# **Penelope Handpaints Cowl** Designed by Michael del Vecchio

# FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 32"

Length: 7"

## **MATERIALS**

Universal Yarn Bamboo Bloom Handpaints (48% rayon from bamboo, 44% wool, 8% acrylic; 100g/154 yds)

• 305 Kimono – 1 hank Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular

needle or size to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch marker, tapestry needle

# **GAUGE**

16 sts x 22 rows = 4" in St st, measured over bamboo sections of yarn Save time, check your gauge

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

K Knit Sl st slip stitch

St st Stockinette stitch

## **PATTERN NOTE**

Entire cowl is worked in St st. Knit every stitch until you come upon a wool section of yarn, then work a bobble as follows: Knit into front, back, and front of next st, turn, purl 2, pass 1 stitch over the next, purl last st, pass prev st over next st, turn, sl st back to RH ndl and cont working across bamboo sections of yarn.

## **COWL**

Cast on 115 sts. Place marker and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Knit 1 rnd without working any bobbles. Working even in St st, knit every stitch across bamboo sections of yarn and work 1 bobble per each section of wool yarn until cowl measures 6¾". Knit 1 rnd without working bobbles. Bind off all sts loosely.
