## SIZES

Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)
Shown in size Small modeled with $31 / 4$ " ease.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 33 ( $371 / 4,41,45112,4911 / 4,53,571 / 2$, 611/4, 651/2)"
Length: $21 \frac{1}{4}\left(21 \frac{1}{4}, 221 / 4,23,231 / 2,24\right.$, $243 / 4,251 / 4,253 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Fibra Natura Whisper Lace (70\% superwash wool, $30 \%$ silk; $50 \mathrm{~g} / 440$ yds)

- 104 Fog -3 ( $4,4,5,5,6,6,7$, 9) balls

Needles: US Size 3 ( 3.25 mm ) straight and set of DPNs or size needed to obtain gauge
US Size 2 ( 2.75 mm ) straight, set of DPNs, and two 16 " circs (for neck band)
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, cable needle

## GAUGE

34 sts x 38 rows $=4$ " in Cable patt 30 sts $\times 36$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in St st
Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

This lightweight drop-shoulder pullover is a perfectly magical blend of interest and wearability. An asymmetrically placed cable panel balances out an otherwise pared back sweater. This is the garment you'll reach for again and again throughout the year.

The body of this sweater is worked flat in three pieces: Back, Front, and Side Panel. These pieces are sewn together at the seams. The Sleeves are picked

up from the underarm and worked in the round from the top down. The neckband is picked up during finishing and worked in the round. Unless otherwise noted, all slipped stitches in this pattern are worked purlwise with yarn held in front of work. This sweater calls for the long-tail tubular cast-on. You can find a tutorial for this cast-on method on our blog.

## STITCH GUIDE

## 2x1 Left Purl Cross (LPC)

SI next 2 sts to cn and hold in front, p1 from left ndl, k2 from cn.
2x1 Right Purl Cross (RPC)
Sl next st to cn and hold in back, k2 from left ndl, p1 from cn.
$2 \times 2$ Left Cross (LC)
SI next 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2 from left ndl, k2 from cn.
$\mathbf{2 x 2}$ Right Cross (RC)

SI next 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2 from left ndl, k2 from cn.

## $\mathbf{2 x 2}$ Right Purl Cross (RPC)

Sl next 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2 from left ndl, p2 from cn.
$2 \times 2$ Left Purl Cross (LPC)
SI next 2 sts to cn and hold in front, p2 from left ndl, k2 from cn.

## K1, P1 Rib

(even number of sts, worked in the round)
Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

## K1, P1 Rib

(odd number of sts, worked flat)
Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

## K1, P1 Rib

(even number of sts, worked flat)
Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

## Cable

(multiple of 29 sts, plus 1)
Row 1 (RS): P1, * p1, $2 \times 2$ LC, p2, $2 \times 1$
RPC, $2 \times 2$ LC, $2 \times 2$ RC, $2 \times 1$ LPC, p2, $2 \times 2$ RC, p2; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS): * K2, p4, k2, p2, k1, p8, k1, p2, k2, p4, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 3: P1, * $2 \times 1$ RPC, $2 \times 1$ LPC, $2 \times 1$
RPC, p1, k8, p1, $2 \times 1$ LPC, $2 \times 1$ RPC, $2 \times 1$ LPC, p1.
Row 4: * K1, p2, k2, p4, k2, p8, k2, p4, k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 5: P1, * k2, p2, 2x2 RPC, p2, 2x2 LC, $2 \times 2$ RC, p2, $2 \times 2$ LPC, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end.
Row 6: * K1, p2, k2, p2, k4, p8, k4, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 7: P1, * $2 \times 1$ LPC, $2 \times 1$ RPC, p2, $2 \times 2$ RC, k4, $2 \times 2$ LC, p2, $2 \times 1$ LPC, $2 \times 1$ RPC, p 1 ; rep from * to end.
Row 8: * K2, p4, k3, p12, k3, p4, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.
Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

## SWEATER

## SIDE PANEL

With small ndl, cast on 61 (61, 61, $90,90,90,119,119,119$ ) sts using the long-tail tubular method. Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge, ending with a RS Row. Change to larger ndl.

