull
through loop; make taut - Twelve
12" strands. Divide strands into 3
groups of 4 strands and braid. Tie
end in overhand knot. Rep for other
Earflap. 📖

SIZE
Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Brim Circumference: 18"
Height: 8½"




MATERIALS
Universal Yarn *Deluxe Chunky* (100% wool; 100g/120 yds)
• 3704 Gold Spice- 1 skein
Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE
14 sts x 18 rows = 4" in St st
Save time, check your gauge.

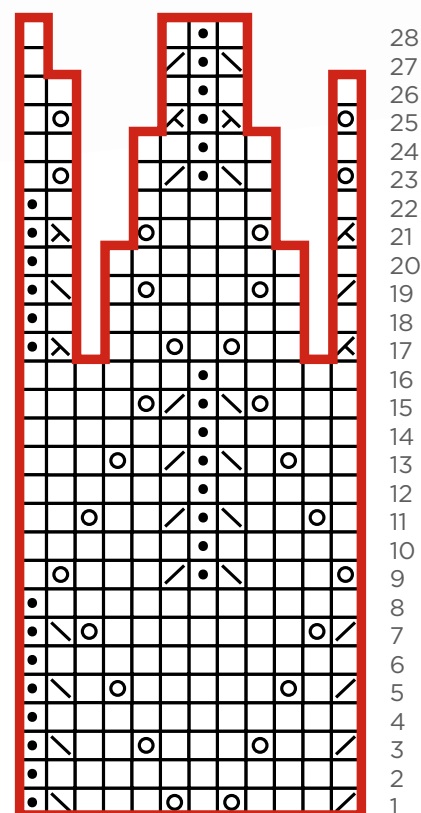
BRIM
Cast on 72 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.
Rnd 1: * K1tbl, p1; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 until Brim meas 2½". Knit 1 rnd.

Main Hat
Work Rnds 1-28 of Chunky Lace patt - 24 sts rem.
Next rnd: [K3tog] across - 8 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING
Weave in ends and block.

NEON LATTICE CAP



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 16"

Height: 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Classic Shades (30% wool, 70% acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 737 Neon Kaleidoscope (MC) – 1 ball

Universal Yarn Classic Shades Solids (30% wool, 70% acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 603 Eggplant (CC) – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Lattice patt

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Lattice Patt (*multiples of 6 sts*)

Rnd 1: * K1, yo, k5, yo; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * Sl 1 pwise wyib, drop yo off ndl, k4, sl 1, drop yo; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3-5: * Sl 1 pwise wyib, p4, sl 1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: * Drop next st and let hang at front of work, k2, place dropped st on LH ndl and knit, sl 2, drop next st and let hang at front of work, sl same 2 sts back to LH ndl, place dropped st on ndl and knit, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: * K2, [yo, k1] twice, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 8: * K2, [drop yo, sl 1] twice, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9-11: * K2, sl 2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 12: Sl 2, drop next st, sl same 2 sts back to LH ndl, place dropped st on ndl and knit, drop next st, k2, place dropped st on ndl and knit; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-12 for patt.

BRIM

With CC, cast on 80 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep this rnd until Brim meas 1½".

Inc rnd: * K5, m1; rep from * to end – 96 sts. Break CC.

Hat Body

With MC, work Rnds 1-12 of Lattice Patt, 2 times, then work Rnds 1-6 of patt, 1 more time.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: * K2tog, [yo, k1] twice, k2; rep from * to end – 80 sts rem.

Rnd 2: * K1, [drop yo, sl 1] twice, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 3 & 4: * K1, sl 2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: * Sl 1, drop next st, sl st back to LH ndl, place dropped st on LH ndl and knit, k1, drop next st, ssk, place dropped st on LH ndl and knit; rep from * to end – 64 sts rem.

Rnd 6: * Yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * to end – 48 sts rem.

Rnd 7: * Drop yo, sl 1, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 8: * Sl 1, k2tog; rep from * to end – 36 sts rem.


Rnd 9: * Sl 1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 10: * Ssk; rep from * to end – 18 sts rem.

