SIZES

Poncho is sized to fit Women's Small /Medium (Large/1X, 2X/3X) Shown in Small/Medium size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 30 (33, 35¾)" Length: 20 (21, 22)"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura Radiant Cotton (100% cotton; 100g/203 yds)

• 809 Atlantic -5 (6, 7) skeins **Needles:** US Size 6 (4 mm) 32" circular (or longer) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" circular (for neck edging)

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders

GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Medallions patt Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

This easy to wear poncho is worked in two pieces and joined at the shoulders using a 3 needle bind-off.

STITCH GUIDE

Medallions

(multiple of 8 sts + 3)

Row 1 (RS): * P3, k5; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 2 (WS): K3, * p5, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 3: * P3, k2, p1, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 4: K3, * p2, k1, p2, k3; rep from * to end.

Rows 5 & 6: Rep Rows 1 & 2.

Row 7: * K3, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 8: P3, * k1, p3; rep from * to end.

Row 9: K4, * p3, k5; rep from * to last 7 sts, p3, k4.

Row 10: P4, k3, * p5, k3; rep from * to last 4 sts, n4

Row 11: K1, p1, k2, * p3, k2, p1, k2; rep from * to last 7 sts, p3, k2, p1, k1.

Row 12: P1, k1, p2, k3, * p2, k1, p2, k3; rep from * to last 4 sts, p2, k1, p1.

Rows 13 & 14: Rep Rows 9 & 10.

Rows 15 & 16: Rep Rows 7 & 8.

Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

FRONT

With larger ndl, cast on 165 (181, 197) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K5, pm, work Row 1 of Medallions patt to last 5 sts, pm, k5.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to m, work Row 2 of Medallions patt to m, knit to end.

Cont in patt as est'd, keeping 5 sts each side in garter st until piece meas 16½ (17½, 18½)" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row.

Shape Neck

Next row (RS): Work in patt over 73 (80, 87) Left Front sts, attach new ball of yarn and bind off center 19 (21, 23) sts, work in patt over rem 73 (80, 87) Right Front sts. Place Left Front sts on holder.

Dec row (WS): Work in patt to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1-1 st dec'd.

Dec row (RS): K1, k2tog, work in patt to end -1 st dec'd. Cont to work a Dec row every row, 10

more times – 61 (68, 75) sts rem. Work even in patt for 7 more rows or until piece meas 20 (21, 22)" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row. Place sts on holder.

Return Left Front sts to ndl.

Dec row (WS): P1, ssp, work in patt to end -1 st dec'd.

Dec row (RS): Work in patt to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 – 1 st dec'd. Cont to work a Dec row every row, 10 more times – 61 (68, 75) sts rem. Work even in patt for 7 more rows or until piece meas 20 (21, 22)" from cast-on edge, ending with WS row. Place sts on holder.

BACK

Work as for Front.

Join Back and Front shoulders using 3 ndl bindoff.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to finished measurements.

Neck Edging

With smaller circ ndl, pick up and knit 148 (152, 156) sts evenly around neck opening. PM and join to work in the rnd. Purl 1 rnd, knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts kwise over the next rnd.




