SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Shown in Medium size with 8¾" of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust (buttoned): 32¾ (36¾, 40¾, 44¾, 48¾, 52¾, 56¾, 60¾, 64¾)"

Length: 17¼ (17½, 18, 19, 19¾, 20¾, 22, 22¾, 22¾)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Cotton Supreme Sapling
(100% Cotton; 100/109 yds)

- 808 Hosta (MC) – 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6) skeins
- 813 Celery (CC) – 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4) skeins

Needles: US Size 11 (8 mm) straight, or your preferred needle for knitting flat *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) straight, or your preferred needle for knitting flat

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 4 – 1" buttons (*buttons shown are the Palm Buttons by Katrinkles*)

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GAUGE

12 sts x 19 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch (St st)

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The Nori Cardigan is an oversized, casual cardigan that's perfect for breezy days. Knit up in bulky-weight Cotton Supreme Sapling, this project is quick, easy, and satisfying to knit. We love how the nubby characteristic of this yarn gives the sweater just the right amount of texture. You're sure to enjoy this cardigan all season long!

This cardigan is knit flat in pieces from the bottom up and seamed. After seaming, stitches for the button band are picked up and worked flat. When working in Stripes Pattern, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, twist the strands of yarn around one another every RS row.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Twisted Rib

(Multiple of 2 sts, plus 1)

Row 1 (RS): * K1 tbl, p1; rep from * to last st, k1 tbl.

Row 2 (WS): P1 tbl, * k1, p1 tbl; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

Stripe Sequence

(Any number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): With CC, knit.

Row 2 (WS): With CC, purl.

Row 3: With MC, knit.

Row 4: With MC, purl.

Rep Rows 1-4 of patt.

BACK

Hem

With smaller ndl and MC, cast on 51 (57, 63, 69, 75, 81, 87, 93, 99) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 1¾" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2 of patt.

Change to larger ndl. Join CC, do not break MC.

Main Back

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work Row 2 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 3: Work Row 3 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 4: Work Row 4 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 until piece meas 12 (12, 12, 12½, 12½, 12½, 13, 13, 13)" from cast-on edge. Place removable markers on each side to denote armhole. Cont as est'd until piece meas 5¼ (5½, 6, 6½, 7¼, 8¼, 9, 9¾, 9¾)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller ndl and MC, cast on 23 (27, 29, 33, 35, 39, 41, 45, 47) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 1¾" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2 of patt.

Change to larger ndl. Join CC, do not break MC.

Main Front

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 2 (WS): Work Row 2 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 3: Work Row 3 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 4: Work Row 4 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 until piece meas 8¼ (8½, 9, 9½, 10¼, 11¼, 12, 12¾, 12¾)" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Note 1: Maintain Stripe Sequence throughout Neck shaping.

Note 2: When piece meas 12 (12, 12, 12½, 12½, 12½, 13, 13, 13)" from cast-on edge, place a removable marker on each side of work to denote armholes.

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Dec Row (RS): Cont as est'd to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 1 st dec'd, 22 (26, 28, 32, 34, 38, 40, 44, 46) sts rem.

Rep Dec Row every 4 rows, 6 (5, 5, 5, 6, 5, 6, 5, 6) times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows, 5 (7, 7, 8, 6, 8, 7, 9, 7) times – 11 (12, 12, 13, 12, 13, 13, 14, 13) sts dec'd, 11 (14, 16, 19, 22, 25, 27, 30, 33) sts rem.

Cont even as est'd until piece meas 5¼ (5½, 6, 6½, 7¼, 8¼, 9, 9¾, 9¾)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front to Neck Shaping.

Shape Neck

Note 1: Maintain Stripe Sequence throughout Neck shaping.

