#### **DIFFICULTY**

Intermediate

#### **SIZES**

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Shown in Adult Small size with approx 2" of positive ease.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 29¾ (33½, 37¾, 41¼, 45¾) (49¼, 53¾, 57¼, 61¾)"

Length: 23 (23¾, 23¾, 23¾, 23¾) (24¼, 24¼, 24¾, 24¾)"

#### **MATERIALS**

Universal Yarn Offbeat (90% acrylic, 10% alpaca; 150g/586 yds)

> 110 Far Out - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) balls - See pattern notes.

Hook: US Size G/6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size E/4 (3.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers

#### **GAUGE**

18 sts x 14 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet (hdc) with larger hk Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Amp up your wardrobe with McKenzie, a crochet sweater designed to delight. Featuring intricate post-stitch cables on the front, thoughtful neck shaping, and soothing half double crochet stitches, McKenzie isn't just a project, but a wearable piece of art! Our soft, self-striping Offbeat yarn adds a playful element that will bring a smile to your face with its vibrant color palette and supple texture with a subtle halo. Together, the crafting experience and dynamic yarn will make you the talk of your local yarn store!

Sizes Medium, 2X, and 4X use almost exactly the noted amount of yarn. Accurate gauge is crucial to ensure you do not run out of yarn. After obtaining gauge, unravel your swatch and use it for the sweater. Alternatively, you may wish to purchase an extra ball as insurance.

Offbeat is a self-striping yarn. To ensure your project looks as close to the sample as possible, when starting each section, be sure to visually match the color to the point at which you are rejoining. This will require you to wind off some yarn, but we promise the results are worth the effort! If you choose to use this method, you may wish to purchase an extra skein as insurance.

When making Post stitches, always skip the equivalent amount of stitches on the current row.

#### STITCH GUIDE

## Front Post Treble Crochet (FPtr)

[Yo] 2 times, insert hk from front to back to front around the post of the indicated st, yo, pull up lp (4 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (3 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo and draw through rem 2 lps on hk.

#### Front Post Double Treble Crochet (FPdtr)

[Yo] 3 times, insert hk from front to back around the post of the indicated st, yo, pull up Ip (5 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (4 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (3 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 lps (2 lps on hk), yo and draw through 2 rem lps on hk.

# PATTERN BEGINS

FRONT Hem

Wish smaller hk, ch 11.

Row 1: Sc into  $2^{\rm nd}$  ch from hk and each ch across, turn – 10 sc.

Row 2-69 (77, 87, 95, 105) (113, 123, 131, 141): Ch 1, blo sc in 1st and each st across, turn.

Do not fasten off.

## Main Body

Set-up Rows

#### Size Extra Small ONLY

Switch to larger hk. Rotate the Hem to stitch directly into the edge of the rows already made.

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2 (counts as a st here and throughout), hdc in the side of each row, turn – 69 (x, x, x, x) (x, x, x, x) hdc.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Size XS, proceed to Establish Cable Panel section.

# Sizes Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X ONLY

Switch to larger hk. Rotate the Hem to stitch directly into the edge of the rows already made.

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2 (counts as a st here and throughout), hdc in the side of each row, turn – x (77, 87, 95, 105) (113, 123, 131, 141) hdc.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Set-up Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next x (20, 25, 29, 34) (38, 43, 47, 52) sts, \* FPtr in the next 2 sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, FPtr in the next 2 sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

**Set-up Row 4**: Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Sizes Small, Medium, Large, 1X, proceed to Establish Cable Panel section.

#### Sizes 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X ONLY

Rep Rows 3-4, x(x, x, x, x) (1, 1, 2, 2) more time(s). Proceed to Establish Cable Panel section.

# Establish Cable Panel

### Size Extra Small ONLY

Note: In this row you will establish Post Stitches.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, hdc in next 16 sts, \* sk 3 sts, FPdtr in next 2 hdcs 2 rows below, sk next 2 sts on current row, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in the first 2 sk'd hdcs 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn...

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

# Sizes Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, hdc in next x (20, 25, 29, 34) (38, 43, 47, 52) sts, \* sk 3 sts, FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

# Cable Panel ALL SIZES

Note: Row 1 has been worked for all sizes in the previous section. All sizes will now begin at Row 2.

