FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Wingspan: 68½"
Depth at Center: 3411/2"

MATERIALS
Universal Yarn Colorburst (65\%
superwash fine merino, $35 \%$ acrylic; 200g/660 yds)

- 103 Aries - 1 ball

Needles: US Size 8 ( 5 mm ) 32" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) or size needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

## GAUGE

20 sts $\times 24$ rows $=4 "$ in Lace patt Save time check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

The Juniper Berry Shawl features a lovely, undulating lace pattern at a loose gauge. The result is a large and cozy accessory to hug your shoulders whenever there is a chill in the air. Worked up in self-shading Colorburst, this pattern is a joy to knit as you watch the colors change from one to the next. This design is truly a one-skein wonder.

This shawl is knit flat from the top-down. You may wish to place stitch markers between each pattern repeat to help you stay on track.

## STITCH GUIDE

## Lace

(Multiple of 12 sts)
Row 1 (RS): * K1, yo, k4, S2KP2, k4, yo; rep from * to end.

WS Rows 2-10: Purl.
Row 3: * K2, yo, k3, S2KP2, k3, yo, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 5: * K1, yo, ssk, yo, k2, S2KP2, k2, yo, k2tog, yo; rep from * to end.
Row 7: * K2, yo, ssk, yo, k1, S2KP2, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 9: * K1, [yo, ssk] 2 times, yo, S2KP2, yo, [k2tog, yo] 2 times; rep from * to end.
RS Rows 11-13: Knit.
Row 12: Knit.
WS Rows 14-20: Purl.
RS Rows 15-19: * K1, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k1, [k2tog] 2 times, yo, k1, yo; rep from * to end.
Rows 21-24: Knit.
Rep Rows 1-24 for patt.

## SHAWL

## Starting Tab

With MC, cast on 3 sts. Knit 7 rows in garter st.
Set-up Row 1 (RS): K3, rotate work 90 degrees, pick up and knit 3 sts from side of Tab, pick up and knit 3 sts from cast-on edge -9 sts.
Set-up Row 2 (WS): K3, pm, k1, pm, p1, pm, k1, pm, k3.

## Establish Pattern

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.
Row 1 (RS): K3, sl m, yo, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, yo, sl m, k3-4 sts inc'd, 13 sts.
WS Rows 2-12: Knit.
RS Rows 3-11: K3, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k3-20 sts inc'd, 33
sts.
Row 12: Knit.
Row 13: K3, sl m, yo, work Row 1 of Lace patt to 1 st bef m, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, work Row 1 of Lace patt to 1 st bef m, k1, yo, sl m, k3-4 sts inc'd, 37 sts.
WS Rows 14-22: K3, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k1, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k3.
Row 15: K3, sl m, yo, k1, work Row 3 of Lace patt to 2 sts bef m, k2, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, work Row 3 of Lace patt to 2 sts bef m, k2, yo, sl m, k3 - 4 sts inc'd, 41 sts.

Row 17: K3, sl m, yo, k2, work Row 5 of Lace patt to 3 sts bef m, k3, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k2, work Row 5 of Lace patt to 3 sts bef m, k3, yo, sl m, k3 -4 sts inc'd, 45 sts.
Row 19: K3, sl m, yo, k3, work Row 7 of Lace patt to 4 sts bef m, k4, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k3, work Row 7 of Lace patt to 4 sts bef m, k4, yo, sl m, k3 - 4 sts inc'd, 49 sts.

Row 21: K3, sl m, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, work Row 9 of Lace patt to 5 sts bef m, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, work Row 9 of Lace patt to 5 sts bef m, k2, yo, ssk, k1, yo, sl m, k3 - 4 sts inc'd, 53 sts.
RS Rows 23-25: K3, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k3-8 sts inc'd, 61 sts.
Row 24: Knit.
WS Rows 26-32: K3, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k1, sl m, purl to m, sl m, k3.
Row 27: K3, sl m, yo, k1, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1] 2 times, work Row 15 of Lace patt to 8 sts bef m, k2, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k1, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k1, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1] 2 times, work Row 15 of Lace patt to 8 sts bef $m, k 2$, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k1, yo, sl m, k3-4 sts inc'd, 65 sts.
Row 29: K3, sl m, yo, k2, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1]
2 times, work Row 17 of Lace patt to 9 sts bef m,

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k2, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k2, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k2, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1] 2 times, work
Row 17 of Lace patt to 9 sts bef $m$, $k 2$, yo, $k 1$, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k2, yo, sl m, k3-4 sts inc'd, 69 sts. Row 31: K3, sl m, yo, k3, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1] 2 times, work Row 19 of Lace patt to 10 sts bef m, k2, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k3, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, k3, [k2tog] 2 times, [yo, k1] 2 times, work Row 19 of Lace patt to 10 sts bef $m, k 2$, yo, k1, yo, [ssk] 2 times, k3, yo, sl m, k3-4 sts inc'd, 73 sts.
RS Rows 33-35: K3, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k3-8 sts inc'd, 81 sts.
WS Rows 34-36: Knit.
Rep Rows 13-36, 5 more times - 240 sts inc'd, 321 sts.
Bind off all sts kwise.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends but do not trim. Wet or steam block, stretching to enhance lace. Once piece is fully dry, trim ends close to work.
