# Little Lace Bucket Hat

# **DIFFICULTY**

Easy

#### SIZES

Newborn (Baby, Toddler) *Shown in Newborn size.* 

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference: 18¼ (20, 21¾)" Sized to fit Head Circumference of

approx: 13 (14, 15)". Length: 6½ (6¾, 7¼)"

#### **MATERIALS**

Universal Yarn Filly (46% cotton, 33% fine superwash merino wool, 12% polyamide, 9% PBT; 100g/492 yds)

• 103 Butterfly - 1 skein

**Needle:** US Size 4 (3.5 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### **GAUGE**

22 sts x 34 rnds = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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#### **PATTERN NOTES**

For a day at the park or strolling along the beach, a bucket hat is a perfect accessory for your little one. A little lace on the brim adds extra excitement to a simple design. Our Filly yarn is light and breathable, with beautiful bands of colors throughout the skein. The Little Lace Bucket Hat works up quickly and makes a wonderful gift for someone who's expecting.

This hat is knit in the round from the bottom up. The brim is worked first and features a decorative lace motif. Decreases are worked before the main hat, then it is worked evenly before crown shaping.

Note that brim of this hat is floppy and not fitted. After the decreases are incorporated into the brim, the hat measures approx. 12¾ (14, 15¼)". Use these measurements as a reference when choosing a size and choose a size with 0-1" of negative ease, or up to 1" of positive ease.

#### STITCH GUIDE

#### Little Lace Brim

(begins as a multiple of 10 sts)

Rnd 1: Purl. Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnds 3-4: Rep Rnds 1-2.

Rnd 5: \* K8, k2tog, yo; rep from \* to end.

Even Rnds 6-14: Knit.

Rnd 7: \* Yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* to

Rnd 9: \* K1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k2; rep from \* to

Rnd 11: \* K2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 13: \* K4, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 15: \* [K2tog, k2] 2 times, k2tog; rep from \* to

end - 3 sts dec'd per rep; 7 sts rem per rep.

Rnd 16: Purl. Rnd 17: Knit. Rnd 18: Purl.

#### **PATTERN BEGINS**

HAT Brim

Cast on 100 (110, 120) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Work Rnds 1-18 of Little Lace Brim patt. Patt will be repeated 10 (11, 12) times across each rnd. After all rnds are complete, 30 (33, 36) sts dec'd, 70

(77, 84) sts rem.

#### Main Hat

Work even in St st until piece meas approx. 4% (5¼, 5½)" from cast-on edge.

#### Newborn & Baby Sizes Only:

Next Rnd: Knit to end, dec'ing 4 (5) sts evenly across rnd - 66 (72) sts rem.

#### All Sizes:

66 (72, 84) sts.

**Set-up Rnd**: \* K11 (12, 14), pm; rep from \* to end. Dec Rnd: \* Knit to 2 sts bef m, ssk, sl m; rep from \* to end - 6 sts dec'd. 60 (66, 78) sts rem.

Even Rnd: Knit, slipping markers as you come to them.

Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd, 3 more times - 18 sts dec'd. 42 (48. 60) sts rem.

Rep Dec Rnd only, 5 (6, 8) more times - 30 (36, 48) sts dec'd, 12 sts rem (all sizes).

Next Rnd: \* Ssk; rep from \* to end - 6 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem (all sizes).

Break yarn leaving approx. 6" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

## **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
