## Kobuk Cowl

## **DIFFICULTY**

Easy

#### **SIZES**

One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 29"

Height: 10"

## **MATERIALS**

<u>Universal Yarn Be Woo/</u> (40% Wool, 60% Acrylic; 200g/94 yds)

• 114 Cerulean (A) - 1 ball

<u>Universal Yarn Be Wool Multis</u> (40% Wool, 60% Acrylic; 170g/80 yds)

• 206 Rusted (B) - 1 ball

**Hook:** US size N/15 (10.0 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable

stitch markers

#### **GAUGE**

7 sts x 6 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet (Hdc)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Embrace fall and adventure with the Kobuk Cowl. Named for the Kobuk Valley National Park, with an enchanting, dreamlike landscape. This cowl's earthy and frosty tones gave us the inspiration for its namesake. It is soft, thick, and the perfect size to tuck into a jacket for your own adventure.

This cowl is worked in unturned rounds.

#### STITCH GUIDE

#### Front Post Half Double Crochet (FPhdc)

Yo, insert hk from front to back to front around the post of the indicated st, draw up lp (3 lps on hk), yo and draw though all 3 lps on hk.

## Back Post Half Double Crochet (BPhdc)

Yo, insert hk from back to front to back around the post of the indicated st, draw up lp (3 lps on hk), yo and draw though all 3 lps on hk.

#### V Stitch (V-st)

[Dc, ch 1, dc] in the indicated st.

#### PATTERN BEGINS

Begin: Ch 52, sl st into 1st ch.

Rnd 1 (RS): with color A, ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout) and hdc in each st around, sl st into top of beg ch-2 hdc - 52 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, \* FPhdc in next st, BPhdc in next st; repeat from \* 24 times, Fphdc around last hdc, sl st into top of beg ch-2 hdc.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2, cut yarn and switch to color B. Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk 1st st, V-st in the next st, \* sk 2 sts, V-st in next st; rep from \* around, sl st into top of beg ch-3 dc - 17 V-sts made.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, \* V-st in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* around, sl st into top of beg ch-3 dc.
Rnds 6-9: Rep Rnd 5, cut yarn and switch to color

A. Rep Rnd 5, cut yarn and switch to color

Rnd 10: Ch 2, then hdc in each st around, sl st into top of beg ch-3 - 52 sts.

Rnd 11: Ch 2, \* FPhdc in next st, BPhdc in next st; rep from \* 24 times, FPhdc around last hdc, sl st into top of beg ch-2 hdc

Rnd 12: Rep Row 11. Cut yarn and fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Gently wash and block to finished measurements.