Note 2: When piece meas 12 (12, 12, 12½, 12½, 12½, 13, 13, 13)" from cast-on edge, place a removable marker on each side of work to denote armholes.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, cont as est'd to end – 1 st dec'd, 22 (26, 28, 32, 34, 38, 40, 44, 46) sts rem. Rep Dec Row every 4 rows, 6 (5, 5, 5, 6, 5, 6, 5, 6) times, then rep Dec Row every 2 rows, 5 (7, 7, 8, 6, 8, 7, 9, 7) times – 11 (12, 12, 13, 12, 13, 13, 14, 13) sts dec'd, 11 (14, 16, 19, 22, 25, 27, 30, 33) sts rem.

Cont even as est'd until piece meas 5¼ (5½, 6, 6½, 7¼, 8¼, 9, 9¾, 9¾)" from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

SLEEVES

Cuff

With smaller ndl and MC, cast on 29 (29, 31, 31, 31, 33, 33, 33, 33) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 1¾" from cast-on edge, ending with Row 2 of patt.

Change to larger ndl. Join CC, do not break MC.

Main Sleeve

Row 1 (RS): Work Row 1 of Stripe Sequence to end.



Row 2 (WS): Work Row 2 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 3: Work Row 3 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Row 4: Work Row 4 of Stripe Sequence to end.

Shape Sleeve

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence throughout Sleeve Shaping.

Inc Row (RS): K1, m1R, cont as est'd to last st, m1L, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 31 (31, 33, 33, 33, 35, 35, 35, 35) sts.

Rep Inc Row every 22 (14, 14, 10, 6, 4, 4, 2, 2) rows, 1 (1, 1, 1, 5, 1, 10, 3, 3) more times, then rep Inc Row every 0 (16, 16, 12, 8, 6, 0, 4, 4) rows, 0 (1, 1, 2, 1, 6, 0, 9, 9) times – 2 (4, 4, 6, 12, 14, 20, 24, 24) sts inc'd, 33 (35, 37, 39, 45, 49, 55, 59, 59) sts.

Cont even as est'd until piece meas 13" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

Saddle

Note: Maintain Stripe Sequence throughout Saddle.

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Bind off 10 (11, 12, 13, 16, 18, 21, 23, 23) sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 13 sts rem.
Work even as est'd until Saddle meas 3¼ (4¼, 5¼, 6¼, 7¼, 8¼, 9, 10, 11)'' from bind-off. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block pieces to finished measurements. Weave in ends. Sew Saddle to Front and Back shoulders, using removable markers as a guide. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

Button Band

With smaller ndl, MC, and RS facing, beg at bottom of Right Front. Pick up and knit 54 (55, 56, 61, 63, 66, 69, 71, 71) sts along Right Front, 11 sts along Saddle, 29 (29, 31, 31, 31, 31, 33, 33, 33) sts along Back Neck, 11 sts along Saddle, and 54 (55, 56, 61, 63, 66, 69, 71, 71) sts along Left Front – 159 (161, 165, 175, 179, 185, 193, 197, 197) sts.

Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas ¼'' from picked-up edge, ending with a RS row.

Buttonholes

Note: On Row 2, the double yarn-overs are worked with the preceding stitch and first stitch following the double yarn-overs. If the first stitch is a knit stitch: ssk. If the first stitch is a purl stitch: p2tog. If the second stitch following the double yarnover is a knit stitch: k2tog. If the second stitch following the yarnover is a purl stitch, p2tog.

Buttonhole Row 1 (WS): Cont as est'd over 4 (5, 3, 5, 4, 4, 3, 5, 5) sts, [yo] 2 times, {work in patt for 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 10, 11, 11, 11) sts, [yo] 2 times} 3 times, work in patt to end of row – 4

Buttonholes.

