



Pattern Collection: Accessories



Onyx Mitts

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

SIZE

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hand Circumference: 7 (7¾, 8½)''

Length: 8 (8½, 9)''

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura Cashmere Lusso (50% virgin cashmere wool, 50% recycled cashmere wool; 50g/246 yds)

- 10005 Lavagna – 1 ball (all sizes)

Needles: US Size 3 (3.25 mm) set of dpns (or your preferred needles for small circumference knitting) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 2 (2.75 mm) set of dpns (or your preferred needles for small circumference knitting)

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn

GAUGE

26 sts x 34 rnds = 4'' in St st with larger ndl

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PATTERN NOTES

Nothing says luxury like a pair of cashmere gloves and the Onyx Mitts are just that. These minimalist mitts are perfect for everyone and every occasion. We're certain this will be the pair you grab again and again when the air is cool and crisp.

These mitts are knit in the round from the bottom up. Stitches are increased for the thumb, then divided to work the hand and thumb separately.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Rib

(even number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

K1, P1 Twisted Rib

(even number of sts)

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

MITTS

(make two)

Cuff

With smaller ndl, cast on 46 (50, 56) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 1½" from cast-on edge. Change to larger ndl.

Work even in St st until piece meas 3½" from cast-on edge.

Shape for Thumb

Set-up Rnd: K44 (48, 54), pm, k2.

Inc Rnd: Knit to m, sl m, m1, knit to bor m, m1 – 2 sts inc'd, 48 (52, 58) sts.

Rep Inc Rnd every 4 rnds, 1 more time, then rep Inc Rnd every 2 rnds, 5 (6, 7) more times – 12 (14, 16) sts inc'd, 60 (66, 74) sts.

Separate Thumb and Hand

Next Rnd: Knit to m, remove m, sl next 16 (18, 20) sts to holder or waste yarn, cast on 2 sts, pm for new bor.

Hand

Work even in St st until piece meas 7 (7½, 8)" from cast-on edge. Change to smaller ndl.

Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib until piece meas 8 (8½, 9)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts in patt.

Thumb

Return 16 (18, 20) sts to larger ndl.

Rnd 1: K16 (18, 20), pick up and knit 2 sts along cast-on edge, pm to denote bor – 18 (20, 22) sts.

Work even in St st until Thumb meas 1 (1¼, 1½)" from picked-up edge. Change to smaller ndl.

Rnds 1-4: Work in K1, P1 Twisted Rib to end. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

bor	beginning of round
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
m	marker
m1	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
rnd	round
sl	slip
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)

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