WS Rows 2-16: Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Row 3 (RS): Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (19, 23, 27, 32) (36, 41, 45, 50) sts, \* reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5 sts, reaching backwards FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next st; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (18, 23, 27, 32) (36, 41, 45, 50) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, \* hdc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and behind sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below; rep from \* 2 more times, hdc in next 5 sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (18, 23, 27, 32) (36, 41, 45, 50) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, \* hdc in next 5 sts \*\*, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across. turn.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Row 11: Ch 2, hdc in next 16 (20, 25, 29, 34) (38, 43, 47, 52) sts, \* reaching backwards FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

Row 13: Ch 2, hdc in next 16 (20, 25, 29, 34) (38, 43, 47, 52) sts, \* sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

Row 15: Ch 2, hdc in next 16 (20, 25, 29, 34) (38, 43, 47, 52) sts, \* FPtr in the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, FPtr in the next 2 FP sts 2 rows below \*\*, hdc in next 5 sts; rep from \* 3 more times ending at \*\*, hdc in rem sts across, turn.

Row 17: Rep Row 13.

Rep Rows 2-17. 2 more times.

Rep Rows 2-16, 1 more time. Do not fasten off.

#### **Neck Shaping**

Sizes Extra Small, Small, Medium ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2. hdc in next 16 (20, 25, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below hdc in rem sts across, turn. Do not fasten off, proceed to Right Side.

#### Right Side

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next 29 (33, 38, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, turn - 30 (34, 39, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts.

Row 3: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5 sts, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn – 2 sts dec'd, 28 (32, 37, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, hdc in next 25 (28, 34, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, turn - 2 sts dec'd, 26 (30, 35, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

Row 5: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, reaching backward FPdtr in first 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 4 sts, sk next 2 FP sts and FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, 24 (28, 33, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

**Row 6**: Ch 2, hdc in next 21 (24, 30, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, turn - 2 sts dec'd, 22 (26, 31, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

Row 7: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next 2 sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across - 2 sts dec'd, 20 (24, 29, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts. Fasten Off.

#### Left Side

With WS facing, attach yarn to the *center hdc* of the third FP sequence of Row 1. A chart is provided for reference.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn - 30 (34, 39, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (18, 23, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, sk next 2 sts on current row, hdc in next 5 sts, reaching backwards FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, sk next 2 sts on current row, hdc in next st, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, sk next 2 sts on current row, hdc in next st, turn – 2 sts dec'd, 28 (32, 37, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

Row 4: SI st in first 3 sts, ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, 26 (30, 35, x,x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (18, 23, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 4 sts, reaching forward sk next 2 FP sts and FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, turn - 2 sts dec'd, 24 (28, 33, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

**Row 6**: Rep Row 4 - 2 sts dec'd, 22 (26, 31, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 2, hdc in next 14 (18, 23, x, x) (x, x, x, x) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts - 2 sts dec'd, 20 (24, 29, x, x) (x, x, x, x) total sts. Fasten Off.

#### Sizes Large, 1X, 2X ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 29, 34) (38, x, x, x) sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below hdc in rem sts across, turn. Do not fasten off, proceed to Right Side.

#### Right Side

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 41) (46, 50, x, x) sts, turn - x (x, x, x, 42) (47, 51, x, x) sts.

Row 3: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next st, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 40) (45, 49, x, x) total sts.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 37) (42, 46, x, x) sts, turn - x (x, x, x, 38) (43, 47, x, x) sts.

Row 5: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, reaching backward FPdtr in first 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, sk next 2 FP sts and FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 36) (41, 45, x, x) sts.

Row 6: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 34) (38, 42, x, x) sts, turn - x (x, x, x, 34) (39, 43, x, x) sts.

Row 7: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next st, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 32) (37, 41, x, x) sts. Fasten off.

#### Left Side

With WS facing, attach yarn to the *third FP st* of the third FP sequence of Row 1. A chart is provided for reference.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn – x(x, x, x, 42) (47, 51, x, x) sts.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 27, 32) (36, x, x, x) sts, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, turn – 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 40) (45, 49, x, x) total sts.

Row 4: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 38) (43, 47, x, x) sts.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 27, 32) (36, x, x, x) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, reaching forward sk next 2 FP sts and FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 36) (41, 45, x, x) sts.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4 - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 34) (39, 43, x, x) sts.

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, 27, 32) (36, x, x, x) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, 32) (37, 41, x, x) sts. Fasten off.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

### Sizes 3X, 4X, 5X ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 43, 47, 52) sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 4, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, sc in next 5 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 4 sts, sk 2 FP sts below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, reaching backward and in front of sts just made FPdtr in 2 sk'd FP sts 2 rows below hdc in rem sts across, turn. Do not fasten off, proceed to Right Side.

#### Right Side

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x) (x, 54, 58, 63) sts, turn - x (x, x, x, x) (x, 55, 59, 64) sts.

Row 3: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next st, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, reaching backward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 53, 57, 62) sts.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x) (x, 50, 54, 59) sts, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 51, 55, 60) sts

Row 5: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, reaching backward FPdtr in first 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, sk next 2 FP sts and FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x(x, x, x, x) (x, 49, 53, 58) sts.

