SIZE

One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 59"

Depth: 16"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Revolutions* (57% acrylic, 15% nylon, 10% wool, 10% alpaca, 8% mohair; 200g/612 yds)

• 107 Harmony – 1 skein

Needles: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 24" circular

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

12 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Texture patt **Save time, check your gauge.**

PATTERN NOTES

This generously sized cowl shows off the long color repeat in Revolutions beautifully. A simple textured stitch pattern is easy to remember and adds just enough interest. Wear this cowl long, or double-wrap it around your neck for extra warmth.

STITCH GUIDE

Texture

(even number of sts)

Note: The stitch count is cut in half after Rnd 3, and then restored back to the original stitch count after Rnd 4.

Rnds 1-2: Knit.

Rnd 3: *P2tog; rep from * to end. Rnd 4: * Kfb; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-4 for patt.

COWL

Cast on 176 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Purl 1 rnd. Work Rnds 1-4 of Texture patt, 18 times. Knit 1 rnd. Bind off all sts pwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

Abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st

dec'd)

kfb knit into front and back of next st

(1 st inc'd)

patt pattern
pm place marker
pwise purlwise
rep repeat
st(s) stitch(es)