## Establish Pattern

Set-up Row (WS): SI 1, pm, [k2, p4, k3, p12, k3, p4, k1] $2(2,2,3,3,3,4,4,4)$ times, k1, pm, k1.
Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, sl m, work Row 1 of Cable Panel to $m$, $s l m, k 1$. Pattern will be repeated $2(2,2,3,3,3,4,4,4)$ times across each row.
Row 2: Sl 1, sl m, work Row 2 of Cable Panel to m, sl m, k1.

Row 3: Sl 1 , sl m, work next row of Cable Panel to $m$, $s l m, k 1$.
Row 4: SI 1, sl m, work next of Cable Panel to m, sl m, k1.
Cont in patt as est'd until piece meas 15 ( $15,15,151 / 4,151 / 4,151 / 4,151 / 2,151 / 2$, $151 / 2$ )" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

## Divide Front and Back

Cont as est'd over 27 (27, 27, 41, $41,41,55,55,55)$ Back sts, bind off center $7(7,7,8,8,8,9,9,9)$ sts, cont as est'd over 27 (27, 27, 41, 41, 41, $55,55,55)$ Front sts. Place Back sts on holder or waste yarn.

## Side Panel Front

Note: Maintain sts in patt as much as possible.
Cont even in patt as est'd until piece meas $61 / 4(63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4,81 / 4,83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4$, $101 / 4$ )" from armhole bind-off. Bind off all sts in patt.

## Side Panel Back

Return Back sts to ndl.
Cont even in patt as est'd until piece meas $61 / 4(63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4,81 / 4,83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4$, $101 / 4$ )" from armhole bind-off. Bind off all sts in patt.

## FRONT

With smaller ndl, cast on 100 (116, $130,134,148,162,166,180,196)$ sts using the long-tail tubular method. Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge, ending with a RS Row. Change to larger ndl.
Set-up Row (WS): SI 1, purl to last st, k1.
Row 1 (RS): SI 1, knit to end.
Row 2: SI 1, purl to last st, k1.
Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 15 (15, $\left.15,151 / 4,151 / 4,151 / 4,151 / 2,151 / 2,15^{1} / 2\right)^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on edge, ending with a RS row. On the next WS row, bind off 3 $(3,3,4,4,4,5,5,5)$ sts. Cont as est'd to end - 97 (113, 127, 130, 144, 158, $161,175,191)$ sts rem.
Cont even in patt as est'd until piece meas $2 \frac{1}{4}(23 / 4,3114,33 / 4,41 / 4,43 / 4,51 / 4,53 / 4$, $61 / 4$ )" from Armhole bind-off, ending
with a WS row.

## Shape Front Neck

Next Row (RS): Cont as est'd over 26 (34, 41, 35, 42, 49, 43, 50, 58) Left Front sts, bind off $18(18,18,19,19$, 19, 20, 20, 20) Front Neck sts, cont as est'd over 53 (61, 68, 76, 83, 90, 98, 105, 113) Right Front sts. Place Left Front sts on holder or waste yarn.

## Right Front

Row 1 (WS): Cont as est'd to end. Bind off 6 sts at the beg of the next RS row, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the foll 6 RS rows - 24 sts bound off, $29(37,44,52,59,66,74,81,89)$ sts rem.
Cont even as est'd until piece meas $61 / 4(63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4,81 / 4,83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4,101 / 4)^{\prime \prime}$ from Armhole bind-off, ending with a WS Row. Bind off rem sts.

## Left Front

Return 26 (34, 41, 35, 42, 49, 43, 50, 58) Right Back sts to ndl.

Bind off 6 sts at the beg of the next WS row, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the foll 6 WS rows -24 sts bound off, $2(10,17,11,18,25,19,26,34)$ sts rem. Cont even as est'd until piece meas $61 / 4(6314,71 / 4,73 / 4,81 / 4,83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4$, 10 $1 / 4$ )" from Armhole bind-off, ending with a WS Row. Bind off rem sts.