**Row 6**: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x) (x, 48, 50, 55) sts, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 47, 51, 56) sts.

Row 7: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in rem sts across - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 45, 49, 54) sts.

#### Left Side

With WS facing, attach yarn to the *third FP st* of the third FP sequence of Row 1. A chart is provided for reference.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn - x (x, x, x, x) (x, 55, 59, 64) sts.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x, x) (x, 41, 45, 50) sts, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 3 sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, reaching forward FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 53, 57, 62) sts.

Row 4: SI st in first 3 sts, Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x(x, x, x, x)(x, 51, 55, 60) sts.

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x, x) (x, 41, 45, 50) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next 2 sts, reaching forward sk next 2 FP sts and FPdtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st, turn - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 49, 53, 58) sts.

**Row 6**: Rep Row 4 - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 47, 51, 56) sts.

**Row 7**: Ch 2, hdc in next x (x, x, x, x) (x, 41, 45, 50) sts, FPtr in next 2 FP sts 2 rows below, hdc in next st - 2 sts dec'd, x (x, x, x, x) (x, 45, 49, 54) sts. Fasten off.

#### **BACK**

#### Hem

With smaller hk, ch 11.

Row 1: Sc into  $2^{nd}$  ch from hk and each ch across, turn – 10 sc.

Rows 2-69 (77, 87, 95, 105) (113, 123, 131, 141): Ch 1, blo sc in 1st and each st across, turn.

Do not fasten off.

#### Main Body

Switch to larger hk. Rotate the hem to stitch directly into the edge of the rows already made.

Row 1: Ch 2, hdc in the side of each row, turn - 69 (77, 87, 95, 105) (113, 123, 131, 141) hdc.

Rows 2-73 (75, 75, 75, 75) (77, 77, 79, 79): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Fasten off after the last row.

#### **SLEEVES**

Make 2 alike.

# Cuff

With smaller hk, ch 10.

**Row 1**: Sc into  $2^{nd}$  ch from hk and each ch across, turn – 9 sc.

Rows 2-34 (36, 36, 40, 40) (44, 44, 44, 44): Ch 1, blo sc in 1st and each st across, turn.

Do not fasten off.

#### Shape Sleeves

Switch to larger hk. Rotate the Cuff to stitch directly into the edge of the rows already made.

**Set-up Row**: Ch 2, hdc in the side of each row, turn - 34 (36, 36, 40, 40) (44, 44, 44, 44) hdc.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

#### Increase Section 1

Inc Row: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc across until 1 st rem, 2hdc in last st, turn – 2 sts inc'd, 36 (38, 38, 42, 42, (46, 46, 46, 46) hdc.

Next 3 (1, 1, 1, 1) (1, 1, x, x) row(s): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Rep these 4 (2, 2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 1, 1) row(s), 11 (3, 8, 8, 13) (13, 20, 3, 11) more times – 22 (6, 16, 16, 26) (26, 40, 6, 22) sts inc'd, 58 (44, 54, 58, 68) (72, 86, 52, 68) hdc.

Sizes Extra Small and 3X ONLY proceed to Even Section.

#### Increase Section 2

Inc Row: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc across until 1 st rem, 2hdc in last st, turn – 2 sts inc'd, x (46, 56, 60, 70) (74, x, 54, 70) hdc

Next x (3, 3, 3, 3) (3, x, 1, 1) row(s): Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Rep these x (4, 4, 4, 4) (4, x, 2, 2) rows, x (9, 6, 6, 3) (3, x, 18, 12) more times – x (18, 12, 12, 6) (6, x, 36, 24) sts inc'd, 58 (64, 68, 72, 76) (80, 86, 90, 94) hdc.

#### **Even Section**

Even Rows: Ch 2, hdc in next and each st across, turn.

Cont even as established for 5 (5, 6, 6, 6) (6, 5, 5, 6) more rows, or until piece meas 17½ (17½, 17¼, 17¼, 16½) (16½, 15¾, 15¾, 14¾)". Fasten Off.

#### **FINISHING**

Gently wash and block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeve and side seams.

## Collar

With RS facing, attach yarn at either shoulder seam of the neck.

With smaller hk, ch 11.

Row 1: Sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk and each ch across working towards sweater, sl st into st at base of ch, sl st in next st, turn - 10 sc.

Row 2: Blo in each st across working away from sweater, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, blo in each sc st across working towards sweater, sl st into st at base of row, sl st in next st, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 around neck until Row 1 is reached. To seam, align RS of Row 1 and final row and sl st through beg ch and flo sc of final row across 10 sts. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.








Cable Panel Size Extra Small



Cable Panel Sizes Small, Medium, Marge, 1x, 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x





Neck Shaping Sizes Extra Small, Small, Medium






