SKILL

Crochet

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7½"

Length: 58½"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Major](#) (100% acrylic; 200g/328 yds)

- 145 Feather - 1 ball

Hook: US Size J/10 (6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

13 sts x 9 rows = 4" in Herringbone Half Double Crochet (hhdc)

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

This sophisticated scarf puts a new twist on a classic beginner stitch. With one small variation, a whole new pattern awaits. Take the plunge and add this stitch to your skillset - it's easier than you think!

This scarf is crocheted flat from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

Herringbone Half Double Crochet (hhdc)

Yo, insert hk into indicated st, yo, pull up lp through st and first lp on hk (2 lps left on hk), yo, draw through rem 2 lps.

PATTERN BEGINS

Scarf

Ch 25.

Row 1: Hhdc in 3rd ch from hk (chs count as st) and each ch across, turn - 24 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as a st here and throughout), hhdc in next and each st across, turn.

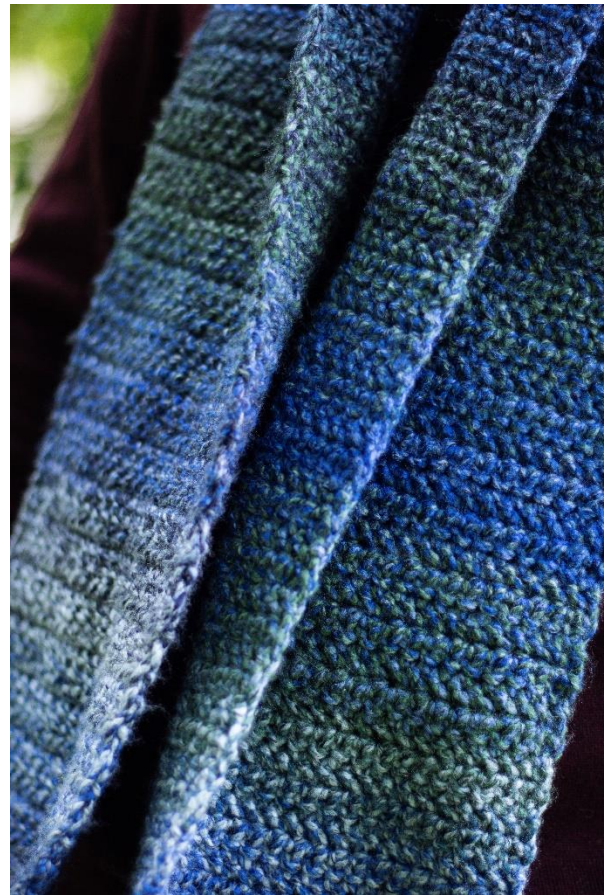
Rows 3-133: Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch	chain
hk	hook
lp(s)	loop(s)
rem	remain(ing)
st(s)	stitch(es)
yo	yarn over



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
