SIZES

One Size (Baby)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hand Circumference: 4½"

Length: 5"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Adore (55% superwash merino, 45% acrylic; 100g/273 yds)

Sample

- 101 Peony – 1 skein (**sample 1**)
- 103 Capri – 1 skein (**sample 2**)

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) set of DPNS or your preferred needle for small circumference knitting *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 4 (3.5 mm) set of DPNS or your preferred needle for small circumference knitting

Notions: stitch marker, tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 sts x 27 rnds = 4" in Left or Right

Diagonal patt on larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

These adorable little mittens are perfect for the wee one in your life. Simple knit and purl stitches create a diagonal pattern across the front and back of each mitten. To add to the simplicity of the pattern, no thumb is included and that means there is less faffing around as you try to fit these over your little one's wriggly little hands. The set of mitts connect with an I-cord, ensuring that a single mitten is never lost. The best part? A single skein will make about seven sets!

The Mini Mittens are worked in the round from the bottom up. They do not have a thumb. They feature a cute I-cord to keep them together.

STITCH GUIDE

I-Cord

Cast on 3 sts to dpn. * K3, slide sts to other end of ndl and place in left hand; rep from * until piece meas desired length.

Left Diagonal

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p2, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * P1, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

Right Diagonal

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p2, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * P1, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

LEFT MITTEN

With smaller needle, cast on 24 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful to twist.

Cuff

Rnds 1-8: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Change to larger ndl.

Main Mitten

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Left Diagonal patt to end.

Patt will be repeated 6 times across each rnd.

Cont as est'd through Rnd 4 of Left Diagonal patt, then rep Rnds 1-4 of Left Diagonal patt, 3 more times.

Left Tip

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.

Rnd 1: * K1, p2, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: [Ssk, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 20 sts rem.

Rnd 4: P1, [k2, p2] 2 times, k1, p1, [k2, p2] 2 times, k1.

Rnd 5: [Ssk, k2, p2, k2, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.

Rnd 6: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: [Ssk, p1, k2, p1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Rnd 8: [Ssk, p1, k1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.

Rnd 9: [Ssk, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 4 sts rem. Break yarn leaving approx. 6" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts, pull taut to close.

RIGHT MITTEN

With smaller needle, cast on 24 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful to twist.

Cuff

Rnds 1-8: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Change to larger ndl.

Main Mitten

Rnd 1: Work Rnd 1 of Right Diagonal patt to end.

Patt will be repeated 6 times across each rnd.

Cont as est'd through Rnd 4 of Right Diagonal patt, then rep Rnds 1-4 of Right Diagonal patt, 3 more times.

Right Tip

Note: This section is also charted for your convenience.

Rnd 1: * K1, p2, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: * P2, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: [Ssk, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 20 sts rem.

Rnd 4: K1, [p2, k2] 2 times, p1, k1, [p2, k2] 2 times, p1.

Rnd 5: [Ssk, k2, p2, k2, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 16 sts rem.

Rnd 6: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

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Rnd 7: [Ssk, p1, k2, p1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Rnd 8: [Ssk, k1, p1, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 8 sts rem.

Rnd 9: [Ssk, k2tog] 2 times – 4 sts dec'd, 4 sts rem. Break yarn leaving approx. 6" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts, pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Block Mittens to finished measurements and weave in ends.

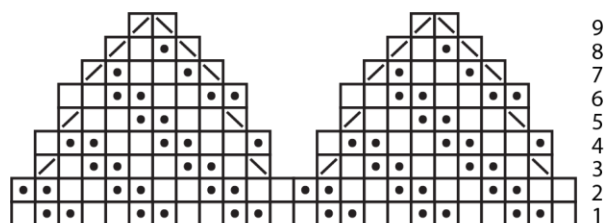
I-Cord Connector

Make an I-cord approx. 10½" long. Bind off. Sew one end of I-Cord to the left edge of Left Mitten cast-on. Sew opposite end to right edge of Right Mitten cast-on. Weave in rem ends.

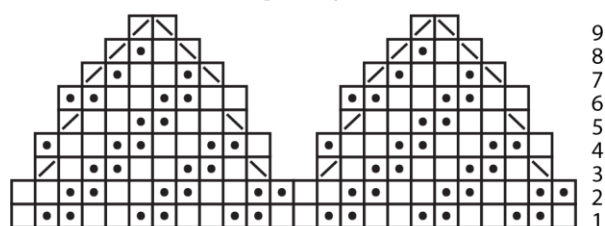
Abbreviations

dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
est'd	established
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
rnd	round
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)

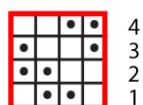
Left Tip



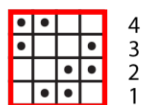
Right Tip
