



## Pattern Collection: Women



### Hydrangea

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

### SIZES

Extra Small/Small (Medium/Large/1X),  
2X/3X/4X)

Shown in Small/Medium size modeled  
with 3" of positive ease.

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust:** 35 (49, 63)"

### MATERIALS

**Universal Yarn Classic Shades Frenzy**  
(70% acrylic, 30% wool; 100g/158 yds)

- 910 Thrill Ride – 4 (6, 8) balls

**Hook:** US Size J-10 (6 mm) *or size needed  
to obtain gauge*

US Size H-8 (5 mm)

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

1 Motif = 3½" square

**Save time, check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

Motifs, an easy mesh pattern, and tailored edgings make this a super fun project that will keep you on your toes. Stitch patterns are lacy and open, making this garment excellent for layering over tanks and dresses in the spring or fall.

## STITCH GUIDE

**2-dc CL:** [Yo and pull up a lp, yo and pull through 2 lps on hook] 2 times, yo and pull through 3 lps.

### Motif

With larger hook, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, [sc, ch 2, 2-dc CL, ch 2] in ring 4 times, join with sl st to beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [sc, ch 5, sc] in top of next 2-dc CL, \* ch 1, [dc, ch 3, dc] in next sc, ch 1, [sc, ch 5, sc] in top of next 2-dc CL; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, dc in last sc, ch 3, join with sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch 4. Fasten off.

**Joining Rnd 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [sc, ch 2, sl st in corresponding ch-5 sp from previous motif, ch 2, sc] in top of next 2-dc CL, ch 1, [dc, ch 1, sl st in corresponding ch-3 sp from previous motif, ch 1, dc] in next sc, ch 1, [sc, ch 2, sl st in corresponding ch-5 sp from previous motif, ch 2, sc] in top of next 2-dc CL, complete remainder of Rnd 2 as described above.

## YOKE

### Motif 1

Work Rnds 1-2 of Motif.

### Motif 2

Work Rnd 1 of Motif. Work Joining Rnd 2 of Motif, attaching to one side of Motif 1.

### Motifs 3-36 (48, 60)

Work as for Motif 2, joining as you go, following Yoke diagram for Motif placement.

### Neck Edging

With smaller hook, attach yarn with sl st to corner joining sp inside Neck.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next sp, \* ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in sp just before next

join, sc in join, sc in sp just after next join; rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in each sc and 3 sc in each ch-3 sp around, join with sl st to beg sc – 120 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, \* sc2tog tbl, sc tbl of next 31 sc, sc2tog tbl, sc in next sc, sc2tog tbl, sc tbl of next 19 sc, sc2tog tbl; rep from \* 1 more time, join with sl st to beg sc – 112 sc rem.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, \* sc2tog tbl, sc tbl of next 29 sc, sc2tog tbl, sc tbl in next sc, sc2tog tbl, sc tbl of next 17 sc, sc2tog tbl; rep from \* 1 more time, join with sl st to beg sc – 104 sc rem.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, bphdc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg hdc. Fasten off.

## FRONT

With larger hook, attach yarn with sl st to join between first and second motifs from one long side of Yoke.

### Begin Mesh Pattern

*Note: This stitch pattern is also charted for your convenience.*

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next sp, \* ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in sp just before next join, sc in join, sc in sp just after next join; rep from \* to last 2 motifs, ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in sp just before next join between the last 2 motifs, sc in join, turn – 31 (43, 55) sc, 10 (14, 18) ch-2 sps. One motif at each end is unworked for sleeve.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, \* 3 sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3; rep from \* to last sp, 3 sc in last ch-3 sp, sc in last 2 sc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, \* ch 3, 3 sc in ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last 5 sc, ch 3, sc in last 2 sc, turn. Rep Rows 2-3 until piece meas 14", ending with Row 3.

## Hem

Switch to smaller hook.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, hdc in each sc and 3 hdc in each ch-3 sp across, turn – 61 (85, 109) hdc.

**Rows 2-5:** Ch 1, hdc tbl of each hdc across, turn. Fasten off.

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## Back

Work as for Front along other side of Yoke.

