FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 29½" Depth In Center: 26¾"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn <u>Major</u> (100% acrylic; 200g/328 yds)

• 104 Pebbles - 1 skein

Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 24" circular

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

11 sts \times 16 rnds = 4" in V-Twist patt Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

PATTERN NOTES

The Permafrost Cowl is a next-level accessory for cold days. Knit in plump, colorful Major, this cowl will keep you warm even in the chilliest climates. It features a deep, roomy neck with a stylish pointed front – creating an easy-to-style, lovely combination of a shawl and a cowl.

This cowl is knit in the round from the top down. Stitches for the circumference are cast on and worked in the round to the center, then the front and back are separated, and the Front is worked flat. After completing the Front, stitches are picked up for the lower edging and worked in the round.

In this pattern, slip all sts pwise with yarn held in back on RS rows/rnds and with yarn held in front on WS rows.

STITCH GUIDE

Right Twist (RT): K2tog but do not slip st from ndl, knit the first st again, slip both sts from ndl.

Left Twist (LT): Knit the second st on the left ndl through the back loop, knit the first st through the front loop, slip both sts from ndl.

Right Purl Twist (RPT): K2tog but do not slip st from ndl, purl the first st again, slip both sts from ndl.

Left Purl Twist (LPT): Purl the second st on the left ndl through the back loop, knit the first st through the front loop, slip both sts from ndl.

V-Twist

(multiple of 13 sts, plus 1, worked in the rnd)

Rnd 1: P1, * k1, p1, k1, p6, [k1, p1] 2 times; rep from * to end.

Rnd 2: P1, * [LPT] 2 times, p4, [RPT] 2 times, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: P1, * p1, sl 1, k1, sl 1, p4, sl 1, k1, sl 1, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: P1, * p1, LT, LPT, p2, RPT, RT, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: P1, * p2, sl 1, k1, sl 1, p2, sl 1, k1, sl 1, p3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: P1 * p2, LT, LPT, RPT, RT, p3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: P1, * p3, sl 1, k1, [sl 1] 2 times, k1, sl 1, p4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 8: P1, * p3, LT, [RT] 2 times, p4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: P1, * p4, [sl 1] 2 times, k1, sl 1, p5; rep from * to end.

Rnd 10: P1, * p4, LT, RT, p5; rep from * to end.

Rnd 11: P1, * p5, [sl 1] 2 times, p6; rep from * to end.

Rnd 12: P1, * p5, LT, p6; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-12 for patt.

V-Twist

(multiple of 13 sts, plus 1, worked flat)

Row 1 (WS): * [K1, p1] 2 times, k6, p1, k1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2: P1, * [LPT] 2 times, p4, [RPT] 2 times, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 3: * K2, sl 1, p1, sl 1, k4, sl 1, p1, sl 1, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: P1, * p1, LT, LPT, p2, RPT, RT, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 5: * K3, sl 1, p1, sl 1, k2, sl 1, p1, sl 1, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6: P1 * p2, LT, LPT, RPT, RT, p3; rep from * to end

Row 7: * K4, sl 1, p1, [sl 1] 2 times, p1, sl 1, k3; rep from * to lst st, k1.

Row 8: P1, * p3, LT, [RT] 2 times, p4; rep from * to end

Row 9: * K5, sl 1, p1, [sl 1] 2 times, k4; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 10: P1, * p4, LT, RT, p5; rep from * to end.

Row 11: * K6, [sl 1] 2 times, k5; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 12: P1, * p5, LT, p6; rep from * to end. Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

COWL

Cast on 79 sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Bor marker indicates center back.

Rnd 1 (Set-up Rnd): Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: Purl.

Establish Pattern

Work Rnds 1-12 of V-Twist patt, 5 total times. Patt will be repeated 6 times across each rnd.

Next Rnd (Divide Front & Back): Cont in patt as est'd to last 19 sts, bind off next 38 sts (removing bor m as you come to it) - 41 sts Front rem.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

Shape Front

Note 1: You will now begin working flat.

Note 2: Maintain V-Twist patt as est'd throughout Front Shaping. If there are not enough stitches to complete a LT, LPT, RT, or RPT, work these extra stitches in reverse stockinette stitch instead.

Row 1 (RS Dec Row): K1, ssk, cont in patt as est'd to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 2 sts dec'd, 39 sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): P2, cont as est'd to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 3: K2, cont as est'd to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-4, 12 more times – 24 sts dec'd 15 sts

rem.

Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times – 8 sts dec'd, 7 sts

rem.

Shape Tip

Row 1 (RS): K1, ssk, p1, k2tog, k1 - 2 sts dec'd, 5

sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): P2, k1, p2.

Row 3: Ssk, p1, k2tog - 2 sts dec'd, 3 sts rem.

Row 4: S2KP2 - 2 sts dec'd, 1 st rem. Fasten off

rem st.

Bottom Edging

Beg at Right Back (where first bind-off occurred). Pick up and knit 38 Back sts, pick up and knit 46 sts along side dec edge, pm, pick up 1 st at center front, pm, pick up and knit 46 sts along side dec edge, pm and join to knit in the rnd - 131 sts.

Rnd 1: Purl to 1 st before m, m1L, sl m, k1, m1R, purl to end - 2 sts inc'd. 133 sts.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 1 - 2 sts inc'd, 135 sts.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Bind off all sts pwise.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements.

Weave in ends.