Rnd 11: Rep Rnd 10 – 9 sts rem.

Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl, and pass through rem live sts. Pull taut, fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom to top of hat securely.

CABLES & TEXTURE HAT



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 17"

Height: 10"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Worsted

(100% wool; 100g/220 yds)

• 91467 Tulipwood – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker, cable needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

3 x 3 Right Cross (RC): Slip next 3 sts to cn and hold in back, k3, k3 from cn.

3 x 3 Left Cross (LC): Slip next 3 sts to cn and hold in front, k3, k3 from cn.

BRIM

Cast on 80 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 until Brim meas 1½" from cast-on edge.

Next rnd: Purl.

Next rnd: * K5, m1; rep from * to end – 96 sts.

Main Hat

Rnds 1 & 2: * K6, p2, k1, p12, k1, p2, k6, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * RC, p2, k14, p2, LC, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: * K6, p2, k14, p2, k6, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5 & 6: Rep Rnds 1 & 2.

Rnds 7 & 8: * K6, p2, k14, p2, k6, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-8, 5 more times, or until Hat meas about 7½" from cast-on edge.

Purl 2 rnds.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: * K10, k2tog, pm; rep from * to end – 88 sts rem.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: * Purl to 2 sts bef m, p2tog; rep from * to end – 80 sts rem.

Rnd 4: Purl.

Rnd 5: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 72 sts rem.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: Purl to 2 sts bef m, p2tog; rep from * to end – 64 sts rem.

Rnd 8: Purl.

Rnd 9: Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 56 sts rem.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11: Purl to 2 sts bef m, p2tog; rep from * to end – 48 sts rem.

Rnd 12: Purl.

Rnd 13: Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 40 sts rem.

Rnd 14: Knit.

Rnd 15: Purl to 2 sts bef m, p2tog; rep from * to end – 32 sts rem.

Rnd 16: Purl.


Rnd 17: Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 24 sts rem.

Rnd 18: [K2tog] to end – 12 sts rem.

Rnd 19: Rep Rnd 18 – 6 sts rem.

Break yarn, thread through tapestry needle and pass through rem live sts. Pull taut, fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom to top of hat securely. 

HOT HATS!

EASY STRIPES HAT



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 19"

Height: 7½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Uptown Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 302 White Glow (A) - 1 ball
- 315 Hunter Green (B) - 1 ball

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Sequence

(any number of sts)

Rnds 1-6: With A, knit.

Rnds 7-10: With B, knit.

BRIM

With A, cast on 80 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnds 1-4: * K3, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5-8: With B, rep Rnd 1.

Main Hat

Work Rnds 1-10 of Stripe Sequence until Hat meas 5½" from cast-on edge.

Cont Stripe Sequence throughout remainder of Hat.

Shape Crown

Set-up rnd: * K10, pm; rep from * to end.


Dec rnd: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end - 8 sts dec'd.

Next rnd: Knit.

Rep these 2 rnds, 1 more time. Rep Dec rnd every rnd, 5 times - 24 sts rem.

Next rnd: * K2tog; rep from * to end - 12 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom securely to top of hat. 

TIP

Attaching a Luxury Fur Pom-Pom to the top of your hat is easy using a crochet hook! Hook sizes anywhere from a US Size E-4 (3.5 mm) to US Size H-8 (5 mm) work best.

Insert your hook from the inside of the hat to the outside at the crown of the hat. With the hook, grab two of the four strings coming from the Pom-Pom and pull them inside the hat. Insert hook through crown of hat a half inch from the first set of strings, grab the remaining two strings and pull them inside the hat. Tie the two sets of strings together firmly and you're all set!

CHECKED SLOUCH

SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 18"

Height: 10"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Worsted (100% wool; 100g/220 yds)

- 12509 Mulberry Heather (A) - 1 skein

- 71009 White Ash (B) - 1 skein

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Checked patt

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Checked Pattern (multiples of 3 sts)

Rnd 1: With A, * sl 1 pwise wyib, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: With A, knit.