Buttonhole Row 2 (RS): Cont as est'd to 1 st bef the first double yo, [work next st and the first yo tog, then work the second yo and foll st tog, cont as est'd for 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9, 10, 10, 10) sts] 3 times, cont as est'd to end. Cont in K1, P1 Twisted Rib as est'd until piece meas 1½'' from picked-up edge. Bind off all sts in patt. Weave in rem ends.

m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1R	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
MC	main color
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt	pattern
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat
RS	right side
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over

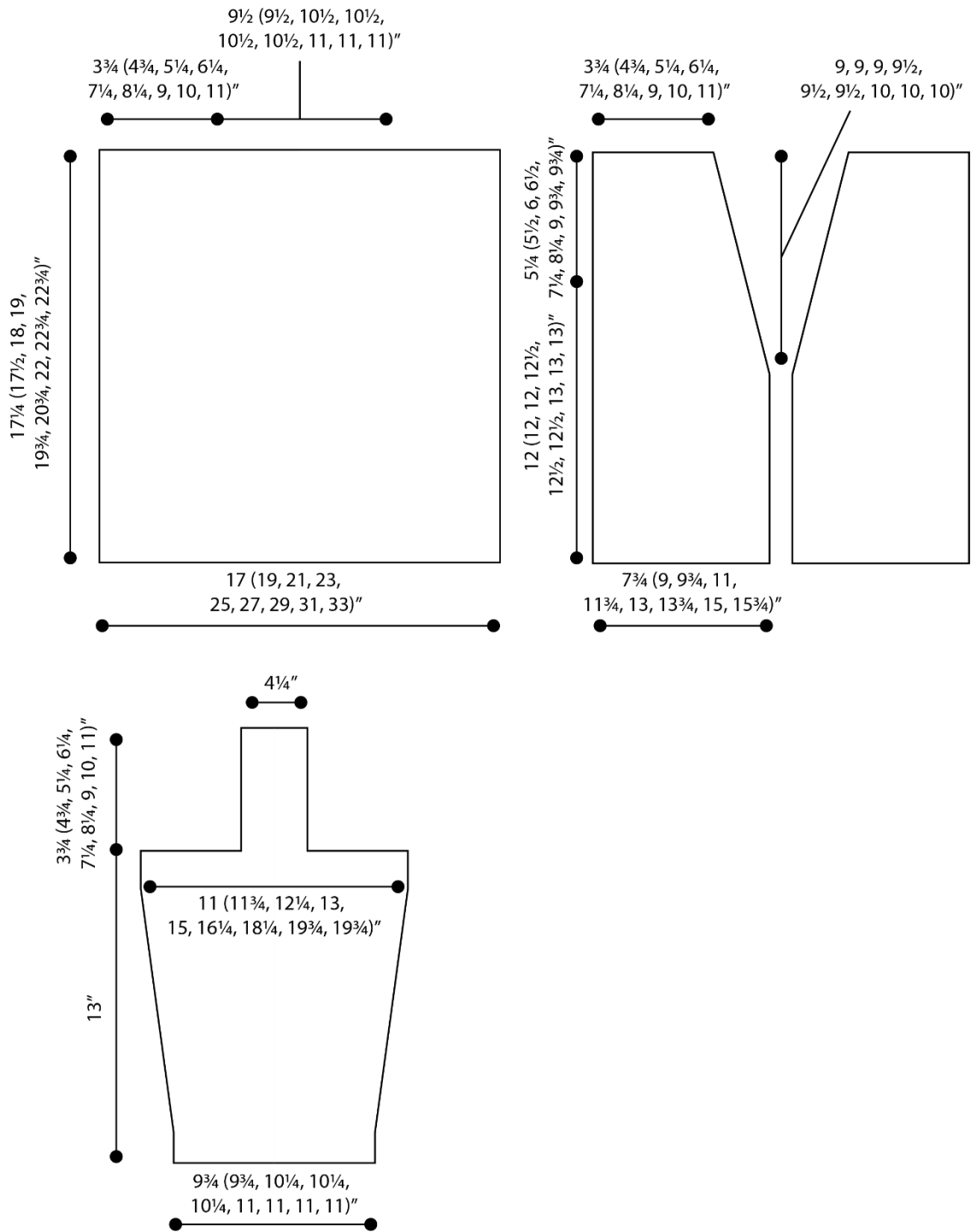
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