## Sleeve Edging

With RS facing, attach yarn with sl st to center ch of corner of right-most motif.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next sp, \* ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in sp just before next join, sc in join, sc in sp just after next join; rep from \* to last motif, ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in last corner motif, sc in center ch of ch-5, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in each sc and 3 sc in each ch-3 sp across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, bphdc in each sc across. Fasten off.

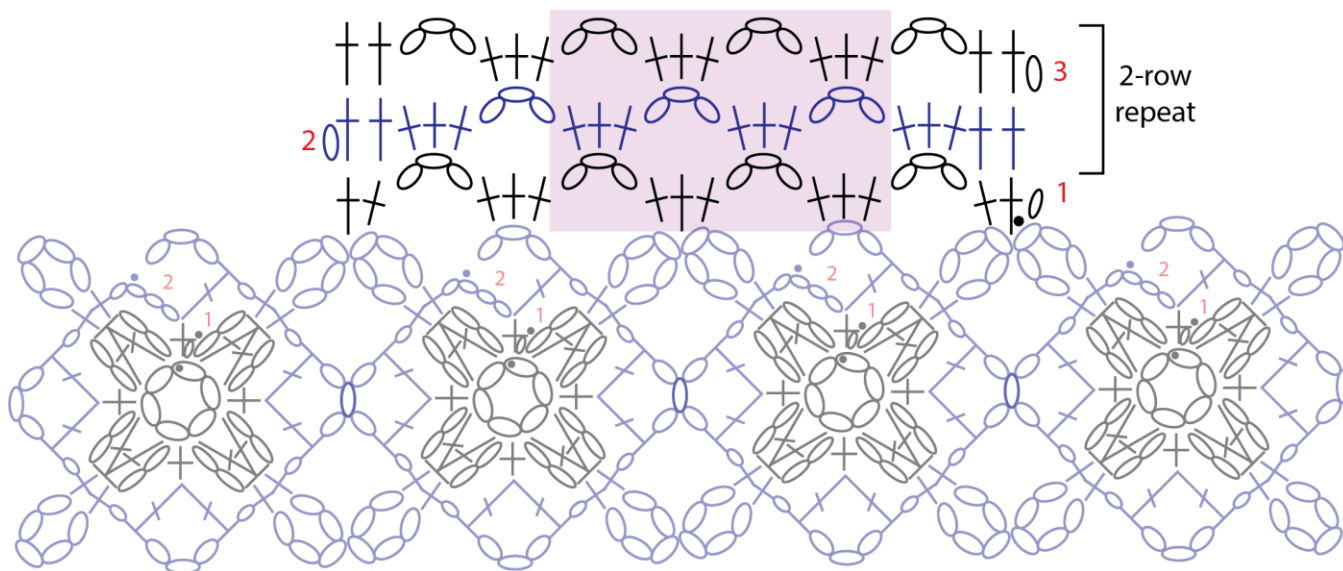
## FINISHING

Block piece to finished measurements. Sew sleeve and side seams. Weave in ends.

<b>bp</b>	back post
<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>hdc</b>	half double crochet
<b>lp(s)</b>	loop(s)
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sc2tog</b>	sc 2 sts together – 1 st dec'd
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>sp</b>	space(s)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>tbl</b>	through the back loop(s)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
<b>yo</b>	yarn over

