# FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 73" Depth: 23"

#### **MATERIALS**

# <u>Universal Yarn Bamboo Bloom</u>

Handpaints (44% wool, 48% rayon from bamboo, 8% acrylic; 100g/154 yds)

• 316 Arigato - 5 skeins

**Needle:** US Size 10 (6 mm) 40" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) or size needed to obtain

gauge

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

14 sts x 21 rows = 4" in Garter st after blocking.

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

What is better than a cool breeze on an autumn morning? Wrapping yourself up in a handmade shawl, of course! With <u>Bamboo Bloom Handpaints</u>, simplicity is elevated into so much more due to this beloved yarn's abundance of color and texture. Featuring simple garter stitch, drop stitches, and increases, Kerid is a crescent-shaped shawl great for beginner knitters looking to grow their skills or someone looking for a relaxing project!

This shawl is knit flat from the top down. Four stitches are increased every right side row, and two stitches are increased every wrong side row. Instructions for the shawl are in written form only.

#### STITCH GUIDE

KYOK: [K1, yo, k1] into next st - 2 sts inc'd.

#### PATTERN BEGINS

**SHAWL** 

Cast on 10 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, pm, KYOK, k2, KYOK, pm, k3 – 4 sts inc'd, 14 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k3 - 2 sts inc'd. 16 sts.

Row 3: K3, sl m, KYOK, knit to 1 st bef m, KYOK, sl m, k3 - 4 sts inc'd, 20 sts.

**Row 4**: K3, sl m, yo, knit to m, yo, sl m, k3 – 2 sts inc'd. 22 sts.

Rep Rows 3-4, 58 more times – 348 sts inc'd, 370 sts.

#### Drop Stitch Edge

Note: In this section, you will be creating drop stitches. Please read through the row instructions carefully before proceeding.

Row 1 (RS): K3, sl m, KYOK, knit to 1 st bef m, wrapping the yarn twice around the needle when knitting each stitch, KYOK, sl m, k3 - 4 sts inc'd, 374 sts.

Row 2 (WS): K3, sl m, yo, k3, knit to 3 sts bef m, knitting into the first loop of every stitch and letting the 2<sup>nd</sup> loop drop off the ndl creating a drop stitch, k3, yo, sl m, k3 - 2 sts inc'd, 376 sts. Bind off all sts kwise using your preferred elastic bind-off method.

## **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
