

Pattern Collection: Accessories



Inverse Hats Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

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SIZES Adult Small (Medium, Large) Shown in Adult Large size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 17½ (19¼, 20¾)" Stretches to approx. 21 (23, 26)" **Length:** 10¾ (11, 11¼)" with brim uncuffed

MATERIALS

Rozetti Merino Mist (60% viscose, 20% super wash fine merino, 20% acrylic; 50g/167 yds) Sample A:

- 101 Frost (MC) 1 ball (all sizes)
- 103 Wheat (CC) 1 ball (all sizes)

Sample B:

- 103 Wheat (MC) 1 ball (all sizes)
- 101 Frost (CC) 1 ball (all sizes)

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular and set of dpns *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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GAUGE

20 sts x 30 rnds = 4" in Stockinette Stitch using larger ndl

Save time check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Soft and cozy stripes in coordinating neutrals make for a great accessory. Knit in Merino Mist, the Inverse Hats are sure to become a wardrobe staple. Merino Mist's slight metallic sheen means this hat is easily dressed up or down. The simple stripe pattern with colors reversed for each sample creates a timeless look. The best part – one ball of each color is sufficient to knit two hats!

When working in Stripes patt, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, twist the strands of yarn around one another every round, taking care not to twist too tightly.

Take note that color MC and CC as referred in the pattern will be different, depending on the sample you choose to make.

Stitch Guide

K2, P2 Rib

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Stripes

Rnds 1-2: With CC, knit. Rnds 3-4: With MC, knit. Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

HAT

Brim

With MC and smaller ndl, cast on 88 (96, 104) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Work in K2, P2 Rib patt until piece meas approx.

 $3\%^{\prime\prime}$ from cast-on edge. Change to larger 16" circ. Join CC.

Main Hat

Work Rnds 1-4 of Stripes patt until piece meas approx. 7" from cast-on edge.

Shape Crown

Note 1: Cont as est'd in Stripes patt throughout crown shaping.

Note 2: Change to DPNs when there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on circular needle. Set-up Rnd: * K11 (12, 13) pm; rep to end. Dec Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end – 8 sts dec'd, 80 (88, 96) sts rem. Even Rnd: * Knit to m, sl m; rep from * to end. Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd 8 (9, 10) more times – 64 (72, 80) sts dec'd, 16 sts rem. Next Rnd: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 8 sts

dec'd, 8 sts rem. Break yarn leaving an 8" tail, pass tail through rem sts, pull taut, and fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)

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
