



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Juneau Hat

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

SIZES

Baby (Toddler, Child, Teen, Adult Small, Adult Medium, Adult Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 17¼ (18¼, 19½, 20½, 21¾, 22¾, 24)''

Height (before folding inward): 18 (19, 20, 21, 21½, 22, 22½)''

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Deluxe DK Superwash* (100% superwash wool; 100g/220 yds)

Charcoal:

- 835 Ebony – 1 ball (A)

Blush:

- 848 Coral Heather – 1 ball (A)

Rozetti Yarns *Alaska* (44% acrylic, 26% polyamide, 15% alpaca, 15% superwash fine merino wool; 50g/246 yds)

Charcoal:

- 908 Nightfall – 1 ball (B)

Blush:

- 906 Buff – 1 ball (B)

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16'' circular and set of DPNs *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

21 sts x 30 rows = 4'' in Stockinette stitch (St st) with A or B

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The Juneau Hat is a simple, reversible hat. Super soft and cozy Alaska makes the perfect fabric for the inside or outside of a basic hat. A folded brim creates additional warmth around your ears.

The hat is worked from one crown to the other – increasing at the beginning and decreasing at the end. It creates a tube that will look a bit like a capsule. Once completed, simply fold end into the other to create a perfect, reversible hat.

HAT

With A and set of dpns, cast on 6 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Crown Increase Section

Note: When there are too many sts to fit on the dpns, switch to circ ndl.

Setup Rnd: * K1, pm; rep from * to end.

Inc Rnd 1: * Knit to m, m1L, sl m; rep from * to end – 6 sts inc'd, 12 (12, 12, 12, 12, 12) sts. Rep Inc Rnd 0 (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) more time(s) – 12 (18, 24, 30, 36, 42, 48) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit to end.

Rep Inc Rnd every 2 rnds, 13 times – 78 sts inc'd, 90 (96, 102, 108, 114, 120, 126) sts.

Main Hat

Cont even in St st until piece meas 5¼ (5¾, 6, 6½, 7, 7¼, 7¾)". Break A.

Join B. Cont even in St st until piece meas 5¼ (5¾, 6, 6½, 7, 7¼, 7¾)" from color change.

Crown Decrease Section

Note: When there are too few sts to fit on the circ ndl, switch to dpns.

Dec Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end – 6 sts dec'd, 84 (90, 96, 102, 108, 114, 120) sts rem.

Even Rnd: Knit to end.

Rep Dec Rnd every 2 rnds, 13 more times – 78 sts dec'd, 6 (12, 18, 24, 30, 36) sts rem.

Work a Dec Rnd every rnd 0 (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) more times – 0 (6, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36) sts dec'd, 6 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6) sts rem.

Break yarn leaving an 8" tail, pass tail through rem sts, pull taut, and fasten off.

FINISHING

Block to measurements and weave in ends.

Abbreviations

bef	before
circ	circular
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
ndl	needle
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd	round
sl	slip
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)



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