Mesh Pattern



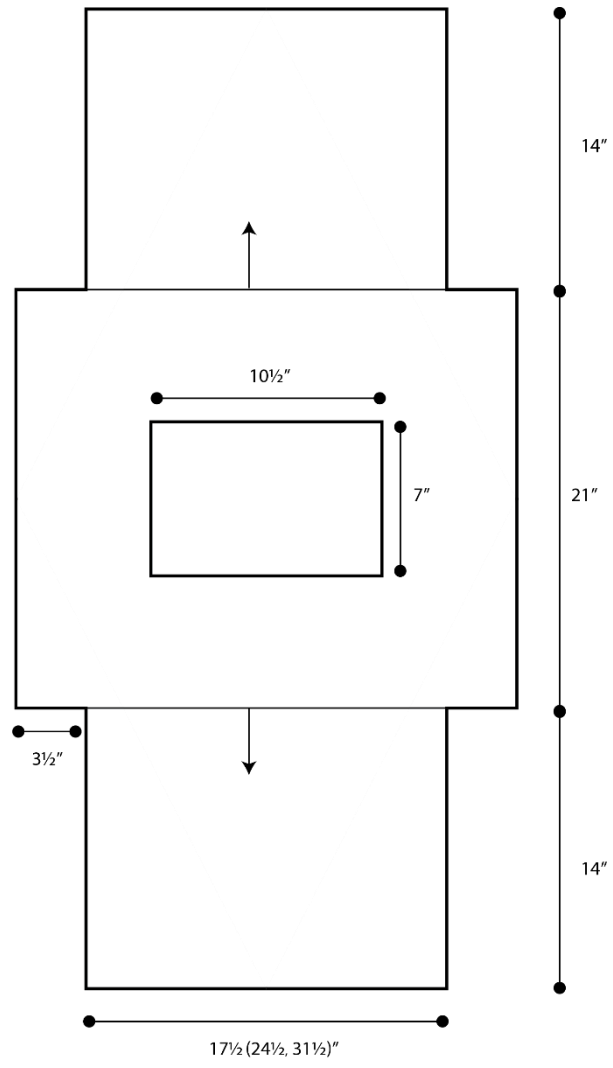
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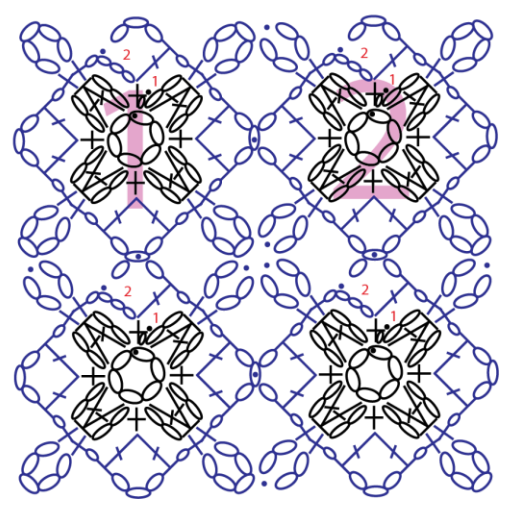
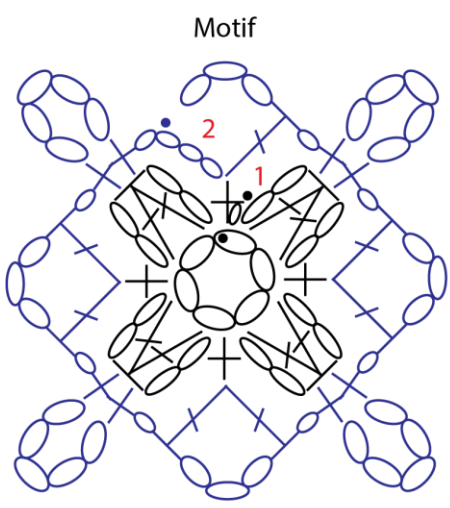

