DIFFICULTY

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 66½" Depth at Center: 34"

MATERIALS

<u>Fibra Natura Ravello</u> (75% cotton, 16% extra fine merino, 9% recycled cashmere; 50g/207 yds)

• 105 Honeypot - 7 balls

Hook: US Size F/5 (3.75 mm) or size

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

3 Petals = 4" wide

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Soft and stunning Ravello is perfectly suited for a crochet shawl. The blend of cotton, extra fine merino wool, and cashmere features a subtle halo and superb stitch definition that make the decorative stitches in this fabric shine. The Petal Shawl is a luxurious piece that will keep you warm during every season. Go ahead, treat yourself to something beautiful!

This shawl is worked flat from the top down, beginning with the widest edge, and decreasing to the point. A single crochet border is applied to the edges during finishing. A diagram is included for the gauge swatch instructions and also may be used as a reference for the actual shawl pattern.

STITCH GUIDE

Petal Stitch (Petal st): [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] into indicated st.

Reverse Petal Stitch (Reverse Petal st): [Tr, 3 dc, tr] into indicated st.

Instructions for Gauge Swatch

Ch 32 loosely.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hk, sc in each ch across, turn – 31 sc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in 1st st, * sk 2 sts, Petal st into next st, sk 2 sts, sc into next st; rep from * across, turn - 5 Petals.

Row 3: Do not chain, instead, sk 1st st, sl st into next 3 sts, and ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc into top of ch-3 sp, * Reverse Petal st] into sc from previous row, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from * across, turn - 4 Reverse Petals.

Rep Rows 2-3, 3 more times, then rep Row 2, 1 more time. Fasten off. Gently wash and block, then take gauge measurements from this swatch.

PATTERN BEGINS

SHAWL

Ch 284 loosely.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2^{nd} ch from hk, sc in each ch across, turn – 283 sc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 1, sc in 1st st, * sk 2 sts, Petal st into next st, sk 2 sts, sc into next st; rep from * across, turn - 47 Petals.

Row 3: Do not chain, instead, sk 1st st, sl st into next 3 sts, and ch 3 sp, ch 1, sc into top of ch-3 sp, * Reverse Petal st into sc from previous row, sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from * across, turn - 46 Reverse Petals.



Rep Rows 2-3, 45 more times - Final Reverse Petal made.

Rep Row 2, 1 more time - Final Petal made.

FINISHING

SI st to any corner.

Ch 1, * sc in each stitch evenly down the side of the shawl till you reach a corner, 3 sc in corner; rep from * 2 more times, sl st to the 1st st to join the border. Fasten off. Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.
