SIZES

One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length from Front Trim to Crown: 61/4"

Height (from Neck Trip to top of forehead: 7½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Adore* (55% superwash merino, 45% acrylic; 100g/273 yds)

• 108 Plump Plum – 1 skein

Needle: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight and set of dpns or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

25 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Rev St st

PATTERN NOTES

The Petite Bonnet is a sweet little topper featuring an adorable bobble and twisted stitch motif around the brim. I-Cord ties can be used to secure the bonnet onto your little one – all while adding a touch of charm.

This bonnet is worked flat to the crown shaping, where it is joined in the round. The open bottom edge rests around the neck and is finished with an I-cord edging. The pattern begins with a provisional cast-on that is later unpicked and bound off using the I-cord method.

Crochet Provisional Cast-on

With waste yarn and crochet hook, make a ch approximately 10 chs longer than the number of sts to be cast on. With working yarn and knitting needle, pick up and knit sts through the bottom bump of each ch.

I-Cord

With MC, cast on 4 sts to dpn. * K4, slide sts to other end of ndl and place in left hand; rep from * until Rope meas 20 (22, 24)". Bind off all sts. Sew cast-on edge to bind-off edge.

I-Cord Bind-Off Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. * K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound-off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from * until all sts have been bound-off.

STITCH GUIDE

Right Purl Twist (RPT): K2tog but do not slip st from ndl, purl the first st again, slip both sts from ndl.

Left Purl Twist (LPT): Purl the second st on the left ndl through the back loop, knit the first st through the front loop, slip both sts from ndl.

Make Bobble (mb)

[K1, yo, k1, yo, k1] into same stitch, turn, p5, turn, p2tog, p1, p2tog, turn, S2KP2

Zig Zag Bobble

(repeat of 23 sts)

Row 1 (RS): * P1, k1 tbl, p1, [k1 tbl] 2 times, p1, [k1 tbl] 2 times, [p1, k1 tbl] 3 times, p1, [k1 tbl] 2

times, p1, [k1 tbl] 2 times, p1, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): * K1, p1 tbl, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, [k1, p1 tbl] 3 times, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 3: * P1, k1 tbl, p1, RPT, p1, LPT, [p1, k1 tbl] 3 times, p1, RPT, p1, LPT, p1, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end

Row 4: * [K1, p1 tbl] 2 times, k3, [p1 tbl, k1] 4 times, p1 tbl, k3, [p1 tbl, k1] 2 times; rep from * to end

Row 5: * P1, k1 tbl, RPT, p3, LPT, [k1 tbl, p1] 2 times, k1 tbl, RPT, p3, LPT, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end

Row 6: * K1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k5, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1, p1 tbl, k1, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k5, [p1 tbl] 2 times, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 7: * P1, RPT, p2, mb, p2, LPT, p1, k1 tbl, p1, RPT, p2, mb, p2, LPT, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 8: * K1, p1 tbl, k7, [p1 tbl, k1] 2 times, p1 tbl, k7, p1 tbl, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 9: * RPT, p7, LPT, k1 tbl, RPT, p7, LPT; rep from * to end.

Row 10: * P1 tbl, k9, [p1 tbl] 3 times, k9, p1 tbl; rep from * to end.

Row 11: * P11, k1 tbl, p11; rep from * to end.

Row 12: Knit to end.

BONNET

Using the Crochet-Provisional method, cast on 92 sts.

Brim

Row 1: Work Row 1 of Zig Zag Bobble patt to end. Patt will be repeated 4 times across each row.

Row 2: Work next row of Zig Zag Bobble patt to end. Cont as est'd through Row 12 of Zig Zag Bobble patt.

Work Rows 1-12 of Zig Zag Bobble patt to end. Patt will be repeated 4 times across each row. Work in Rev St st until piece meas 3½" from caston edge, ending with a WS Row.

Shape Crown

Note: Patt will now be worked in the round. Work Set-up Row onto dpns or preferred needle for small circumference knitting.

Knit. Relax, Smile, Repeat!

2019 © Universal Yarn, Inc. All rights reserved. www.universalyarn.com **Setup Row (RS):** * K1, p21, k1, pm; rep from * to end. *Note: Last marker indicates bor. Distribute sts evenly along ndls.*

Dec Rnd: * K2tog, purl to 2 sts bef m, ssk; rep from * to end – 8 sts dec'd, 84 sts rem. Rep Dec Rnd every rnd, 9 more times – 80 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Next Rnd: * K2tog; rep from * to end; 6 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem. Break yarn leave a 6" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts. Pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Front Trim

Using smaller set of dpns, make an I-cord approx. 7" long – do not bind off. Carefully unravel crochet chain, placing resulting live sts onto ndl. Joining I-cord, bind off all sts using the I-Cord method. Do not bind off rem I-cord sts. Cont working I-cord until it meas approx. 7" from last cast-on stitch. Bind off I-cord. Tie each end with an overhand knot.

Neck Trim

With smaller needles and RS facing, pick up and knit 49 sts evenly along neck edge. Bind off all sts using the I-cord method. Weave in rem ends.


