SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 20"

Length: 72"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Classic Shades Sequins Lite* (74% acrylic, 22% wool, 4% payette; 100g/263 yds)

- 407 Wild Berries (A) – 3 skeins
- 416 Etoile (B) – 3 skeins

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24" circular
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

14 sts x 34 rows = 4" in Two-Color
Brioche Rib

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The Nebula Stole is all about simplicity and elegance. If you're new to Brioche knitting, we promise this will feel as simple and soothing as stockinette stitch once you get the hang of it. This reversible stole is a straightforward knit with stunning results. Knit in two shades of Classic Shades Sequins Lite, this accessory is incredibly soft and features a touch of sparkle that make it perfect to wrap around your shoulders on a chilly evening out.

Note that only one color is used each row. Each row is worked twice – once with Color A and once with Color B. Although this shawl is reversible, Right and Wrong sides of the work are indicated to help you stay on track.

STITCH GUIDE

Two-Color Brioche Rib

(odd number of sts)

Set-up Row 1 (WS): With A, k1, p1, * sl1yo, p1; rep from * to last st, k1. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Set-up Row 2 (WS): With B, k1, sl1yo, * brk 1, sl1yo; rep from * to last st, k1. Turn work.

Row 1 (RS): With A, k1, brk 1, * sl1yo, brk 1; rep from * to last st, k1. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 2 (RS): With B, k1, sl1yo, * brp 1, sl1yo; rep from * to last st, k1. Turn work.

Row 3 (WS): With A, k1, brp 1, * sl1yo, brp 1; rep from * to last st, k1. Slide sts to other end of ndl.

Row 4: (WS) With B, k1, sl1yo, * brk 1, sl1yo; rep from * to last st, k1. Turn work.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

STOLE

With A, cast on 71 sts.

Work Set-up Rows 1-2 of Two-Color Brioche Rib.

Work Rows 1-4 of Two-Color Brioche Rib. Cont as est'd until piece meas 71¾", ending with Row 4 of patt. Break B.

With A, bind off all sts kwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends but do not trim. Gently wet or steam block. Once piece is fully dry, trim ends close to work.

Abbreviations

brk	brioche knit – knit the stitch that was slipped in the previous row together with its yarnover
brp	brioche purl – purl the stitch that was slipped in the previous row together with its yarnover
cont	continue
est'd	established
k	knit
kwise	knitwise
m	marker
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
pwise	purlwise
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
sl1yo	slip 1, yarnover – bring the working yarn under the needle to the front of the work, slip the next st pwise, bring the working yarn over the ndl and the slipped stitch to the back
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side

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