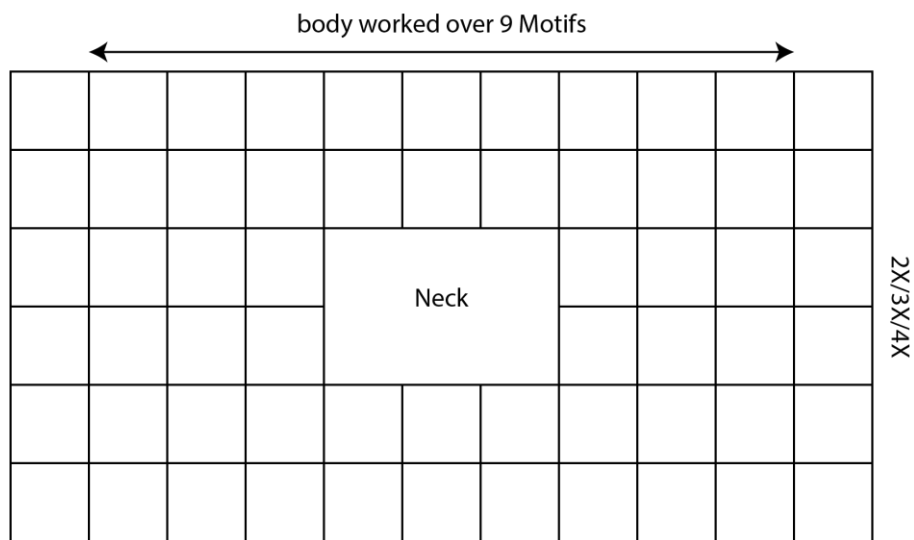
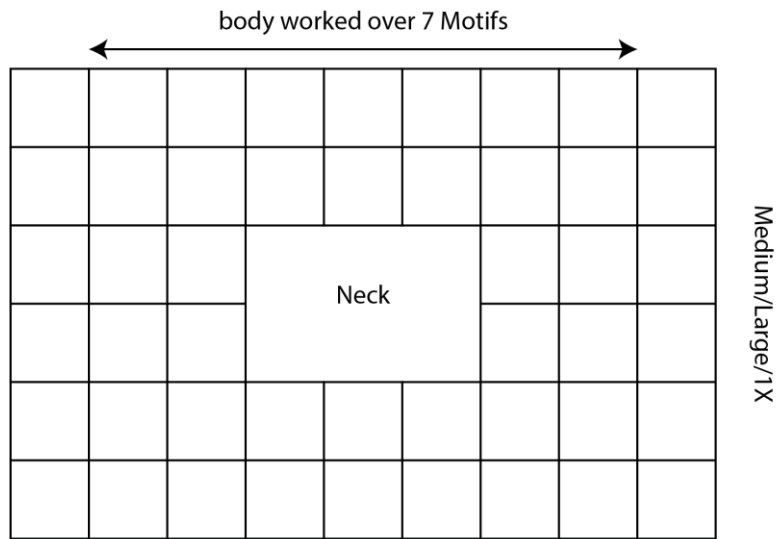
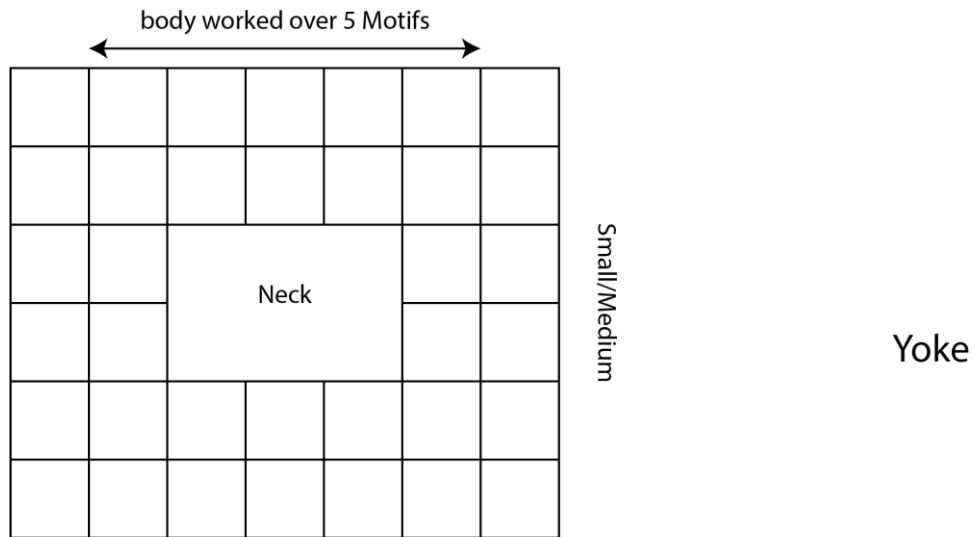
Joining Motifs



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
