Malawi Earrings

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: adjustable

Height: adjustable

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Yashi Iro (100% Raffia; 50 g /124 yds)

- 204 Sea Life – 1 skein

Universal Yarn Yashi (100% Raffia; 40g/99 yds)

- 102 Rice – 1 skein
- 105 Hot Aqua – 1 skein
- 101 Spider – 1 skein

Hook: US Size E-4 (3.5 mm) *It is not necessary to exactly match the hook size.*

Notions: 24-gauge jewelry making wire, pliers, 8 fishhook earrings, 4, $\frac{3}{4}$ " raindrop loop for earrings, 2 round beads, 2 conical shaped beads, jewelry pliers

GAUGE

Not applicable

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

Just a couple balls of Yashi, a few jewelry notions, plus a smidge of time and you can have a whole new assortment of earrings. You can follow the instructions below to make the earrings as shown in the photos. But once you sit down with your Yashi and pretty notions, I bet you'll come up with so many more ideas to make! Each set of earrings takes just a small amount of yarn, so there will be plenty of leftovers to play around with.

To Attach Fringe: Fold yarn strand (s) in half. Insert hook through earring (or wire) and through the folded end of yarn, pull loose ends of yarn through, making taut.

Small Loop Earrings

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Yashi (100% Raffia; 40g/99 yds)

- 105 Hot Aqua (MC) – 1 skein

Universal Yarn Yashi Iro (100% Raffia; 50 g /124 yds)

- 204 Sea Life (CC) – 1 skein

Notions: 2 fishhook earrings, 2 ¾" raindrop loops, jewelry pliers

Make Fringe

With MC, cut 26, 2½" strands of yarn. With CC, cut 24, 2½" strands of yarn.

Group 1: Holding 1 strand of MC and using a crochet hk, attach 1 group to raindrop loop.

Group 2: Holding 1 strand of CC and using a crochet hk, attach 1 group to raindrop loop.

Alternate Groups 1 and 2, 11 more times. Attach Group 1, one more time – 25 total groups. Rep for second earring.

Using pliers, carefully attach fishhook earring to loops.

FINISHING

Trim Fringe to ¾" or desired length.



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Large Loop Earrings

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Yashi Iro (100% Raffia; 50 g /124 yds)

- 204 Sea Life (MC) – 1 skein

Universal Yarn Yashi (100% Raffia; 40g/99 yds)

- 102 Rice (CC) – 1 skein

Notions: 2 fishhook earrings, 2 ¾" raindrop loops, jewelry pliers

Make Fringe

With MC, cut 28, 4½" strands of yarn. With CC, cut 24, 4½" strands of yarn.

Group 1: Holding 2 strands of MC tog as 1 group and using a crochet hk, attach 1 group to earring loop.

Group 2: Holding 2 strands of CC tog as 1 group and using a crochet hk, attach 1 group to earring loop.

Alternate Groups 1 and 2, 5 more times. Attach Group 1, one more time –13 total groups. Rep for second earring.

FINISHING

Using pliers, carefully attach fishhook earring to loops. Trim Fringe to 2" or desired length.



Bead & Knot Earrings

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Yashi (100% Raffia; 40g/99 yds)

- 101 Spider (MC) – 1 skein

Notions: 2 fishhook earrings, two ½" beads with an opening of approx. ¼", 24-gauge wire, jewelry pliers

Make Fringe

Cut 10, 5" strands of yarn. With wire, create a small loop – just large enough to fit hk through. Holding 5 strands tog as one group, use hk to attach group to loop. Pull taut. Thread bead through the group. Form a loop and pass the end of the group through it. Tighten to form an overhand knot. Rep for second earring.

FINISHING

Use pliers to attach the wire loop to fishhook earrings. Trim Fringe to 1¼" or desired length below knot.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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Conical Fringe Earrings

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Yashi* (100% Raffia; 40g/99 yds)

- 101 Spider (MC) – 1 skein

Notions: 2 fishhook earrings, two conical beads approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ " long and with a bottom opening of approx. $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 24-gauge wire, jewelry pliers

Make Fringe

Cut 20, 11" strands of yarn. Cut 2 pieces of wire approx. $2\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Holding 10 strands tog as one group, attach Fringe by folding in half and placing over wire. Fold wire over the top of Fringe and use pliers to twist and close. Carefully thread wire through bead and form a small loop using pliers. *Note: The loop should be approx. $\frac{1}{16}$ " wide.* Rep for second earring.

FINISHING

Use pliers to attach the wire loop to fishhook earrings. Trim Fringe to $3\frac{1}{4}$ " or desired length below bead.