## BACK

Work as for Front until piece meas $15(15,15,15114,151 / 4,151 / 4,151 / 2,151 / 2$, $151 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. On the next RS row, bind off $3(3,3,4,4,4,5,5,5)$ sts, cont as est'd to end - 97 (113, 127, 130, 144, 158, $161,175,191)$ sts rem.
Cont even in patt as est'd until piece meas $41 / 4(43 / 4,51 / 4,53 / 4,61 / 4,63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4$, 81/4)" from Armhole bind-off, ending with a WS row.

## Shape Back Neck

Next Row (RS): Cont as est'd over 53
(61, 68, 76, 83, 90, 98, 105, 113) Right Back sts, bind off 18 (18, 18, 19, 19, 19, 20, 20, 20) Back Neck sts, cont as est'd over 26 (34, 41, 35, 42, 49, 43,

50,58) Left Back sts. Place Right Back sts on holder or waste yarn.

## Left Back

Row 1 (WS): Cont as est'd to end.
Bind off 6 sts at the beg of the next RS row, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the foll 6 RS rows -24 sts bound off, 2 ( $10,17,11,18,25,19,26,34$ ) sts rem.
Cont even as est'd until piece meas
$61 / 4\left(63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4,8 \frac{1}{4}, 83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4,101 / 4\right)^{\prime \prime}$
from Armhole bind-off, ending with a WS Row. Bind off rem sts.

## Right Back

Return 60 Right Back sts to ndl.
Bind off 6 sts at the beg of the next RS row, then bind off 3 sts at the beg of the foll 6 RS rows -24 sts bound off, $29(37,44,52,59,66,74,81,89)$ sts rem. Cont even as est'd until piece meas $61 / 4(63 / 4,71 / 4,73 / 4,81 / 4,83 / 4,91 / 4,93 / 4$, $101 / 4$ )" from Armhole bind-off, ending with a WS Row. Bind off rem sts.

## FINISHING

Block pieces to finished measurements and weave in ends. Sew sides of Side Panel to Left Front and Left Back. Sew right side seam. Sew Shoulder seams.

## Sleeves

With larger set of dpns, beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit 100 (108, 114, 124, 130, 138, 146, 154, 162) sts evenly along armholes. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

## Rnd 1: Knit.

Rep Rnd 1 until piece meas $3 / 4$ " from picked-up edge.

## Shape Sleeve

Dec Rnd: K1, k2tog, cont as est'd to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 2 sts dec'd, 98 (106, $112,122,128,136,144,152,160)$ sts rem.
Rep Dec Rnd every 6 (6, 6, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rnds, 12 ( $9,2,27,24,23,20,17,14$ ) more times, then rep Dec Rnd every $4(4,4,2,2,2,2,2,2)$ rnds, $9(14,24$, $2,8,10,17,22,29)$ times - 42 ( 46 , $52,58,64,66,74,78,86)$ sts dec'd, 56
( $60,60,64,64,70,70,74,74$ ) sts rem. Cont even in St st until Sleeve meas $14(14,14,14114,141 / 4,141 / 4,141 / 2,141 / 2$, $141 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ from underarm. Change to smaller set of dpns.

## Sleeve Cuff

Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas $16(16,16,161 / 4,161 / 4,161 / 4,161 / 2,161 / 2$, $161 / 2$ )" from underarm. Bind off all sts in patt.

## Neck Edge

With smaller $16^{\prime \prime}$ circ and RS facing, beg at Right Back, pick up and knit 29 sts along Right Back Neck edge, 18 (18, 18, 19, 19, 19, 20, 20, 20) sts along Back Neck bind-off edge, 29 sts along Left Back Neck edge, 40 sts along Left Front Neck edge, 18 ( 18,18 , $19,19,19,20,20,20$ ) sts along Front Neck bind-off edge, and 40 sts along

Right Front Neck edge - 174 (174, $174,176,176,176,178,178,178)$ sts. PM and join to work in the rnd. Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 5 " from picked-up edge. Fold neck out so WS is visible. Using spare circ ndl, beg at first st picked up, pick up a loop along inside of neck edge - 1 for each st along pick-up edge - 174 (174, 174, $176,176,176,178,178,178)$ sts on spare ndl. Fold neck in half to inside so both needles are parallel to each other. Using the 3-ndl method, loosely bind off all sts. Weave in rem ends.