Rnd 3: With B, * k2, sl 1 pwise wyib; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: With B, knit.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

BRIM

Cast on 80 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: With A, * k2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep this Rnd until Brim meas 2".

Inc rnd: With A, *k1, kfb, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4. - 99 sts. With A, knit 1 rnd.

Hat Body

Rep Rnds 1-4 of Checked Patt until Hat meas 9", ending with Rnd 4 of patt.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: With A, * sl 1 pwise wyib, k2tog; rep from * to end - 66 sts rem.

Rnd 2: With A, knit.


Rnd 3: With B, * k2tog; rep from * to end - 33 sts rem.

Rnd 4: With B, knit.

Rnd 5: With A, * k2tog; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3tog - 16 sts rem.

Rnd 6: With A, * k2tog; rep from * to end - 8 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl and pass tail through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom securely to top of hat.

SKYWARD HAT



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 16"

Height: 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Worsted
(100% wool; 100g/220 yds)

• 12277 Periwinkle – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Little Cable St patt

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Little Cable Stitch

(multiples of 10 sts)

Rnds 1 & 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: * RC, LC, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: * K4, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5 & 6: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1-6 for patt.

Right Cross (RC): Slip next st to cn and hold in back, k1, k1 from cn.

Left Cross (LC): Slip next st to cn and hold in front, k1, k1 from cn.

BRIM

Cast on 90 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end. Rep this rnd until Brim meas 1½".

Inc rnd: * K3, m1; rep from * to end – 120 sts.

Hat Body

Work in Little Cable st patt until Hat meas 5½" from beg, ending with Rnd 6 of patt.


Shape Crown

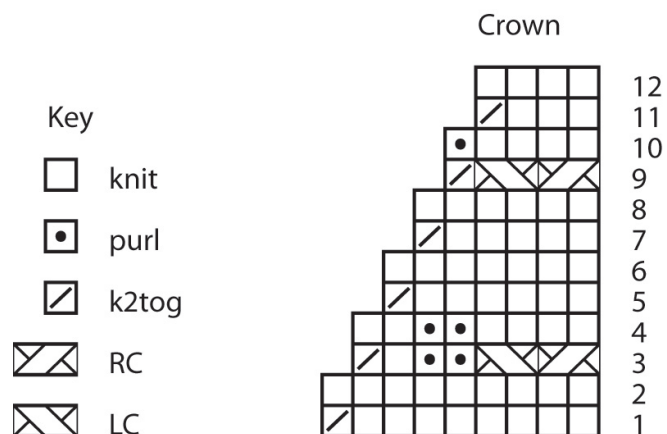
Work Rnds 1-12 of Crown Shaping chart – 48 sts rem.

Next rnd: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 24 sts rem.

Rep this rnd, 2 more times – 6 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl, and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie Pom-Pom securely to top of hat.

ROLL-BRIM BEANIE



SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 17 (19)"

Height: 8½" (8½)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Uptown Worsted (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100g/180 yds)

- 335 Acorn (A) – 1 ball
- 339 Purple Panic (B) – 1 ball
- 337 Neon Yellow (C) – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: One 2½" Luxury Fur Pom-Pom, tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Sequence

Rnds 1-3: With A, knit.

Rnds 4-6: With B, knit.

Rnds 7-9: With C, knit.

Rep Rnds 1-9 for patt.

BEANIE

With A, cast on 81 (90) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Stripe Sequence. Cont in Stripe Sequence until Beanie meas 6¾".

Shape Crown

Cont to work in Stripe Sequence through remainder of Crown.

Set-up rnd: * K9, pm; rep from * to end.

Dec rnd: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end – 9 (10) sts dec'd.

Next rnd: Knit.

Rep these 2 rnds, 7 more times – 9 (10) sts rem.

Break yarn, thread through tapestry ndl and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block. Tie

Pom-Pom securely to top of hat. 

TIP

There are two easy ways to freshen up the look of your Luxury Fur Pom-poms.

- 1: Grasp a Pom-pom at the base and shake!
- 2: Lightly blow on the edges of the Pom-pom evenly.
